NEW YORK METS (44-44) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (42-47)

July 8, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 12:35 EDT - GAME #90/HOME #46

RHP CHRISTIAN SCOTT (0-2, 4.32 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (9-5, 3.48 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...took a 2-1 lead into the ninth inning before losing 3-2 yesterday against the Mets...Scored a season-high 14 runs while hitting a club record-tying seven home runs Friday night...Have gone 15-15 in one-run games...Have won 10 games in their last at-bat, matching their total from all of 2023 (the team won 13 games in the final at-bat of 2022)...Have gone 32-3 (.914 winning percentage) when outhitting their opponents this season...Have not been shut out in 34 straight games, which is the sixth-longest active streak in MLB (the Cardinals have the longest active streak at 67 games)...Have gone 2-0-2 in their four-game series this season heading into the deciding game of their current series against the Mets...Have played in 30 one-run games, which are the second-most among National League teams behind the Cubs (33).

GIMME FIVE: Mitch Keller worked 5.0 innings in his last start Tuesday against St. Louis, giving him 48 straight starts of working at least 5.0 innings in a game...It's the longest active streak in all of MLB coming into today and the longest in MLB since Max Fried had 50 straight from June 6, 2021, to September, 30, 2022...It's also the longest streak by a Pirate since A.J. Burnett made 49 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings from May 8, 2012, to August 10, 2013.

ALL-STARS AMONG US: Last night Major League Baseball announced that Bryan Reynolds and Paul Skenes will represent the Pirates at this year's All-Star Game in Texas...This is the second time Reynolds has been selected to play in the All-Star Game after also starting in center field for the National League in 2021...Skenes was named to the team just one year after the Pirates selected him No. 1 overall in the draft...According to MLB, the 22-year-old Skenes is the first player ever to earn an All-Star selection in the season after being the No. 1 overall selection in his draft...Skenes is the first Pirates rookie pitcher ever to be selected to the All-Star Game and the fourth Pirates rookie overall along with Frankie Zak in 1944, Jason Kendall in 1996 and Tony Womack in 1997.

QUALITY STUFF: Luis Ortiz tossed 6.0 shutout innings while making his second start of the season yesterday afternoon...The Pirates now have 43 quality starts this season (the team had 53 in all of 2023)...That's the fourth-most in all of MLB, trailing only the Mariners (53), Phillies (51) and Royals (46)...Today's starter, Mitch Keller, is tied with Jared Jones for the most quality starts (nine) on the Pirates this season.

ON DECK: The Pirates will depart for a six-game road trip leading up to the All-Star break after today's game that will take the team to Milwaukee and Chicago to play the White Sox...The game on Sunday against the White Sox will close out a stretch of 13 games since the team's last off day a week ago today.

CARMEN'S ELECTRIC: Carmen Mlodzinski tossed a scoreless seventh inning on Sunday for his fifth straight scoreless appearance, which totals 6.1 innings...Mlodzinski has an 0.55 ERA (16.1ip/3r/1er) and .130 batting average against in his last 12 appearances out of the bullpen dating back to May 31.

EVERYDAY BRYAN: Bryan Reynolds has started each of the first 89 games of this season... That's the longest streak by a Pirate since Josh Bell started each of the first 89 games of the 2018 campaign...Prior to Bell, the last Pirate to start more than 89 games to begin a season was Jason Bay in 2006 (118 games).

B-REY AND BOBBY BO: Bryan Reynolds is tied with Bobby Bonilla for the most home runs (114) in Pirates history among switch hitters...That's also tied for 17th overall in Pirates history...Reynolds is now two home runs shy of tying Andy Van Slyke and Dick Stuart for 15th place in team history in home runs (117).

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen's double on Wednesday moved him into sole possession of sixth place for the most career extra base hits (591) in Pirates history... He is now one extra base hit shy of tying Pie Traynor for the fifth-most in team history...McCutchen also ranks fifth on the team's all-time walks list (798)...The only four Pirates with more career walks are Willie Stargell (937), Max Carey (919), Paul Waner (912) and Honus Wagner (877).

July 8, 1964: Bob Veale tossed 6.2 scoreless innings as the Bucs cruised to a 9-1 win against the Reds at Forbes Field. Roberto Clemente went 3-for-4 with a triple and RBI while Willie Stargell also added three hits, including his 12th home run of the season, which was a three-run shot off Reds starter Jim Maloney in the sixth inning.

TODAY'S STARTER **RHP MITCH KELLER** **#23**

2024 RECORD: 9-5, 3.48 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-2/205 **BATS/THROWS:** R/R
BORN: April 4, 1996 **SIGNED:** Thru 2028
AGE: 28 **HOW ACQUIRED:** Selected by the Pirates in the 2nd round of the 2014 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 28-year-old righthander is in his sixth Major League season, all with the Pirates...Keller signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 22, 2024...The 2023 All-Star has been Pittsburgh's Opening Day starter in each of the last two seasons, making him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16...He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First Year Player Draft.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Keller enters play among the NL leaders in several categories, including tied for fourth in wins (9), sixth in run support (65), tied for 11th in innings pitched (103.1) and 14th in home runs per 9.0 IP (0.87).

RARE AIR: Keller currently has nine wins, 103.1 innings pitched and 96 strikeouts so far this season...With one more win and four strikeouts, Keller could become the fourth pitcher in Pirates franchise history to record 10+ wins, 100.0+ IP and 100+ strikeouts before the All-Star Break, joining Gerrit Cole in 2015 (13 wins, 117.1 IP, 116 strikeouts), Bob Veale in 1966 (10 wins, 142.0 IP, 134 strikeouts) and Bob Friend in 1960 (10 wins, 153.1 IP, 109 strikeouts).

#WINNING: The Pirates are 8-2 in Keller's last 10 starts since May 6 vs. LAA.
 • With a win today, Keller would become the first Pirates pitcher since Gerrit Cole in 2015 (13) to record 10+ wins before the All-Star Break.

ALL HE DOES IS WIN: Keller earned his ninth win of the season on June 25...Keller has now earned nine wins before July 1 in back-to-back seasons, the first Pirates pitcher to accomplish this feat since Steve Blass did so in 1971 (9) and 1972 (9) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

- He is the first Major League pitcher to post back-to-back seasons of 9+ wins before July 1 since Justin Verlander did so for the Astros from 2018-19...The last National League pitcher to do so was Max Scherzer with the Nationals for four straight seasons from 2015-18 (also did it from 2013-14 with the Tigers...six consecutive seasons in total).
- Keller was also the first Pirate to have seven-plus wins through June 1 in consecutive years since Howie Camnitz from 1908 (7) to 1909 (8)...The only other Pirates to accomplish this feat were Frank Killen in 1896 (10) and 1897 (8) (courtesy of Elias Sports Bureau).

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss after he allowed six runs (five earned) on nine hits with five strikeouts and no walks over 5.0 innings of work on July 2 vs. St. Louis.

GETTING IT DONE: In 10 starts since the beginning of May, Keller is 7-2 with a 2.42 ERA (17 ER in 63.1 IP) and .239 (58-for-243) batting average against...His seven wins in that time are tied for the second-most in the NL (Chris Sale - 8)...His ERA since May 1 is third-best in the NL and fifth in the Majors behind only CWS Garrett Crochet (1.66) WSH Jake Irvin (2.12), BAL Corbin Burnes (2.21) and ATL Chris Sale (2.25).

VS. NEW YORK: Keller will be making his fourth career start against the Mets today and his first of the 2024 season...He owns a lifetime 2-1 record with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER in 19.0 IP) with a .188 opponents average, 15 strikeouts and six walks in those starts.
 • He last appeared against New York on June 11, 2023 at PNC Park, allowing one run on two hits with seven strikeouts against two walks in 7.0 innings pitched.

DAY MAN: Today marks Keller's 10th day game start of the season, which will tie him for the National League lead in that category this season with PHI Zack Wheeler., WSH Jake Irving, SD Michael King and CIN Frankie Montas..Dating back to last season, this will be Keller's 23rd day game start, which is the third most among NL hurlers trailing only WSH Patrick Corbin (26) and PHI Zack Wheeler (24).

ON DECK: The Pirates have not announced a starter for the opening game of their series tomorrow night at Milwaukee.

LAST SEASON: In 2023, Mitch Keller set the franchise record by a right-handed pitcher with 210 strikeouts, surpassing the previous mark of 209 held by A.J. Burnett in 2013... Keller also rewrote the Pirates record book for strikeouts at various points throughout the season, including being the first pitcher in team history to record 90+ strikeouts prior to June 1 as well as being the first Pirates pitcher in the Modern Era (since 1900) to record eight or more strikeouts in seven consecutive starts from April 27-May 31.
