HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs and Brewers are meeting for the first time since Aug. 23-25, 2019 in Milwaukee.

- ◆ Pavin Smith has a 14-game hitting streak, batting .420 (21-for-50)/1.142 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home run, 8 RBI and 6 walks.
  - □ LONGEST HITTING STREAKS IN 2021 (\* ACTIVE): 19 G Nick Castellanos/CIN\*; 17 G - Jose Altuve/HOU; 14 G - Pavin Smith/ARI\*.
- ♦ Ketel Marte is batting .524 (11-for-21) with 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 6 RBI during his 5-game hitting streak.
- ♦ The D-backs have lost 14 consecutive road, tying the club record (also: May 18-June 18, 2010).

ROSTER MOVES: Earlier today, the D-backs reinstated Asbrúbal Cabrera from the 10-day injured list (strained right hamstring) and placed Seth Frankoff on the 10-day injured list (right forearm soreness).

♦ Domingo Leyba was claimed off waivers by the Orioles.. was designated for assignment on June 2.

- ◆ Darnell Coles (hitting coach) spent 4 seasons as hitting coach with Milwaukee (2015-18)...he also served as the Brewers' Minor League hitting coordinator (2010-11) and manager at Double-A Huntsville.
- ◆ Eric Hinske (assistant hitting coach) was born in Menasha, Wis....his 137 Major League home runs are the fourth most by a Wisconsin-born player, trailing Al Simmons (307), Andy Pafko (213) and Ken Keltner (163).
- ♦ Mike Fetters (bullpen coach) was named to the Brewers' Wall of Honor in 2014 after recording 79 saves in 289 games with Milwaukee from 1992-97.
- ◆ Joakim Soria played 26 games with the Brewers in 2018.
- ◆ Stephen Vogt hit .254 with 8 home runs and 20 RBI in 45 games with Milwaukee in 2017.
- ♦ Vaughn Robinson (Director, Skills Development) graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point in 2003 and worked as a strength & conditioning coach for the University of Wisconsin from 2003-04.

AT A GLANCE: First season in the Majors and fifth season with the D-backs' organization.

- D-backs 23rd-round pick in the 2017 draft out of University of South Alabama, the same college as Luis Gonzalez.
- · Signed by scout Kerry Jenkins, his first big leaguer.

LAST START: Recorded his first career win as a starter on May 30 vs. Cardinals...allowed 2 runs on 6 hits over 6.0 innings...struck out 6 and did not walk a batter.

VS. BREWERS: Is making his first career appearance.

BY THE NUMBERS: Opponents are 2-for-20 (.100) off his slider and 20-for-74 (.270) off his sinker

• Has not allowed a walk in his last 19.1 innings.

FROM THE SAWMILL TO THE MOUND: Stepped away from baseball as a junior due to injury.

- · Worked for his uncle at the family's sawmill company.
- Returned for his senior season and was drafted.
- "I never thought that I'd be wearing steel-toed boots covered with oil, welding just a few years ago in the sawmill to now wearing baseball spikes and pitching in the big leagues," Peacock told USA TODAY Sports.

AS A STARTER: Is making his fourth Major League start. Has gone 1-1 with a 3.31 ERA (6 ER in 16.1 IP).
