Scoring Late

The Braves scored three runs in yesterday's eighth inning for their only tallies of the game, and Atlanta's 172 runs from the eighth inning on stand as the third most in baseball. Only the Cubs (176) and Rockies (175) have scored more runs in the eighth or later this year.

Atlanta has hit .271/.340/.466 after the seventh inning this season, and its .806 OPS from the eighth inning on is highest in the majors. The Braves have 11 total triples on the season and five of them have come in the eighth or later, including Ozzie Albies' pinch-hit, three-base hit yesterday.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Phillies tonight open a three-game weekend series with what is the 11th of 13 scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...Today marks the fifth game in a span of eight days between the two, after Atlanta and Philadelphia split four games last weekend at Citizens Bank Park.

 Atlanta is 7-3 over the first 10 games with Philadelphia this season, and the Braves have already clinched the season series and any potential postseason tiebreakers...Atlanta last won the season set over Philadelphia with a 7-6 mark in 2024.

 The Braves and Phillies will play all 13 of their regular season matchups in two separate bursts over the six-month campaign...They met six times in 10 days in April, and will play their final seven games over a 10-day stretch that extends through this weekend.

 Atlanta went 2-1 against Philadelphia here at Truist Park earlier this season, April 24-26, and is 44-27 (.620) at home against the Phillies since the facility opened in 2017...Philadelphia's 44 defeats here since 2017 are its second most in any visiting stadium in that span (45 at Citi Field).

 RH Aaron Nola has pitched against the Braves more than any other team in his career, compiling a 17-12 record with a 3.73 ERA (102 ER/246.0 IP) over 40 total starts...The 6-foot-2, 200-pound native of Baton Rouge, LA, faced Atlanta just five days ago at Citizens Bank Park, and fired 7.0 one-run innings in a no-decision...In his lone start here at Truist Park this year, April 26, he allowed seven hits and six runs over 4.2 innings in the loss.

CHRIS SALE: Is set tonight to make the 11th start of his career against Philadelphia, and enters play 5-2 with a 3.20 ERA (21 ER/59.0 IP) and 77 strikeouts all time against the club...Tonight also marks his fourth start versus the Phillies this season, and he is a perfect 3-0 with a 1.42 ERA (3 ER/19.0 IP) against the club this year.

 The left-hander has pitched at least 6.0 innings and allowed no more than two runs in each of his last five starts against the Phillies, including 6.0 two-run innings last Friday night at Citizens Bank Park.

 Sale last started here at Truist Park on August 27, and fired a five-hit, 11-strikeout shutout versus the Dodgers...In 12 home starts this season, he is 8-3 with a 1.45 ERA (12 ER/74.1 IP) and 85 strikeouts...His 1.45 home ERA is the best in baseball among pitchers with as many starts in their home park.

 He fanned 11 in that shutout against Los Angeles, and with another 11 strikeouts tonight would pass Frank Tanana (2,773) for 26th in baseball's all-time annals for career strikeouts...Sale enters tonight with 2,763 career punchouts, and would move into sixth all time by a left-hander by passing Tanana.

 Sale's 2.10 ERA on the season ranks third in baseball among qualified pitchers, behind just Jacob deGrom (1.95) and Cam Schlichter (2.01).

THE NL EAST: The Braves and Phillies enter their final scheduled series of the regular season in first and second, respectively, in the National League East... Atlanta leads Philadelphia by 4.0 games, while both teams have 15 games remaining on their schedules... These two teams have combined to win the division in each of the previous eight seasons.

 Atlanta's magic number to win the NL East stands at 11, meaning that any combination of Braves wins and Phillies losses totaling 11 would clinch the division...Miami has an elimination number of just one, while New York and Washington have both already been eliminated from contention.

 Philadelphia has won consecutive NL East crowns in 2024 & 2025, while Atlanta won the previous six championships from 2018 through 2023... Washington was the last different team to claim the NL East title, doing so in 2017.

 Since the current iteration of the NL East was formed in 1994, Atlanta and Philadelphia have combined to win 25 of the 31 total division titles... Atlanta has 18 NL East championships in that span, while Philadelphia owns seven... Washington (four) and New York (two) also own division titles among the current division makeup, while Florida/Miami has never captured the title...No division champion was crowned in the debut season of 1994.

HITS AND RUNS: Atlanta collected five hits and scored three runs in yesterday afternoon's eighth inning, matching its hit total from the previous 20 combined innings dating to Tuesday night...The three runs matched the Braves' total from its previous three total games.

 Atlanta is batting just .145/.185/.205 over its last four games, dating to a two-hit shutout at Philadelphia on Monday...Five of the club's 17 total hits (29%) in that span came in five straight at-bats in yesterday's eighth inning...Outside of that span, the club has hit .107 (12-for-112).

 Just four of Atlanta's 17 hits over the last four games have gone for extra bases, and the club has only five walks compared to 23 strikeouts in the four affairs.

 This stretch comes after Atlanta scored 21 runs on 34 hits, including 15 extra-base hits, over a four-game stretch from last Wednesday in Washington to Sunday afternoon in Philadelphia.

HOME WORK: Atlanta tonight begins its penultimate home series of the regular season, and the Braves' 49-26 (.653) here at Truist Park is the second-best home record in baseball...Only Milwaukee, at 50-25 (.667) has been better.

 The Braves are 22-8 (.733) here at home since the All-Star break, and have lost just three series at Truist Park in that span.

 The Braves are 11-1 (.917) on Friday night home games this season...Since Truist Park opened in 2017, Atlanta's 79-45 (.637) record in home Friday games stand as the best winning percentage and most wins in such games across the league.

- Among players with at least 32 inherited runners, Fuentes' seven that he has allowed to score are tied for the fewest in the NL.
- From July 6-August 14, struck out 30 batters in his last 16 relief outings, becoming the first Braves reliever to do so since Michael Tonkin in 2023.
- Owns a 1.85 ERA (13 ER/63.1 IP) when pitching in relief, the third-best in the National League (min. 40 games)...The only other Braves rookie reliever to finish with a better mark (min. 40 games) was Peter Moylan (1.80) in 2007.
- Utilizes his four-seam fastball 69.0% of the time, the highest fastball usage in MLB (min. 40 appearances).

- Converted 35 consecutive save opportunities from July 28, 2025-July 6, 2026, the most by a Cuban-born player in MLB history.
