BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a stretch of 15 games in 14 days tonight which started with an April 30 doubleheader vs. the Astros...The Birds will play each of the next six days, including three-game sets against the Athletics and Yankees before enjoying an off-day on May 14.

⚾ Last night, the Birds were unable to secure their second series sweep of the 2026 campaign in a 4-3 setback at Miami...Baltimore fell to 2-5 (.286) in one-run affairs this season, the third-lowest winning percentage in such games in MLB ahead of New York-NL (.273) and Minnesota (1-4, .200).

⚾ O's pitching has allowed 3+ runs in 23 straight games since April 13, their longest streak since August 11-September 4 (G2), 2020 (also 23 G)...They last allowed 3+ runs in 24 straight during a 25-game stretch from July 24-August 19, 2019.

SOUTHPAW SWOON: The Orioles are 0-8 against opposing left-handed starting pitchers this season, the worst mark in the majors with the next closest club being the Mets (1-8, .111).

⚾ It is the second-longest season-opening losing skid in franchise history behind the 1988 Orioles, who dropped each of their first 11 contests, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

⚾ The Birds own a .624 OPS against left-handed starters, ranking 22nd in MLB, while their .756 OPS off left-handed relievers ranks ninth in MLB.

⚾ The Orioles faced a right-handed starter in a franchise-record 17 straight games to open the season, surpassing the previous record of 14 in 1975.

POLAR BEAR PETE: Pete Alonso has hit safely in a season-high eight straight games, batting .345 (10-for-29) with four doubles, three home runs, 10 runs, and nine RBI during that stretch.

⚾ He has reached base safely in 11 of 12 career games opposite the Athletics, including hits in nine of the contests, slashing .383/.474/.851 (18-for-47) with four doubles, six home runs, 14 runs, 17 RBI, eight walks, and one hit-by-pitch...His career 1.325 OPS against the Athletics is the highest of any player in MLB history (min. 50 PA), ahead of Barry Bonds (1.258) and SD's Fernando Tatis Jr. (1.217).

CAMDEN CONFINES: Adley Rutschman has reached base safely in each of his 11 games at Camden Yards this season, slashing .400/.442/.750 (16-for-40) with five doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, and three walks against three strikeouts...It is tied with NYM's Juan Soto for the fourth-longest active season-opening, home on-base streak in MLB this season behind CHC's Ian Happ (23 G), ATH's Nick Kurtz (16 G), and LAD's Shohei Ohtani (16 G).

⚾ Rutschman owns a 13-game home on-base streak dating to September 24, 2025, marking the third-longest such stretch of his career behind runs of 35 games (6/21-9/9/22) and 25 games (6/24-8/25/23).

PATIENCE IN A VIRUTE: The O's have drawn 154 walks this year, the fifth-highest clip in MLB behind the Cubs (179), Yankees (172), Brewers (162), and Guardians (156)...The Birds are averaging 9.33 plate appearances per walk, fourth best in the majors behind the Yankees (8.39), Cubs (8.44), and Brewers (8.44).

⚾ Taylor Ward is averaging 4.86 plate appearances per walk, third best in MLB behind ATH's Nick Kurtz (4.64) and LAA's Mike Trout (4.72)...His 35 walks overall are third most behind both Kurtz and Trout (each 36).

⚾ Baltimore has 17 games with 5+ walks, tied with Milwaukee for second most in MLB behind Chicago-NL (20)...The 2025 Orioles had 34 such games.

TWO'S ARE WILD: Baltimore pitching has allowed a .786 opponent OPS with two outs, the third-highest mark in the majors ahead of Houston (.833) and Texas (.797).

⚾ With two strikes, the opposition owns a .588 OPS, second highest in MLB ahead of only Colorado (.605).

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: Rico Garcia has posted a 0.53 ERA (1 ER/17.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts across 18 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

⚾ His .020 (1-for-51) opponent average and 0.41 WHIP are the best among all MLB relievers, outpacing MIA's John King (.063, 3-for-48) and SEA's Matt Brash (0.44 WHIP), respectively.

⚾ Prior to Garcia's current run, the fewest number of hits allowed by an Oriole through their first 18 outings of a season was four (Jesse Orosco, 1997).

⚾ He has yet to allow a hit in each of his eight home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of three Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with Bryan Baker (9 G, 2023) and Shawn Armstrong (8 G, 2019).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: Taylor Ward has reached base safely 73 times through his first 37 games with the O's (37 H, 35 BB, 1 HBP), the third-highest figure by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) behind both Roberto Alomar (76 TOB, 1996) and Frank Robinson (76 TOB, 1966)...The record through 38 games is 80, held by Alomar.

⚾ Ward's .429 on-base percentage is tied for third in MLB...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2nd, .410).

⚾ Ward has reached safely in 34 of the last 36 games since March 28 while slashing .287/.440/.411 (37-for-129) with 13 doubles, one homer, 26 runs scored, 12 RBI, 35 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles have played in 19 games decided by two runs or fewer, tied for fourth most in the majors behind the Mariners (22), Guardians (21), and Cardinals (20)...The Birds are 11-8 (.579) in those games.

'PEN PALS: Grant Wolfram has not allowed a home run in 34.0 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 39.2 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

⚾ The O's 15.7 percent inherited runners scored rate (8 IRS/51 IR) is second lowest in the majors behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR).

⚾ The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season and 75th of his career tonight in the series opener vs. the Athletics...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fourth loss of the season on May 2 at New York-AL, allowing five runs on six hits (2 HR) and four walks (1 IBB) in 4.0 innings with four strikeouts...The five runs and two homers were season highs, while the four walks tied a season high (2x, last: 4/26 vs. BOS)...Threw 89 pitches, 51 strikes.

👉 Has allowed four home runs over his last three starts, tied for the most over a three-game span in his career (8x, last: 6/14/24-9/1/25)

CALIFORNIA LOVE: Bradish is scheduled to make his second career start vs. the Athletics, earning the win with 6.0 scoreless innings on two hits, one walk, and one hit batter with eight strikeouts in his lone start on April 20, 2023...Is 5-0 with a 1.22 ERA (9 ER/66.1 IP) over 11 career starts opposite the AL West with eight quality starts...Has allowed two runs or fewer in each of those 11 starts with five scoreless appearances.

👉 Holds a 3.94 ERA (120 ER/274.1 IP) in 53 career starts vs. the American League compared to his 2.84 ERA (37 ER/117.1 IP) in 21 starts against the National League.

BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL: Bradish owns a 51.6 percent first-pitch strike rate, the third-lowest mark in the majors (min. 30.0 IP), ahead of LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (51.4%) and CLE's Joey Cantillo (51.2%).

👉 Recorded a 57.0 percent first-pitch strike rate (12/21) in his last start at New York-AL.

👉 In his six starts last season, Bradish posted a 63.5 percent first-pitch strike rate.

WALK DON'T RUN: Bradish's 13.4 percent walk rate this season is the highest of his career (9.2%; 2024) and is the seventh-highest mark in the majors (min. 30.0 IP) behind leader PIT's Bubba Chandler (17.1%)...His 21 walks in seven starts this season are his most over any seven-game span in his career with the next closest being his 18 walks from Septmeber 27, 2022-May 6, 2023.

PLATOON: Bradish allowed a career-high-tying six hits (3 2B) to lefties in his last start on May 2 at New York-AL (also 4/25/23 vs. BOS)...Left handers have gone 20-for-70 (.286) with 10 extra-base hits (6 2B, 3B, 3 HR) over his last five starts after holding them to a .118 (2-for-17) clip with one double over his first two starts this season.

👉 His .396 opponent average against right-handed hitters (19-for-48) is the highest in the majors (min. 45 AB), with the next closest being SEA's Luis Castillo (.366, 26-for-71) and PHI's Andrew Painter (.365, 19-for-52).

👉 Righties are batting .364 (8-for-22) against his slider compared to a .136 (3-for-22) mark for left-handed batters.

SLIDE AWAY: Bradish's .477 slugging percentage on his slider is the fourth-highest mark in the majors (min. 40 AB ending in the pitch) ahead of STL's Matthew Liberatore (.500), ATH's Jeffrey Springs (.571), and MIN's Simeon Woods Richardson (.625).

👉 Opponents slashed .063/.063/.156 (2-for-32) off his slider with one home run in 2025.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP SHANE BAZ (1-3, 4.99)

LAST TIME OUT: Baz suffered his third loss of the season in his last start on May 4 at New York-AL, allowing six runs (5 ER) on five hits (1 HR) and five walks (1 IBB) over 5.2 innings with four strikeouts...The five walks tied a career high (also 7/21/24 at NYY)...Threw 96 pitches, 54 strikes.

Vs. ATHLETICS: Baz is scheduled to make his fourth career start opposite the Athletics, going 1-1 with a 2.91 ERA (7 ER/21.2 IP)...Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in each of those starts, including 7.2 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with Tampa Bay in a 1-0 win on August 20, 2024...Marked the second-longest scoreless outing of his career behind June 26, 2025 at Kansas City (8.0 IP).
