AROUND THE HORN

TEACHER APPRECIATION NIGHT ON MONDAY: The D-backs will celebrate teachers and administrators with Teacher Appreciation Night, presented by FOX10...the Special Event Ticket Pack includes a limited-edition teacher-themed coffee mug and a pregame parade.
ASU NIGHT ON TUESDAY: The D-backs invite the Sun Devils to come together for the start of the school year with ASU Night...the Special Event Ticket Pack includes a co-branded D-backs x ASU Merrill Kelly jersey.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 5-3 in their last 8 games.

- The D-backs are 8-2 in their last 10 games vs. Giants and 11-3 in their last 14 overall since Sept. 10, 2025.
- The D-backs are 4-1 in their last 5 road games @ Giants and 9-5 over their last 14 road games @ Giants.
- **Tim Tawa** has a career-best 13-game on-base streak, hitting .283 (13-for-46)/.822 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Jose Fernandez** has hit safely in 7 of his last 9 games at a .333 clip (8-for-24)/.846 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 RBI, 4 walks and 2 stolen bases.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 6-1 @ Giants.

- **Gabriel Moreno** hit a game-tying solo homer in the fourth inning.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** had 2 singles and 1 walk.
- **José Cabrera** worked 4.1 innings with 2 runs on 3 hits and 1 walk with 4 strikeouts.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled LHP **Kohl Drake** from Triple-A Reno and, following last night’s game, optioned RHP **Juan Burgos** to Triple-A Reno.

ONE SATURDAY STARTER: RHP **Merrill Kelly (8-12, 5.35)** will be one of Saturday’s starting pitchers.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 1.5 games behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 3.5 games behind the Phillies (WC2, lead season 2-1) and 5.5 games behind the Cubs (WC1).

WIN THE SERIES: The D-backs are 9-3-1 in their 13 series post-All-Star break.

ROAD LIFE @ NL WEST: The D-backs are 4-1 in their last 5 games @ NL West and 9-3 in their last 12 road games @ NL West.

LUCKY 13?: Entering this series, the D-backs were 7-4-1 in their last 12 series vs. NL West.

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs’ 26 wins (26-17) since July 9 are tied for second in the Majors with the Padres (26) and Braves (26), behind the Red Sox (31) and ahead of the Brewers (25), Rays (25) and Yankees (25).

HOMER HAPPY: The D-backs have homered in 3 straight games (3 HR) and 14 of their last 17 games (19 HR).

- Among all teams since Aug. 9, the D-backs 19 home runs are tied for eighth.
- The D-backs have homered in 6 straight road games vs. NL West (8 HR).

MORENO OVER THE LAST YEAR: **Gabriel Moreno**, in 135 games since last Aug. 22, is hitting .305 (146-for-479)/.855 OPS with 32 doubles, 1 triple, 15 homers, 86 RBI and 66 walks.

- Among all players since Aug. 22, 2025 (min. 500 PA), ranks in AVG (4th, .305), OBP (5th, .386), OPS (16th, .855).

PACING FOR A CLUB RECORD: **Juan Morillo** (2.24 in 56 G) **Brandyn Garcia** (2.37 in 45 G), **Jonathan Loáisiga** (2.53 in 55 G) and **Taylor Clarke** (2.54 in 60 G) are pacing to become the D-backs’ first group of 4 relievers to post a sub 2.75 ERA in a season (min. 40 G):

- **2012:** Craig Breslow (2.70 in 40 G), David Hernandez (2.50 in 72 G), Brad Ziegler (2.49 in 77 G)
- **2007:** Brandon Lyon (2.68 in 73 G), Doug Slaten (2.72 in 61 G), José Valverde (2.66 in 65 G)
- **2003:** Matt Mantei (2.62 in 50 G), José Valverde (2.15 in 54 G), Óscar Villarreal (2.57 in 86 G)

STREAKING VS. GIANTS: **Geraldo Perdomo’s** 15-game on-base streak vs. Giants is the fourth-longest active streak vs. Giants, behind Sal Frelick/MIL (16), Kyle Schwarber/PHI (19) and Bryce Harper/PHI (28).

- **Gabriel Moreno’s** 13-game on-base streak vs. Giants is the sixth-longest active streak vs. Giants.

DOMO-NATING AUGUST: **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 8 of his last 9 games, batting .375 (12-for-32)/.897 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 RBI and 5 walks.

- In 24 games in August, is hitting .348 (32-for-92)/.875 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 10 walks.

COMEBACK KIDS: The D-backs’ 40 comeback wins are tied for the most in the Majors with the Cubs (40).

- The D-backs’ 19 road comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (18) and Red Sox (17).
- The 19 road comeback wins are third-most in franchise history behind 20 in 1999 and 22 in 2011.

VS. RIGHTY STARTERS: Since Aug. 1, these D-backs rank among the NL’s Top 20 vs. right-handed starters:

- **Tim Tawa** is eighth with a 1.057 OPS, tied for eighth with a .645 SLG, ninth with a .355 AVG, 11th with a .412 OBP
- **Gabriel Moreno** is tied for fourth with 6 XBH, seventh with a .647 SLG, ninth with a 1.032 OPS, 17th with a .324 AVG

GET TO THE ‘PEN: The D-backs offense vs. relievers since Aug. 1, ranks among all teams in OBP (4th, .355), SLG (4th, .434), OPS (4th, .790), total bases (4th, 152), XBH (T-6th, 31), AVG (7th, .257) and runs (9th, 55).

LATE ACTION: The D-backs offense in the seventh-ninth innings ranks among all teams since Aug. 14 in OPS (2nd, .829), total bases (1st, 64), XBH (4th, 13), runs (6th, 21) and times on base (4th, 58).

VS. GIANTS: The D-backs swept their first road series from May 25-27.

- The D-backs have won 4 consecutive series.
- The D-backs are 7-2-1 in their last 10 series.
