RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their six-game (NYM-3, DET-3) road trip today with the finale of a three-game weekend series against the New York Mets at Citi Field...the Cardinals secured their 3rd-straight win yesterday, 7-4, their longest win streak of the season... St. Louis has won four of its last five games, improving to 13-14 on the young season...they are 8-7 in road games, and have won consecutive road series...a win today would give them their 1st series sweep of the year and their 1st sweep at Citi Field since Sept. 13-15, 2021

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis opens today in 5th place in the National League Central, 4.5 games behind first place Milwaukee (17-9) and 1/2-game back of Pittsburgh (14-14) for 4th place.

PATH TO THE 10TH TITLE: The Cardinals are retracing their steps from 2006 with their current road trip through New York and Detroit ... The 2006 Cardinals captured their 10th World Series title in franchise history after eliminating the Mets in seven games in the NLCS and then beating the Detroit Tigers in five games in the Fall Classic as closer Adam Wainwright recorded final outs via strikeout in both series (Carlos Beltrán looking & **Brandon Inge** swinging).

START SPREADING THE NEWS: Despite a 26-27 all-time record at Citi Field, St. Louis enters today winners of 12 of its last 17 games in Queens while outscoring the Mets 95-77. MEET THE METS: The Cardinals and Mets are scheduled to play their entire six-game season series over the next 13 days (April 26-28 in Queens & May 6-8 in St. Louis).

WINNING HAND: Cardinals closer Ryan Helsley has won or saved 11 of the Cardinals 13 wins this season (85 pct.), the most in the team's 1st 27 games since Hall of Famer Lee Smith also did so in 1991 (9 saves, 2 wins) representing 79 pct of their 14 wins that year...Helsley's 9 saves in the 1st

27 games are the team's most since **Trevor Rosenthal** also had 9 thru 27 team games in 2015 (Orf).

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Cardinals (3.31, 3rd) & Mets (2.81, 1st) rank among the top three in the National League in bullpen ERA.

- LHP JoJo Romero and RHP Andrew Kittredge share the MLB lead with 10 holds this season.
- RHP Ryan Helsley ranks among 2024 MLB leaders in appearances (15, T-1st), games finished (14, 1st), and saves (9, T-4th).
- Since the 2022 season, Helsley and Edwin Diaz rank among the top five MLB relievers in ERA, average against, opponent OPS, hits/9, baserunners/9, and WHIP (minimum 70 innings pitched).

LINE DRIVES: Rookie shortstop Masyn Winn, who made his MLB debut last September vs. the Mets, currently sports the 2nd-highest line drive percentage (34.5%) in Major League Baseball behind Mookie Betts (34.7%).

NOLAN KEEPS ROLLIN': Nolan Arenado has reached base safely in 25 consecutive games since March 30, the longest active onbase streak in Major League Baseball.

- Arenado's 25-game on-base streak is his longest as a Cardinal & 5th 20+ game OB streak of his career (30-straight in 2014).
- Arenado, who is the lone Cardinal to have played in all 27 games to begin the season, has reached base safely in 25 games overall (T-5th in MLB), has hits in 22 games (T-4th in MLB), and leads St. Louis in hits (29) and is 2nd in total bases (38).

FINEST IN THE FIELD: The Cardinals .990 fielding percentage is 3rd-highest in MLB behind Washington (.993) and Atlanta (.992), while St. Louis is one of four MLB teams with 10 or fewer errors.

NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

Steven Matz was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

Tommy Edman doubled off **Steven Matz** for his first career MLB hit (June 14, 2019 at Citi Field).

Brendan Donovan (April 25, 2022 at Busch III), and **Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

Cardinals Hall of Famer José Oquendo played the first two seasons MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with Mark Davis to St. Louis for John Young and Angel Salazar (April 2, 1985).

Adam Ottavino was selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#30 overall) of the 2006 MLB Draft. pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2006-11)...made his MLB debut with St. Louis in 2010.

José Quintana made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals in 2022...acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris** Stattron from Pittsburgh in exchange for Johan Oviedo and Malcom Nuñez. Matt Carpenter's younger brother, Tyler, played two seasons in the Mets organization (2011-12).

Harrison Bader was selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in St. Louis (2017-22) where he won the 2021 NL Gold Glove in center field.

Mets Pitching Coach Jeremy Hefner pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Hall of Fame Manager Joe Torre played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator Scott **Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster Keith Hernandez was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

Mets VP of Amateur Scouting Kris Gross was a Cardinals amateur scout for three seasons (2010-12)

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y....graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Cardinals reporter Jim Hayes was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...graduated from SUNY-Geneseo.

Tylor Megill's older brother, Trevor Megill, was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign, returning to Loyola Marymount (Calif.) University.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Jason Isringhausen was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Cardinals reporter Mark Sweeney was traded to the Mets with **Jeromy Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)...attended Spring Training with New York before released (March 13, 2002).

Cardinals AGM/Player Dev. Gary LaRocque previously served as Scouting Dir., AGM & VP/ Player Dev. and Scouting with the Mets from (1998-2005)...appointed VP of Pro Scouting in 2006.

- Was the Cardinals home opening starting pitcher for the first time in his career (4/4 vs. MIA).
- Is 68 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 85.1 innings for 2,000.
- Returns to his original drafting team in 2024 for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- · Was teammates with current Cardinals manager Oliver Marmol in Quad Cities (2008) and Palm Beach (2009).
- Ranks 2nd behind only Adam Wainwright (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals.
- Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals. T-3rd in franchise history behind Chris Carpenter (10) and Bob Gibson (7).
- · Won a career-high 18 games with St. Louis in 2012, his first full season as a starting

LAST TIME OUT

- Hurled 5.0 innings in a no decision exiting with a 3-0 deficit as the Cardinals rallied to win on a walk-off two-run home run in a 5-3 win over ARI.
- · Surpassed Bill Doak (938) and moved into 9th place all-time Cardinals history when he struck out Christian Walker in the 1st inning.

BUSCH STADIUM III (2006-PRESENT)

- Has never pitched at Busch Stadium as a visitor. Before the Home Opener (4/4/23), his previous appearance in St. Louis was Sept. 28, 2017 vs. the Cubs (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 R, 5 K).
- His start tonight marks the 80th of his career at Busch Stadium III, 2nd-most in stadium history (2006-present) behind only Adam Wainwright (214).
- Is seeking his 1st win at Busch III since 9/12/17 vs. CIN (13-4).

- Surpassed Carlos Martinez (927) and Bill Doak (939) this season vaulting into 9th place all-time in Cardinals history for strikeouts.
- Recorded his first win as a member of the Cardinals since 2017 coming at OAK (4/16), firing a season-high 7.0 innings allowing two runs (1 ER) and one strikeout. Marked the first time in his career he had thrown 7.0 or more innings in a start and recorded one strikeout or less.

CAREER

- Member of the 2011 Cardinals World Series Championship team and the 2013 National League Champions.
- Two-time All-Star with the National League (2012, did not pitch) and the American League (2021). Pitched a scoreless inning at Coors Field (7/12/21) in relief of starting pitcher Shohei Ohtani. Current teammates Kyle Gibson and Andrew Kittredge also pitched for the A.L. in that game.
- Placed in the Top 10 in the American League Cy Young Award voting in 2019 (5th), 2020 (6th) and 2021 (3rd).
- · Recorded 26 double-digit strikeout games, 19th among pitchers since 2012, when he
