TODAY'S GAME: With the series even at a game apiece, the Giants can take the series with a win this afternoon..SF is looking for its first road series win in a series of 2+ games since June 16-17 in Atlanta, when they swept what turned out to be a shortened two-game series due to a rainout on June 18.

- ▶ The last road series of 3+ games the Giants have won this year was June 5-7 at the Cubs.
- ▶ With the win last night, the Giants ensured they will avoid the second 100-loss season in franchise history.

TODAY'S STARTER: **RHP Anthony Molina** toes the slab for San Francisco in today's finale looking to put a tough one behind him from last Friday versus San Diego.

- ▶ After working 14.1 innings across his first three games (two starts) in a Giants uniform and allowing five runs (three earned) with 13 strikeouts, Molina allowed a career-high tying seven runs on a career-high tying nine hits in 3.0 innings last Friday in a 7-5 loss to the Padres at Oracle Park.

DAAAANG, THAT'S BRYCE!: IF Bryce Eldridge clobbered the longest homer of his young MLB career yesterday with his 461' 1st-inning homer...it was the Giants' longest homer this season outside of Coors Field, surpassing a 446' blast by **Jonah Cox** on June 5 at Wrigley.

- ▶ The 461' shot last night was also the longest homer hit this season at Busch Stadium and the longest there since August 16, 2024 when STL's Pedro Pagés hit a 462' homer off LAD's Justin Wrobleksi.
- ▶ Eldridge's homer yesterday came at 112.7 mph off the bat, the hardest-hit homer by a Giant this season...he has three of SF's top-5 furthest hit homers of the year as well.
- ▶ With his 2-for-4 day, Eldridge is now hitting .340/.424/.557 with 28 RBI over his last 28 games...his 28 RBI since August 14 are third-most in the Majors behind teammate **Rafael Devers** (34) and CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (29).

EYE CHART: SF drew five walks last night and in 14 games this month, has a 9.7% walk rate, which would be their best walk rate in a month this year..*see chart on the right.*

- ▶ It's not a direct correlation, but in 14 games this month the Giants are averaging 5.43 runs/game, up from their year-long average of 4.23 runs/game (23rd in MLB).
- ▶ Overall, SF's walk rate for the season is a Major League-worst 7.4% with league average being 8.9%.

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYOFFS: Single-A San Jose evened up its Cal League Championship Series last night by tossing the third no-hitter in SJ Giants history in a 9-1 win...**RHP Argenis Cayama** (SF's #17 prospect according to *MLB.com*) spun the first 5.0 no-hit innings while a pair of 2026 draftees in **RHP Ian Korn** (10th round) and **RHP Eric Nachtshiem** (sixth round) finished it with 2.0 hitless innings apiece...it was the first no-no for San Jose since 2009 and their first one overall in a playoff game in team history...they play a deciding Game 3 tonight in San Jose as they try to win consecutive California League titles.

- ▶ Double-A Richmond fell to Erie last night in Erie, 18-6, and has today off as the best-of-three Eastern League Division Series shifts to Richmond tomorrow...Giants' 2026 first-round pick **RHP Jackson Flora** will start that game for the Flying Squirrels.

WE'RE GONNA NEED A BIGGER MANTLE: Minor League Baseball announced its High-A All-Star teams...Eugene, who had the best record in the league at 79-52 before losing the NWL Championship Series, had four players named to the All-Star team...they took home three of the four year-end awards.

- ▶ **LHP Jacob Bresnahan** (starting pitcher), **OF Dakota Jordan** (outfield), **IF Jhonny Level** (utility) and **RHP Ryan Vanderhei** (reliever) all made the NWL Post-Season All-Star team while Bresnahan was the NWL's Pitcher of the Year after going 7-3 with a 2.92 ERA in 20 starts and Level was tabbed the Top MLB Prospect after slashing .302/.363/.473 with eight homers and 40 RBI...Eugene **MGR Jacob Heyward** was named the league's Manager of the Year, his second career award (also 2025 ACL Manager of the Year).

MO MONEY: The 24-year-old from San Joaquin, VZ, was acquired the night before the trade deadline from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for RHP Tyler Mahle...SF is the third club Molina has appeared with in the Majors, as he spent 2024-2025 with Colorado and 2026 with Atlanta and San Francisco.

LAST TIME OUT: Saw his streak of three straight wins to start his Giants career come to an end in a loss to the Padres at Oracle Park... allowed seven earned runs on nine hits and two walks along with four strikeouts over 3.0 innings pitched...the seven runs/earned runs and nine hits both tied career-highs.

VS. THE CARDINALS: Has faced the Cardinals once, which also came on the road when he was a member of the Rockies...he tossed 2.0 innings out of the bullpen on June 7, 2024, allowing one run on three hits with one strikeout.

WITH THE GIANTS: Molina won each of his first three appearances with SF and had a 1.88 ERA (3er, 14.1ip), 13 strikeouts, and 0.70 WHIP in that span before taking the loss last time out...he was the first Giants pitcher to earn the win in each of his first three appearances with the team since **Alex Wood** in 2021.

JUST A BLIP?: Over his first three appearances with SF, Molina held opponents to a .120 average (3x25) off his four-seamer with eight strikeouts, which he threw 54.7% of the time...in his last start, he threw the four-seamer 40% of the time and the Padres went 5-for-9 with four doubles off of it (.556)...in his time with Atlanta this season, he threw his fastball just 36.4% of the time and opponents were 3-for-8 against it (.375)... furthermore, opponents were just 1-for-12 (.083) with three strikeouts against his changeup over his first three starts with SF versus 3-for-4 with a triple in his most recent outing.

WITH THE BRAVES: Pitched in three games for Atlanta this year prior to being traded (May 1, June 14 and June 16), posting a 5.40 ERA (3er, 5.0ip), and a 1.40 WHIP...Molina was originally claimed off waivers by Atlanta from Colorado on December 5, 2025 before being outrighted on December 19...was optioned between Atlanta and Triple-A Gwinnett four times this year prior to his trade to SF.

THIS SEASON IN TRIPLE-A: Spent the majority of this season in Triple-A for Gwinnett (ATL) and Sacramento (SF)...in total, he was 3-2 with a 3.55 ERA (25er, 63.1ip), 65 strikeouts and a 1.22 WHIP in 21 games (12 starts) at the Triple-A level.

LAST SEASON: Went 1-1 with a 7.27 ERA (28er, 34.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in 17 games (one start) for the Rockies in 2025...had a .351 opposing batting average (52x148) and a 1.67 WHIP... in 15 starts at Triple-A Albuquerque, he went 4-5 with a 6.59 ERA (51er, 69.2ip), 30 walks and 51 strikeouts.

WORLD CHAMP: Pitched for 2026 World Baseball Classic Champion Team Venezuela, making two appearances out of the bullpen.

JOURNEY TO THE SHOW: Molina debuted in the Majors on Opening Day in 2024 with Colorado as a Rule 5 selection from Tampa Bay... at 22 years, 76 days old he became the ninth-youngest pitcher to debut in Rockies history.
