TODAY'S GAME: Having lost the series, the Giants will try and salvage a game in the finale this afternoon before heading into tomorrow's off day.

- ▶ With last night's loss the Giants have now lost five consecutive home games here at Oracle Park dating to May 25...SF's 12-18 (.400) mark here at home is tied for third-lowest in the Majors with the A's and is second-lowest in the NL overall ahead of only the Nationals (12-20, .375).
- ▶ The Giants have lost seven of their last nine games here at home to the Nationals dating to May 10, 2023...if you take it back to 2022, the Giants are 4-10 against Nationals at Oracle Park while being outscored 81-53 (-28 run diff).
- ▶ Today's game is ending a stretch of 13 consecutive games for the Giants that dates back to May 29...the Giants have gone 5-7 through the previous 12 games (1-2 at Colorado, 2-2 at Milwaukee, 2-1 at Chicago-NL and 0-2 thus far vs. the Nats).

ROSTER MOVES: LHP Reiver Sanmartín (#48) has been returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 60-day injured list...in corresponding moves, RHP **Tristan Beck** was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento and **OF Will Brennan** was designated for assignment.

TODAY'S STARTER: LHP **Robbie Ray** starts the finale looking to play the stopper, a role he's done very well in so far in 2026...in eight games following a Giants' loss, Ray owns a 2.47 ERA (7er, 43.2ip)...SF is 5-3 in those games.

- ▶ Last time out, Ray blanked the Cubs over 5.0 innings at Wrigley Field last Friday in SF's 18-3 victory...he still walked five and allowed two hits but it was his first time allowing two or fewer runs in just under a month.
- ▶ Ray, who was originally drafted by the Nationals back in 2010, faces the Nats for an 11th time in his career and second time this season...back on April 19 in the District, Ray allowed three runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings to draw a tough-luck loss in SF's 3-0 defeat.

LEE JUNG HOO, SO HOT RIGHT NOW: OF **Jung Hoo Lee** extended his hitting streak to 17 games by going 2-for-5 last night...the streak is the longest active streak in the Majors and tied for the third-longest by any player in the Majors this year with ATL's Ozzie Albies.

- ▶ The 17-game hitting streak is the longest by a Giants batter since a 17-game streak by **Donovan Solano** July 25-August 15, 2020...the last time a Giants player had an 18-game streak was when **OF Ángel Pagán** had a 19-game streak in 2016 (also the last longer streak by a Giants outfielder).
- ▶ Lee is slashing .500/.514/.647 with 15 runs, five doubles, a triple, a homer, 10 RBI and two stolen bases over the 17-game streak.
- ▶ Lee's streak has raised his batting average from .265 at the start of the streak to .335, second-best in MLB behind Miami's Otto Lopez (.341).

DON'T GRAB THE WINDEX: Several other Giants are also streaking offensively entering play today.

- ▶ **IF Bryce Eldridge** is riding a 16-game on-base streak, tied for the seventh-longest active streak in the Majors...he's slashing .407/.492/.667 (1.1159 OPS) with eight doubles, two homers, 10 walks and 14 runs scored during the run.
- ▶ **IF Luis Arraez** is riding a season-best 10-game hitting streak into play today (15x44, .341)...Arraez's .326 season average is fourth-best in the Majors.

MUCH NEEDED R&R: The Giants will take advantage of their first off day in two weeks tomorrow before once again matching up with the Cubs for a second consecutive weekend.

- ▶ SF took two-of-three from the Cubbies last weekend at Wrigley and they've been quite good against the Cubs here at home as of late.
- ▶ Since 2021, the Giants have won four of the five home series played against the North Siders (except 2023) and are 13-5 against the Cubs at home in that time overall.
- ▶ Furthermore that 2023 home series loss to the Cubs is the Giants only home series loss to the Cubs dating all the way back to 2014 (the two clubs did not play each other in 2020).

ON THE UP: SF's High-A affiliate the Eugene Emeralds secured a spot in the postseason later this year by securing the best record in the NWL in the first half with a win over Spokane last night...the Emeralds are 40-18.

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Earned the win in his last start on June 5 at Wrigley Field...tossed 5.0-scoreless innings and allowed two hits and five walks with four strikeouts in the Giants 18-3 win over the Cubs.

PAGING DR. ROBBY: Over his first eight starts this season, Ray posted a 3-4 record with a 2.76 ERA (14er, 45.2ip) and a 1.09 WHIP...in his last five outings, he's gone 1-2 with a 6.95 ERA (17er, 22.0ip) and a 2.05 WHIP.

SLIP AND SLIDE: Ray's slider has been different this year with his average velo dropping from 88mph to 85mph...he's also allowed four HR with it compared to seven all of last year...opponents are hitting .258 off his slider this season, compared to a .206 average last year...furthermore, his strike rate with the pitch this year has gone down to 55% (from 63% last year)...he's also throwing it more this year with almost a six percentage points increase over last year (S/S).

LACK OF SUPPORT: Has received one or zero runs of support in six of his 13 outings...entered his start on May 31 with a 3.07 run support average, the sixth-lowest in the Majors...however, Ray received 11 runs of support in his outing on May 31 at Coors Field and 16 runs of support in his last start on June 5 at Wrigley, which brought his run support average up 3.18 points to a 6.25, which is now the ninth-best figure in the Majors (min. 60.0ip).

AGAINST THE NATIONALS: Will make his 11th career start against the Nationals...has posted a 3-6 record with a 5.13 ERA (30er, 52.2ip) and 59 strikeouts over his 10 career outings...he faced Washington earlier this year on April 19th and suffered the loss as he threw 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits and one walk with seven strikeouts in the Giants 3-0 loss to the Nationals... he's never faced Washington at Oracle Park.

HOME VS. ROAD: Has pitched better in his six starts at home, going 3-1 with a 2.78 ERA and a .188 opponents average, compared to a 1-5 record with a 5.35 ERA in seven starts on the road...San Francisco has won five of his six starts at home and dropped five of his seven starts on the road...last season Ray posted virtually equal stats at home vs. the road.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers are 9-for-their-last-27 (.333) off him with three doubles and a triple...lefties were just 4-for-28 (.200) with no extra base hits off him to start the year...he has yet to allow a home run to a left handed hitter, however, he's allowed 13 homers against right handed hitters this season, which is the most of any pitcher in MLB vs. RHBs.

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup
Last Game: 6/9 vs. WSH; 1.0ip, h, r, er, 2k (23 pitches)

- ▶ Has a 2.20 ERA (4er, 16.1ip) in his last 10 games.
- ▶ Has a 1.53 ERA (3er, 17.2ip) in 13 road games...has a 4.96 ERA (9er, 16.1ip) in 10 games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 12 of 23 contests (4.5 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .206 (7-for-34) off his slider, .241 (13-for-54) off his sinker and .235 (4-for-17) off his changeup.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP (HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker
Last Game: 6/9 vs. WSH; 0.2ip, h, 2bb, k (26 pitches)

- ▶ Has made 12 appearances with SF, logging 9.1 innings and allowing three runs (two earned) on six hits and 11 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has walked 13 batters in the 9.1 innings (12.5 BB/9ip).
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-16 off him while lefties are 6-for-18.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP (kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 6/7 at CHC; 1.0ip, k (6 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0 innings in May but has thrown 4.2 scoreless innings with three hits and 5K's in his last five games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 11-for-60 (.183) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 9-for-46 (.196) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup
Last Game: 6/9 vs. WSH; 0.0ip, h, r, er, 2bb (14 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed 17 walks in his 19.1ip (7.9 BB/9.0)...his 18.9% walk rate is fourth-highest in the Majors (min. 90 batters faced).
- ▶ Has allowed just one home run in his last 64.1 innings pitched dating back to August 14, 2024.
- ▶ Right-handers are 6-for-36 (.167) off him while left-handers are 10-for-36 (.278).
- ▶ Holding opponents 4-for-27 (.148) off his slider and 7-for-36 (.194) off his sinker.

#48 REIVER SANMARTÍN ▶ LHP (RAY-ver san-mar-TEEN)

Pitch Arsenal: Changeup, Sinker, Slider, 4-Seam FB
Last Game: 6/7 vs. TAC (w/AAA); 1.2ip, 3k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab and reinstated from the 60-day IL today...is seeking his Giants debut.
- ▶ Missed SF's first 68 games with a right hip flexor strain that he suffered in a WBC exhibition game while pitching for Colombia.
- ▶ In 10 rehab appearances (two with the ACL Giants and eight at Triple-A Sacramento), Sanmartín was 1-1 with a 6.52 ERA (7er, 9.2ip)...he struck out 10, walked two and allowed one homer.
- ▶ In three appearances for the River Cats this month he'd allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits in 3.2 innings with four strikeouts...39 of his 51 pitches were for strikes.
- ▶ Has 62 games of MLB experience, all coming with the Reds from 2021-2023 and one game last season...owns a 5.66 ERA in his 62 career games with 73 strikeouts in 84.1 career innings.
- ▶ Was claimed off waivers by SF last November.

#77 CARSON SEYMOUR ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Slider, Changeup
Last Game: 6/5 at CHC; 3.0ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, hr, bb, k (45 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento last Friday.
- ▶ Was 3-2 with a 4.04 ERA (22er, 49.0ip) and 23 strikeouts in 11 games (nine starts) with the River Cats this season.
- ▶ In his last three starts with Sacramento leading up to his recall, Seymour was 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3er, 16.0ip) and 15 strikeouts.
- ▶ Had a 3.38 ERA (10er, 26.2ip) in 13 games out of the bullpen for SF in 2025...also made three starts, posting a 8.68 ERA (9er, 9.1ip) and .325 BAA as a starter.
- ▶ His most effective pitch last season was his four-seamer...batters were 5-for-31 against it (.161) with eight strikeouts.

#66 DYLAN SMITH ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sweeper, Splitter, Sinker
Last Game: 6/9 vs. WSH; 1.0ip, bb, k (23 pitches)

- ▶ Has thrown each of the last three days (37 total pitches).
- ▶ Recorded the first save of his MLB career Sunday, pitching a scoreless 10th inning at Chicago-NL.
- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on June 2, his second recall of the season...has made five appearances so far for SF, throwing 4.0 scoreless innings with two walks and four strikeouts.
- ▶ Had a 3.98 ERA (9er, 20.1ip) .205 BAA and 23 strikeouts in 15 games with the River Cats.
- ▶ Acquired from Detroit on March 30 in exchange for cash.
- ▶ Drafted by Detroit on the third round in 2021 out of the University of Alabama...had spent the past five seasons in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut with Detroit last season...in 12 career MLB games he's 1-0-1 with a 1.06 ERA (2er, 17.0ip) with seven walks and eight strikeouts.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider
Last Game: 6/8 vs. WSH; L, 0.2ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, k, hbp (22 pitches)

- ▶ The three hits he allowed Monday night were the most he'd allowed in any relief appearance this year (29 games)...his HBP last night was his first of the season.
- ▶ Over his last six games dating to May 26 he's allowed seven runs (six earned) on 10 hits (two homers) over 7.1 innings (7.36 ERA).
- ▶ Has allowed just two of is 10 inherited runners to score this season.
- ▶ 20 of his 29 appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Opponents are just 21-for-108 (.194) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 10-for-54 (.185) with 18 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His is 27.7% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 4% of MLB.

- ▶ Enters play today with 996 career hits, four shy of 1,000.
- ▶ Is just 4-for-his-last-29 (.160) at the plate dating to his last at-bat on June 2...is 6-for-34 (.176) overall this month.
- ▶ Has eight homers in his last 21 games dating to May 18...had just three home runs in 46 games prior.
- ▶ Dating back to May 10, his 23 RBI rank as the third-most in the Majors, behind Nick Kurtz (29) and Ketel Marte (27).
- ▶ 30 of his 63 hits this year have been for extra-bases (18 2Bs, a 3B, 11 HRs)...his 18 doubles this year are tied for fifth-most in MLB.
- ▶ Is 11-for-his-last-35 (.314) with RISP after going 3x27 (.111) prior.
