WORDS ON THE BIRDS: Following last night's rainout, the St. Louis Cardinals will again try to open their three-game Memorial Day weekend series at Great American Ball Park when they face the Cincinnati Reds for the first time in 2026 with a day/night split double-header... following this weekend's series, the Cardinals will visit Milwaukee for a three-game series at American Family Field that opens on Memorial Day...the Cardinals completed a 3-3 homestand (2-1 vs. KC, 1-2 vs. PIT) on Thursday with a 6-2 loss to the Pirates that handed them their 3rd loss in last four games and leveled their home record at 13-13...the Cardinals are 15-8 in road games this season - tied with the Padres for the 2nd best road win pct. (.652) in MLB behind Atlanta (19-8, .704).

CARDS/REDS TWINBILL TIDBITS: In **1989**, LHP **Ricky Horton** started and came away with no-decisions in three DHs over a nine-game stretch (all Game 2s), culminating on August 18 at Riverfront Stadium.

- **Sept. 7, 1993:** **Mark Whiten** went yard a franchise record 4 times with an MLB-record-tying 12 RBI in G2 of DH at Riverfront Stadium in Cincinnati.
- **Aug. 27, 2002:** **Chuck Finley** pitched a two-hit shutout to defeat the Reds 5-0 in G2 at Cinergy Field, thanks to a five-run first inning and a **Scott Rolen** 3-run HR.
- **2019 Labor Day weekend:** The Cards and Reds played back-to-back DHs that was part of 5 games for St. Louis over 49-hours.
- **2020:** After an MLB-record 17-day COVID-related layoff, the Cardinals played 11 doubleheaders over 21 days, but none against Cincinnati.
- **Sept. 17, 2022:** the Cardinals swept the Reds in a twinbill at Busch III while limiting the Cincy to one unearned run over 20 combined innings, marking the first time St. Louis played more than 18 innings on one day and did not allow an earned run (since 1912) - *Elias*
- **2025.** St. Louis became just the 3rd team the last 40 seasons (excluding 2020) to play six doubleheaders in their first 75 games, joining the 2022 Guardians (6th in Games 74-75) and 2021 Mets (6th in Games 67-68). - *Elias*
- **April 30, 2025:** the Cardinals scored 15 runs in their first doubleheader sweep in Cincinnati since June 28, 1959 at Crosley Field.

N THE NAVY: The Cardinals, who wear their navy caps in road games against teams with a primary team color of red, will wear the navy caps for the first time in 2026 during this weekend's series against the Reds.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: The Cardinals are 10-6 in series opening games and 3-1 in the opening games of road trips this season...**Jordan Walker** is leading the team with his .365 (23-63) batting average in series opening games, including a 1.023 OPS...**Nolan Gorman** and **Ivan Herrera** co-lead the team with 10 RBI in series openers, while **JJ Wetherholt**, **Nolan Gorman** and **Alec Burleson** each have hit 4 HR's to lead the team in the 1st game of a series.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Former Reds Executive, the late **Walt Jocketty**, served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, St. Louis compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06) & one World Series Championship ('06).

Terry Francona played in 86 games in 1990 with the Louisville Redbirds (AAA), including five at pitcher...his father, **Tito Francona**, played parts of two seasons (1965-66) with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade by Cleveland in exchange for a player to be named (Dec. 15, 1964)...originally signed by the St. Louis Browns before the 1952 season (MLB debut for Baltimore in 1956).

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball & coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ. (1995-97).

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11)

Justin Bruihl pitched for the Reds Triple-A Louisville affiliate in 2024.

Riley O'Brien made his MLB debut with Cincinnati (Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

César Prieto made his MLB debut at Cincinnati on Aug. 29, 2025 & collected 1st MLB hit on Aug. 31 off **Emilio Pagán**.

Reds Asst. Pitching Coach **Matt Tracy** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College HS.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Cardinals.TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played outfield for both the Cardinals (1995-97) and Reds (1999).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Senior Advisor **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...worked for St. Louis as a professional scout and special assistant.

Reds Special Asst. to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons (1986-90) with the Cardinals.

Reds President of Baseball Ops **Nick Krall** previously interned for the New Jersey Cardinals of the NY Penn League (SS).

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Reds Senior Advisor **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

GAME 1 STARTER:

- Making his 10th start of the 2026 season as he & Kyle Leahy complete the starting rotation's 10th time thru; it's his 71st career start (179th career appearance).
- Pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his first nine starts, longest streak by a Cardinal since **Sonny Gray** ran off 12 straight last season from July-September. His 9 starts of 5.0 innings or more to begin a season is longest since Gray ran off 10 to begin 2024.
- ***This start continues a pattern of having alternated Home & Road starts to begin the season; won his last three road starts and dropped his last four home starts.***
- Averaging 8.14 RSA on the road and 1.61 at home. Has yet to receive more than 2 runs in a home start or less than 3 runs in a road start.
- His 179th career appearance ranks 70th all-time among Cardinals pitchers; He joins **Adam Wainwright** (478), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach 178 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 60 or more starts.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (70), wins (28), innings pitched (509.0) and strikeouts (361).**
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, May 17 vs. Kansas City): L, 2-0; 6.2 IP, 8 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO, 1 HR, 99 pitches.

- First Cardinals pitcher to work into the 7th inning tossing 6.2 innings.
- Allowed five hits (5-15) to right-handed batters, his most in any start of the season.
- Faced 27 batters; is the only Cardinals pitcher to face 27 batters this season (3rd time) and since Sonny Gray (28 BF, 9/4/25 at SF).

2026 NOTES:

3 TURNS: Pitched into the 7th inning vs. KC (5/17) with a season-high 6.2 innings and 27 batters faced in a 2-0 loss.

ROAD vs. HOME: With a win in Sacramento (5/12), earned his first MLB in his home state (CA).

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .167 BA (10-64) with his slider, and 21 of his 40 strikeouts this season have come via the slider.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in all nine starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in four of those games.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .981 OPS, 10 runs and 3 HRs in 1st inning and batters are hitting .400 (8-20) when contacting the 1st pitch of an at-bat.

BITTER BREW: Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL (5/6), losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

AHOY MATEY: Pitched a season-best 6.0 innings while allowing one run in the Cardinals 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in game three of a four-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in his season-high 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 (at KC) in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut vs. NYM (3/31) and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Is 12-16 in his 35 career games started at Busch Stadium while the Cardinals have gone 16-19 in those games.
- ***Since his 2022 Major League debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (62.8%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ innings pitched.***
- As a starting pitcher (377.1 IP), Pallante's 59.3 career groundball pct. currently is the 8th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 350.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE vs. CINCINNATI:

- Is 6-4 with a 2.49 ERA in 9 career starts and 19 app., vs. the Reds; his most wins (6) and starts (9) against any opponent. The 19 app., are tied for his most.
- **Of active pitchers with 50.0 or more innings vs. the Reds, his 2.49 ERA ranks 4th behind Scherzer (1.67), Wheeler (2.35) & Wacha (2.43).**
- Returned to the Cardinals rotation on May 26, 2024 at Great American Ballpark and hurled 6.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in a 5-3 win.
- Has registered a decision in all nine career starts vs. CIN (5-4, 2.77 ERA, 48.2 IP, 41 K).
- Won each of his first four starts vs. CIN but is 1-4 since.
- He's held the Reds to 3 ER or less in his 3 starts at Great American Ballpark (2.65 ERA).
- Received one run of support or less in 6-of-9 starts.
