LIFE ON THE ROAD: The Orioles opened their second road trip of the season with a 5-2 victory in Texas last night...Entering play today, the O's five road wins are tied for the second-most in the American League and third-most in baseball...Seven AL teams currently have a better winning percentage on the road than at home, including Baltimore.

- 🦅 **OF Cedric Mullins'** 14 hits in road games leads all of baseball
- 🦅 Among pitchers who have made at least two starts on the road, **LHP John Means'** 0.77 ERA (1 ER/11.2 IP) ranks as the second-lowest in the AL.
- 🦅 The Orioles have posted a team ERA of 3.29 (23 ER/63.0 IP) in their seven road games, the second-lowest ERA in the AL and the fifth-lowest in the majors.
- 🦅 Since the beginning of last season, the O's have gone 17-17 in road games.

EXTRA! EXTRA! READ ALL ABOUT IT: The Orioles recorded six extra-base hits and just one single in last night's victory at Texas...It marked the 12th time in club history (since 1954) in which the Orioles won a game when recording at least six extra-base hits and one-or-fewer singles (last: 8/10/17 at OAK)...It was the 19th such game, win or lose, in team history.

- 🦅 **OF Cedric Mullins'** seven doubles are tied for the Major League lead (**J.D. Martinez**, BOS).
- 🦅 Each of **INF/OF Trey Mancini's** last three hits have been home runs.
- 🦅 **OF DJ Stewart's** home run last night traveled the furthest of his career (436 ft.).

GOOD MORNING. GOOD AFTERNOON. GOOD NIGHT: The Orioles struck out a season-high 15 batters in last night's series opener, their most in a game since September 20, 2020 vs. TB... It was the 34th time in Orioles history in which they've combined to strikeout at least 15 opposing batters; the O's have gone 24-9-1 in these games.

- 🦅 The Rangers (149) and Orioles (146) rank first and second respectively in baseball in most strikeouts by team batters.
- 🦅 Orioles batters have struck out double digit times in nine games this season, including last night (11), while their pitchers have struck out opponents double digit times in six games.
- 🦅 **RHP Jorge López** struck out a season-high eight batters, his most since joining the Orioles and tied for the second-most in a single game in his career.

A LOT OF GOPHER BALLS: For the second-straight game, including last night, the lone two runs the Orioles allowed came via two solo home runs...Orioles pitchers have surrendered 23 home runs on the season, the most in baseball...38 of the 67 runs allowed by Orioles pitchers this season have come via the home run (56.7%).

- 🦅 Orioles pitchers have allowed 38 barrels to opponents, according to *Statcast*, the second-most in baseball (DET, 41).

WELCOME TO TEXAS: The O's and Rangers will play game two of their three game series tonight, the lone trip to Texas for the O's...Texas will visit Baltimore for four games in September (23-26).

- 🦅 The Orioles are 3-7 in their last 10 games overall against the Rangers.
- 🦅 The Orioles are 5-5 in their last 10 games in Texas.
- 🦅 **LHP John Means** has made two career starts against the Rangers, posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER/12.2 IP); has tossed a Quality Start in both of these appearances.

CALL TO THE 'PEN: The Orioles bullpen has pitched to a 3.96 ERA (23 ER/52.1 IP) this season, the sixth-lowest ERA in the AL and 14th-lowest in the majors...On the road, the O's 'pen has pitched to a 2.57 ERA (8 ER/28.0 IP).

- 🦅 **RHP César Valdez** has recorded three saves in four opportunities; he is tied for the AL lead in saves...Valdez has allowed a .241 opponent slugging percentage since joining the Orioles on August 29 last season (15 games); this is the second-lowest opponent slugging percentage by an AL pitcher in this stretch (min. 20.0 IP).
- 🦅 **RHP Adam Plutko** has worked 9.1 innings in relief, posting a 1.93 ERA (2 ER/9.1 IP)...his innings out of the bullpen are the third-most in the AL.
- 🦅 **LHP Paul Fry** has appeared in a team-high seven games...His seven games are tied for the most by a left-handed pitcher in the AL.

SETTING THE TABLE: After going hitless in Thursday's doubleheader and snapping his hitting streak, **OF Cedric Mullins** recorded his sixth multi-hit game of the season in last night's series opener...Mullins leads the O's in batting average, hits, multi-hit games, runs scored, doubles, on-base percentage, slugging percentage, and OPS.

- 🦅 He leads the AL in hits, is tied for first in doubles, tied for second in multi-hit games, fourth in batting average, and tied for fourth in extra-base hits.
- 🦅 Mullins has led off each game this season, and has gone 6-for-14 in his first at-bats of the game; has gone 11-for-24 when leading off any inning, with his 11 hits leading all of baseball in this category.
- 🦅 Mullins has gone 7-for-19 (.368) against left-handed pitching to start the season; in Spring Training, he became a full-time left-handed hitter after switch hitting his entire professional career.

HITTING IT HARD: INF Maikel Franco has recorded five at-bats with exit velocities of 110+ MPH this season, recording a single (111.4 MPH), ground out (111.3 MPH), home run (111.2 MPH), double (111.0 MPH), and double (110.1 MPH), respectively in these instances...The rest of the O's have a combined four at-bats in which the batted ball resulted in 110+ MPH exit velocities.

- 🦅 Franco has started each game this season for the O's (12 at third base and two as the DH)...He's started in 79-straight games, dating back to 9/24/19 G2 at WSH.
- 🦅 Franco's seven walks lead the O's and his .316 OBP ranks third on the team.

QUICK HITS: Is making his seventh-career start...Made the Opening Day roster for the first time in his career...Acquired by the Orioles along with INF Rylan Bannon, OF Yusniel Diaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Breyvic Valera from the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for INF Manny Machado on 7/18/18...Ranked as the Orioles' No. 9 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 8 by *MLB.com*...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV....**Became the first Israeli citizen to be selected in the MLB Draft**...Pitched for Israel's National Team in the 2017 World Baseball Classic and was named Most Valuable Pitcher for Israel in 2014 and 2015 after he helped the team qualify for the European Baseball Championship...**Has dual Israeli-American citizenship.**

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on 4/13 (G2) against SEA.....Tossed 3.0 innings and allowed four runs on four hits and one walk with three strikeouts...Has now given up a home run in back-to-back starts after not giving up a homer in four starts in 2020.

VS. TEXAS: Will be his second-straight start against an American League West opponent, after only facing American League East opponents in his first five-career starts...Tonight's contest will be his first-time pitching at a non-American League East ballpark.

ON THE ROAD: Is looking for his first-career road win...Is 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (3 ER/3.0 IP) in one start on the road this season...Went 0-1 in two starts on the road last season, in which he pitched to a 9.39 ERA (8 ER/7.2 IP).

LEFT AND RIGHT: Four of his nine hits allowed this season, including two home runs, have come to left-handed batters...Through his first three starts of 2020, lefties hit just .111 (3-for-27) against him with eight strikeouts...Three of his eight strikeouts (37.5%) this season have been vs. lefties, compared to 13 of his 30 strikeouts (43.3%) in 2020.

MLB DEBUT: Earned the win in his Major League debut on 9/6/20 vs. NYY, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing just one run on one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts...Struck out DJ LeMahieu (looking) for his first career strikeout...Became the fourth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to work at least 6.0 IP while allowing one-or-fewer hits in his big league debut, and the sixth pitcher in O's history to strike out at least seven batters in his Major League debut.

SPRING TRAINING: Went 0-1 in five starts during Spring Training 2021, and pitched to a 6.32 ERA (11 ER/15.2 IP)...Threw 4.2 innings, his longest outing, in his final start vs. BOS on 3/24, in which he allowed two runs on five hits and one walk with five strikeouts.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Recalled from the Alternate Training Site at Double-A Bowie on 9/6/20 and made his Major League debut on that same day vs. New York-AL....Became the fourth of five Orioles to make his Major League debut in 2020...Over his first three big league starts, he went 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER/16.0 IP), tossed 5.0 innings-or-more, allowed one run-or-fewer, and recorded at least six strikeouts...Did not allow a home run in his 18.2 innings worked...Faced just the Yankees, Red Sox, and Rays, going 1-1 overall with a 4.82 ERA (10 ER/18.2 IP), 12 walks, and 22 strikeouts.

Means will be making his fourth appearance this season and third-career start against Texas...Did not factor in the decision in his last start on 4/13 vs. SEA (G1), in which he threw 5.0+ innings, allowing three runs on five hits, two home runs, with two walks and five strikeouts...Snapped his streak of six-straight starts not giving up one-or-more total runs; his streak is tied with Orioles Legend and Hall of Farmer RHP Jim Palmer for the O's club record...Will be making his first-career start at Globe Life Field, made one start at Globe Life Park, in which he did not factor in the decision, allowing one run one three hits in 6.0 innings...Is 1-0 on the road this season with a 0.77 ERA (1 ER/11.2 IP) in two starts.
