#### Don't Fence Me In

The Brewers have hit 1 HR in their last 11 games, including none over the last 7 games, their longest streak since a franchise-record 13 straight from 8/9-8/22, 1999....**Brice Turang** hit the team's last homer on a 2-run shot off Sandy Alcantara on 4/18 at Miami.

#### Start Me Up

Brewers starters have a 2.47 ERA over the last 13 games (69.1ip, 19er) with 6 quality starts and opponents batting .189 (46-for-243, 20bb, 69k).

Brewers pitchers had 18 strikeouts on Sunday against the Pirates....it marked the eighth time in franchise history that the team produced 18 or more strikeouts in a 9-inning game and the second time this season....the team had a franchise-record 20 K on Opening Day against the White Sox.

#### Kyling On

**Kyle Harrison** notched a career-high 12 strikeouts on Sunday against the Pirates....Harrison became just the sixth left-handed pitcher in franchise history (11x) with 12 or more strikeouts in a game, joining **Teddy Higuera** (6x), **Juan Nieves**, **Chris Capuano**, **Eric Lauer** and **Aaron Ashby**.

#### Rising From the Ashes

**Aaron Ashby** has 30 strikeouts in just 18.1 innings pitched this season....his 14.73 K/9IP leads MLB pitchers with at least 18.0 innings pitched.

**IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** **OF Akil Baddoo** (left quad), **OF Jackson Chourio** (left hand), **LHP Jared Koenig** (left elbow), **RHP Quinn Priester** (right thoracic outlet), **1B Andrew Vaughn** (left hand), **OF Christian Yelich** (left groin) and **LHP Rob Zastryzny** (left shoulder) are currently on the injured list....Baddoo and Zastryzny are on the 60-day IL.

**MANAGER:** **Pat Murphy** (351g, 204-147, .581) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

**COACHES:** Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

**IN THE STANDINGS (33 days):** The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 16, **SECOND:** 1, **THIRD:** 5, **FOURTH:** 5, **FIFTH:** 6....the Brewers are currently in fifth place, trailing the first-place Reds by 3.5 games, second-place Cubs by 2.0 games, third-place Pirates by 1.0 game and fourth-place Cardinals by half a game.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 10 replay challenges this season, going 8-2....their last challenge (won) came on 4/21 at Detroit as an out call at first base involving Garrett Mitchell was overturned.

**BREWING SUCCESS:** The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY:** The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 777 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (873), Astros (817) and Yankees (807).

**PATRICK AT A GLANCE:** Chad Patrick, 27, will be making his sixth appearance and fourth start of the season.....Patrick last pitched last Wednesday in relief at Detroit and took a 5-2 loss (4ip, 6h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 2k, 1hr, 80 pitches).....the team is 3-0 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .247 (21-for-85, 2hr).....Patrick was acquired from Oakland on 11/15/23 for INF Abraham Toro.....he was selected by Arizona in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Purdue University Northwest..... he was traded by Arizona to Oakland on 7/31/23 in exchange for INF Jace Peterson, who is now a consultant to player development with the Brewers.

**LAST SEASON:** Patrick went 3-8 with a 3.53 ERA in 27 games/23 starts during his first Major League season.....he had four stints with the team (Opening Day-7/5, 8/18-8/19, 8/24 and 9/9-end of season).....the team went 8-14 in his starts.....he had 5 quality starts.....opponents batted .248 (113-for-455, 13hr).....he was among 2025 National League rookie leaders in starts (1st), strikeouts (1st, 127) and innings pitched (2nd, 119.2).

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 2-4 with a 2.66 ERA in 18 games/14 starts (81.1ip, 24er).....is 0-0 with a 1.29 ERA in 3 games/2 starts this season (14ip, 2er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 2-5 with a 4.26 ERA in 14 games/12 starts (61.1ip, 29er).....is 1-1 with a 4.00 ERA in 2 games/1 start this season (9ip, 4er).
