The Giants reclaimed a share of first place in the NL West with the Braves, as SF defeated Colorado 6-4. **Will Clark** hit his 14th homer of the season, **Rod Beck** earned his 45th save and the Giants won their 100th game of the season.

TODAY'S GAME: With a series win secured, the Giants aim to finish the season at .500 with a victory in this afternoon's series finale...SF has won three straight entering play today.

▶ In the 143 seasons of Giants baseball since 1883 the Giants have finished at exactly .500 only once and that came in 2022...that year, the Giants also entered the final day of the season 80-81, needing a win to get to .500...they were able to do so with an 8-1 win at San Diego.

ROCK ON: SF enters today's contest against Colorado 10-2 (.833) versus the Rockies in 2025...SF's best winning percentage vs. the Rockies came in 2021 when the Giants went 15-4 (.789) in 19 games under the old schedule format...their fewest losses in a season vs. Colorado is three (done in 1993, 1994 and 2024).

- ▶ The last time a Giants team had a better winning percentage against a single team they played at least 10 times within a season was also 2021 when the Giants went 17-2 (.895) against the Diamondbacks.
- ▶ The Giants can join the Guardians (over the White Sox) and Dodgers (over the Rockies) as the only teams to have 11 wins over one opponent this season with a win today.

WEBBY: RHP Logan Webb toes the slab today in what will be his career-best 34th start of the campaign...SF's workhorse will become the fifth Giant since 2000 to make 34 starts in a regular season...**Madison Bumgarner** did it twice (2016 and 2019) while **Matt Cain** (2008), **Livan Hernández** (2001) and **Kirk Rueter** (2001) each did it once.

- ▶ The 28-year-old Webb enters today leading the National League in innings at 201.2 innings and could once again lead the Majors in innings pitched depending on how far he goes today...BOS' Garrett Crochet leads MLB at 205.1...if Webb ends up leading MLB it will be the second time in the last three seasons he's led the Majors in innings pitched (also 2023 with a career-best 216.0).
- ▶ He can also lead the NL in strikeouts with just one strikeout today as he enters today's start tied for the NL lead with Philadelphia's Jesús Luzardo (216) and Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (216), who have made their final regular season starts...if Webb can also accomplish that feat he'll become the first Giant to lead the National League in both innings pitched and strikeouts since **Bill Voiselle** did so in 1944 with the New York Giants.

163?!: IF/DH Rafael Devers has a chance to play in 163 games this season if he plays in today's game...Devers played in 73 games for Boston before the trade to SF, where he's played in 89 games entering today.

- ▶ The last player to appear in 163 games in a single season was the Twins' Justin Morneau, who played in 163 in 2008 with the help of a tiebreaker game...the last player to do it without the help of a tiebreaker game was Todd Zeile in 1996 when he was traded from Philadelphia to Baltimore.
- ▶ Overall Devers' 163 games would be the 34th instance of a player appearing in 163 or more regular season games in a single season...it would be the third time in involves a Giant...**José Pagán** played in 164 games in 1962 and **Willie Montañez** played in 163 between the Giants (60 games) and Braves (103 games).

ON THE SHORES: The Giants own a 41-39 record at Oracle Park this season...the .512 winning percentage at home ranks 20th in MLB...yesterday's win, at least, secured an above .500 season here at Oracle Park...a win today would match the club's home record from last year (42-39).

▶ Giants fans have packed Oracle Park this season, with the team's 36,104 average home attendance ranking seventh-best in the Majors this season...that average attendance is SF's best since 2018 (38,965)...the team's 28 sellouts this year are its most since they had 50 sellouts in 2017.

WILLY THE KID: 2025 Willie Mac Award winner **IF Willy Adames** enters today on the precipice of 30 homers (he's one shy), trying to become the first Giant with 30 homers in a single season since **Barry Bonds** hit 45 in 2004...every other club has had at least one 30-home run hitter since 2019.

Adames enters today leading the Giants in homers (29) and stolen bases (12) among other categories...if Adames finishes today still leading in both (**Jung Hoo Lee** has 10 steals), he'd be the first shortstop to lead the Giants in both homers and steals since Hall of Famer **George Davis** in 1897...Davis led the team with 10 homers and 65 steals (*Stats, LLC*).

SEE YOU IN 2026!: The Giants will open next year's regular season slate right back here at Oracle Park against the Yankees on Wednesday, March 25...it will mark just the third time the Giants will open at home in the last 19 seasons (also 2009 vs. Milwaukee and 2022 vs. Miami).

WEBBMASTER: Webb is in his seventh season with San Francisco...he finished last season with an NL-leading 204.2 innings...he was named an All-Star for the second time in his career (also 2024) this season, pitching a scoreless 3rd inning of relief.

MR. 200: Webb reached the 200.0 inning mark in his last start...he is the first Giants pitcher to record 200.0 innings and 200 strikeouts in the same season since Madison Bumgarner (207.2ip, 203 strikeouts) did so in 2019...he is the first Giants right-hander to accomplish the feat since Jeff Samardzija (207.2ip, 205 strikeouts) in 2017...he is also the first Giants pitcher to reach 200.0 innings in three straight seasons since Bumgarner did so in six straight seasons from 2011-2016.

LAST TIME OUT: Received a no-decision after allowing three runs on eight hits and two walks while striking out five in 6.0 innings on September 23 vs. St. Louis.

FIRSTTIME SINCE WHEN?!: Currently leading the National League with 201.2 innings and tied for the lead with 216 strikeouts, Webb has a chance to be the first Giant to lead the NL in both categories since **Bill Voiselle** did so in 1944.

VS. COLORADO: Is 10–3 with a 3.12 ERA (37er, 106.2ip), 96 strike-outs and a 1.18 WHIP in 18 career games (17 starts)...in two starts this season vs. Colorado, he is 2–0 with a 2.25 ERA (3er, 12.0ip), 13 strikeouts and a 1.42 WHIP...Rockies shortstop Ezequiel Tovar is 7-for-18 with a home run, four RBI and four strikeouts in his career vs. Webb...on the other end, center fielder Brenton Doyle is 2-for-16 with a double, an RBI and two strikeouts.

WHEN YOU'RE 15: Webb is one win shy of tying his career-high for wins (15) set in 2022...the only other Giants since 2000 with multiple 15-win seasons are Madison Bumgarner (four), Tim Lincecum (three) and Jason Schmidt (two).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: The righty is 7-4 with a 3.25 ERA (40er, 110.2ip) and 118 strikeouts at Oracle Park (18 starts)...in 15 road starts, Webb is 7-7 with a 3.36 ERA (34er, 91.0ip) and 98 strikeouts.

HELPING THE CATCHER: Webb has drastically improved his ability to keep runners in check this season and limit stolen bases...he has +5 Net Bases Prevented (a sum of advanced prevented and outs added assigned to the pitcher), which is tied for 15th-best in the Majors on *Baseball Savant*...he had scores of -5 in 2024, -9 in 2023 and -4 in 2022, -1 in 2021 and -3 in 2020...from 2020-2024, Webb allowed an average of 14 stolen bases off him per season (72 in five seasons)...in 2025, Webb has allowed a total of nine stolen bases.

SINK OR SWIM: His sinker has a +9 run value on *Baseball Savant*, making it his most valuable pitch...Webb's sinker was burned by the Cardinals, with St. Louis going 5-for-11 (.455) with three doubles vs. the pitch...since July 11, opponents are batting .355 (39x110) with 13 extra-base hits (10 doubles, three homers) vs. his sinker.
