TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Tigers wrap the series this afternoon with SF looking to win its fourth consecutive home series with a win today..the Giants have gone 5-1-0 in their last six completed home series dating to June 23.

- ▶ The Giants have won seven of their last 10 home games dating to July 11 and are 14-8 (.636) in their last 22 home games dating to June 14, outscoring their opponents 101-79 (+22) in that stretch.
- ▶ SF's 14-8 record at home since June 14 is sixth-best in the Majors and fourth-best in the National League.
- ▶ Lastly, Sundays here by McCovey Cove have been kind to the Giants with the club going 6-2 on Sundays here at home in 2026... SF lost its first Sunday home game to the Mets in April before winning six straight...a loss to the Angels here on July 26 snapped that streak.

THE WEBBMASTER: RHP Logan Webb makes his 21st start of the campaign this afternoon... the Giants have won each of Webb's last three starts dating to July 24 with Webb himself posting a 3.00 ERA (6er, 18.0ip) in that time.

- ▶ Webb spun 6.0 innings of shutout ball last Monday in Texas following a hectic trade deadline day for the Giants...he struck out a season-best eight, walked one and allowed five hits in SF's 5-1 victory.
- ▶ Today's outing marks the 12th time this year Webb will pitch following a Giants' loss the game before...in the 11 prior starts, Webb is 5-2 with a 1.96 ERA (16er, 73.1ip) and a .198 opponents batting average against...the Giants in those games, however, are 6-5 but they have won each of the last three times Webb has started following a team loss the game before.

SMALL SAMPLE SIZE: This series with Detroit is only the fifth the Giants have played here at home against the Tigers since the two began playing one another in Interleague play back in 2003...the only other series the Tigers have won here on the shores of McCovey Cove was in 2008 (2-1).

- ▶ Yesterday's 8-0 defeat at the hands of the Tigers was the largest margin of defeat in the all-time series (32 games)...the previous high was six runs in an 8-2 loss back in 2005.

ON THE PRECIPICE: IF Willy Adames is on milestone watch after hitting his 199th career home run Friday night and his 19th this season...his next homer would make him the first Giant to reach the 20-homer mark as a shortstop in multiple seasons since **Brandon Crawford** (24 in 2021 and 21 in 2015), and the first to do it in two straight seasons since **Rich Aurilia** (37 homers in 2001, 20 homers in 2000).

- ▶ Throughout his career, the infielder has found a lot of success playing in the month of August, his best single month by a wide margin...in 215 career games in August, Adames has a .827 OPS with 48 homers, 122 RBI and 212 doubles.

AND ONE: RHP Trent Harris made his Major League debut yesterday, becoming the ninth Giant this season (only the second pitcher) to make his Major League debut...the other pitcher to make his MLB debut with SF this season was **RHP Wilkin Ramos**.

- ▶ SF's nine debuts are tied for most in the NL with Colorado...overall, the nine debuts are tied for 13th-most in the Majors.
- ▶ On the flip side, the Giants two pitcher debuts are tied for second-fewest in the Majors... the only team to have a single pitcher make their MLB debut this season was San Diego... Texas leads the Majors with 10 pitchers this season who have made their debuts.

HOUSTON, DO YOU COPY?: The Giants tour of the American League continues Monday-Wednesday with the Astros moseying over to Oracle Park for a three-game series.

- ▶ SF swept a three-game series in Houston last year, which was their second series of the regular season after opening in Cincinnati.
- ▶ The Giants have won four straight versus Houston dating to June 12, 2024 and have won five of the last six matchups overall dating to the start of the 2024 campaign.
- ▶ SF has also won each of its last two home series against the Asrtros (2024 and 2021).

GOLD GLOVE: 2025 | ALL-STAR: 2024, 2025, 2026

WEBBMASTER: Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his seventh win of the season shortly after the trade deadline on Monday at Texas...struck out a season-high eight batters in 6.0 shutout innings of work...Webb issued one walk and allowed five hits in the scoreless outing...batters were 1-for-7 with four strikeouts off his sweeper and are 1-for-their-last-11 with five K's off the pitch.

PICK SIX: Webb's most recent start at Texas marked his third outing this season throwing at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, and the 23rd start of his career...Webb's 23 starts of 6.0+ scoreless innings are now fourth-most by a Giant in the last 50 years, surpassing the 22 games by **Barry Zito** and **Jason Schmidt** (see full chart to the right courtesy of *Sarah Langs*).

VS. DETROIT: Will face the Tigers for just the fourth time in his career...the right-hander is 1-2 with a 2.04 ERA (4er, 17.2ip), 24 strikeouts (12.23 K/9ip) and a 1.13 WHIP in the three starts...Webb struck out 10 batters in his last start against them on May 27, 2025, working 6.0 innings with three runs allowed...he's only faced them once here at Oracle Park, almost exactly two years to the date...earned the win after tossing 7.0 innings with one run and eight strikeouts on August 10, 2024.

STAY GROUNDED: Has a 52.3% ground ball rate this season, fifth-best in the Majors behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (58.0%), STL's Andre Pallante (56.0%), DET's Framber Valdez (54.5%) and TOR's José Soriano (52.5%).

HOME, SWEET HOME: Has a 3.88 ERA (28er, 65.0ip) and .613 opposing OPS in 10 starts at home...overall, he is 42-29 with a 2.95 ERA in 100 career games (97 starts) at Oracle Park compared to a 3.91 ERA in 100 starts on the road... since 2021, Webb's 2.80 ERA at home is fifth-best in the Majors (min. 60 GS).

GUESS WHO'S BACK: Since returning from the 15-day IL on May 29, Webb is 5-3 with a 2.92 ERA (25er, 77.0ip), 0.94 WHIP and a .199 BAA in 12 starts...he was 2-4 with a 5.06 in eight starts before the injury...Webb landed on the IL on May 9 and missed 20 games with right knee bursitis in what was his first trip to the injured list since October 2022 (low back strain).

SINK OR SWIM: His sinker has a +12 run value this season, fifth-highest in the Majors and currently his highest value of any pitch since 2024, when he finished the year with a +17 run value on his sinker...batters are hitting .230 with a .360 slugging percentage off his sinker this season, which he throws 30.1% of the time...had a .294 BAA and .438 SLG with the pitch in 2025.

TOUGH LUCK: SF is 8-12 in Webb's 20 starts this year after going 18-16 in his 34 starts a season ago...since 2022, SF as a team is 75-77 in Webb's 152 starts, yet his 3.29 ERA in that time is sixth-best in MLB among starters (min. 100 GS).

IN PLAY...: Has struck out 101 batters in 125.0 innings this season...Webb's 19.8% strikeout rate is down from 26.2% last season and currently his lowest in any full season (excluding 2020).

UP, DOWN: Following a stellar month of June that saw him earn NL Pitcher of the Month honors, Webb went 1-2 with a 6.59 ERA (21er, 28.2ip), four HRs and a 1.29 WHIP in five starts in July.
