**DELAYED:** Rain halted play in the bottom of the ninth inning...Play resumed after a 0:51 delay.

## ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles defeated the Rays 7-6, improving to 17-25 and 12-11 at home...O's won via walk-off for the third time in four games for the first time since September 25-29, 1974...**2B Rougned Odor** recorded his second walk-off plate appearance in his last three games, scoring **C Adley Rutschman** in the 11<sup>th</sup> inning...Have won by walk-off in three of their last four games; entered play today tied with New York-AL for most walk-off victories this season...Improve to 4-0 in extra innings...Won their first game when trailing after eight innings this season (1-23)...Won their first series against Tampa Bay since July 31-August 2, 2020...The Orioles left 16 runners on base, their most since June 13, 2012 against Boston, also leaving 16.
- RHP Spenser Watkins** received a no decision...allowed three runs on three hits without recording an out...Left the game in the first inning with a right forearm contusion...Marks the shortest start of his career...Threw 13 pitches, nine strikes...O's won for the eighth time in franchise history when their starter did not record an out, first time May 17, 1987, at California.
- 2B Rougned Odor** (2-for-6, 2-2B, 2 RBI) marked his seventh career walk-off plate appearance...extended his hitting streak to a season-long seven games; batting .320 (8-for-25) with three doubles, one home run, and five RBI during that span...Marks his 12<sup>th</sup> career two-double game and second this season (last: 4/28 at NYY).
- 1B Ryan Mountcastle** (2-for-4, HR, RBI, 2 R, BB, K) hit his fifth home run of the season and first since May 5 vs. Minnesota...Tied for second on the team in home runs despite spending May 11-20 on the Injured List...Left the game in the ninth inning due to heat related body cramps.
- PH-LF Austin Hays** (1-for-1, 2 RBI) had his first career game-tying hit in the seventh inning or later as a pinch-hitter...Is 3-for-3 in his last three pinch-hit at-bats with a double, triple and four RBI.
- RF-1B Trey Mancini** (0-3, 3 BB) has reached base safely in a season-long 16 consecutive games.

## RAYS NOTES

- The Rays fell to the Orioles by a score of 7-6, dropping to 24-17, 11-8 on the road, and 4-3 in extra innings...Fell to 10-2 in their last 12 games at Oriole Park...Are 3-3 in road series...After using nine pitchers tonight, the Rays now have two of the three occurrences where a team has used nine pitchers this season in MLB...Tallied five hits in the first inning, tying a season-high for hits in an inning (4x, last: 5/13 vs. TOR (eighth))...Have scored at least six runs in five consecutive games, their longest such streak since a seven-game streak from August 6-13, 2021...Rays manager **Kevin Cash** was ejected in the fifth inning for arguing balls and strikes.
- RHP Corey Kluber** did not factor in the decision, allowing two runs on five hits with two walks, two strikeouts, and a hit batter over 3.0 innings, tying a season-low...Threw 73 pitches, 45 strikes.
- RHP J.P. Feyereisen** allowed an unearned run in the seventh inning, his first run of the season; entered today as the only MLB pitcher to have not allowed a run (min. 18.0 IP).
- 3B Isaac Paredes** hit a three-run home run in the first inning, marking his first three-RBI game since August 21, 2020 at Cleveland.
- CF Kevin Kiermaier** (2-for-6, RBI, 2 R, K) recorded his fourth-straight multi-hit game, tying a career-high (3x, last: 9/5-9/2018, four games).
- RF Brett Phillips** (3-for-3, 2-2B, R, BB, 2 SB) has a six-game hitting streak...Reached base safely a career-high tying four times (also, 9/25/20 vs. PHI), hitting two doubles for the first time in his career...Stole two bases, the first time he's done so since June 17, 2021 at Seattle.
