BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles fell to the Royals, 8-2, in last night's series opener...The Birds continue their six-game road trip this afternoon through Kansas City (0-1, 2 to play) and Arizona (3 to play) before enjoying their second off-day of the season on April 10.

👉 Making his season debut yesterday, **Gunnar Henderson** recorded three of six hardest-hit balls of the game by any player...His 106.8 mph lineout in the opening frame was topped only by KC Maikel Garcia's 107.0 mph single in the fourth...Henderson had a 105.3 mph groundout in the second inning and a 104.8 mph single in the eight.

👉 The O's have allowed eight runs in back-to-back games for the first time since August 1-2, 2024 at Cleveland...They have not allowed eight or more runs in three straight games since March 30 to April 2, 2023 at Boston.

👉 Baltimore saw its streak of five straight series-opening victories come to an end, having last dropped a series opener on September 17, 2024 vs. San Francisco.

👉 The Orioles have not recorded a save through the first eight games of the season for the first time since 2003 (also 8 G)...The last Baltimore club to go at least nine games without a save to open the season was the 2002 Orioles (12 G).

👉 **Tyler O'Neill** recorded his 200th career extra-base hit with a second-inning double.

👉 With a win this afternoon, the Orioles would snap a three-game losing streak, having not dropped four straight since a five-game skid from July 9-13, 2024.

KING OF THE CASTLE: **Ryan Mountcastle** is 8-for-19 (.421) with one triple, three home runs, and one walk against KC's Michael Wacha...He is one of eight players to have homered three or more times off Wacha, joining STL's Nolan Arenado (4), Starlin Castro (4), LAA's Jorge Soler (4), Anthony Rizzo (3), PHI's Kyle Schwarber (3), CHC's Ian Happ (3), and COL's Kris Bryant (3).

👉 Mountcastle has reached base safely in 14 of his last 17 games opposite Kansas City since May 8, 2022, batting .304 (21-for-69) with eight doubles, four home runs, and 17 RBI during that period.

OFF AND RUNNING: **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his first eight games, the longest season-opening streak by an Oriole since **Anthony Santander** (18 G) from April 8-27, 2022...**Aaron Hicks** reached base safely in each of his first 12 games from May 31 to June 14, 2023, but did not sign with the club until May 30 that season.

👉 He is 16-for-45 (.356) with five doubles, one home run, and six RBI in 11 career games at Kauffman Stadium.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore is an MLB-best 101-66 (.605) on the road since 2023, ahead of Houston (94-68, .580) and Los Angeles-NL (95-70, .576).

👉 **Cedric Mullins** has reached base safely in nine straight road games since September 25, 2024, going 13-for-33 (.394) with two doubles, two home runs, and six RBI in that time.

👉 **Ryan O'Hearn** has reached base safely in eight straight road games since September 27, 2024, batting .393 (11-for-28) with two doubles, two home runs, and four RBI during that stretch...It is tied for the fourth-longest streak of his career behind three 11-game streaks (last: 7/23-8/9/23).

KNOCK(S) ON WOOD: The Birds have recorded 71 hits, tied for the AL lead with the Red Sox and tied for fourth in MLB behind the Cubs (87 H), Cardinals (77 H), and the Diamondbacks (72 H)...The 71 hits are the most through the clubs first eight games since the 2016 O's (77 H).

MIXED BAG: Oriole starters have posted a 6.10 ERA (26 ER/38.1 IP), the second-highest mark in the majors ahead of only the Twins (7.59, 27 ER/32.0 IP)...The staff's 3.68 FIP, however, ranks 14th in the majors.

👉 Baltimore joins Milwaukee as the only two starting staff's in the majors that have yet to have a stolen base attempt against them.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The O's have grounded into nine doubles plays, second most in the majors behind the Athletics (10)...**Adley Rutschman** has grounded into three double plays, tied for the MLB lead with TB's Junior Caminero and MIN's Carlos Correa (3).

RISPY BUISNESS: Baltimore is a combined 3-for-13 (.231) with runners in scoring position over its last three games after going 12-for-41 (.293) in its first five contests.

👉 O's pitching limited the opposition to a .182 (10-for-55) clip with RISP through their first six games, but opponents have gone 6-for-18 (.333) since.

EARLY AND OFTEN: The Birds are batting .448 (13-for-29) on the first pitch of an at-bat, the fifth-highest clip in MLB behind the Yankees (.615, 16-for-26), Tigers (.500, 15-for-30), Rays (.500, 11-for-22), and Diamondbacks (.455, 15-for-33).

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** moved into sole possession of fourth place in Orioles history with his 408th win on March 29 at Toronto...The victory broke a tie with **Hank Bauer**...The 2023 AL Manager of the Year trails **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (669), and **Paul Richards** (517).

MILB KICK-OFF: Double-A Chesapeake, High-A Aberdeen, and Single-A Delmarva each began their 2025 campaigns yesterday...**Enrique Bradfield Jr.** went 1-for-3 with an RBI and two walks in a 3-2 comeback win for the Baysox...The IronBirds stole six bags and drew nine walks but fell in 12 innings, 4-3...**Chase Allsup** allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits with no walks and four strikeouts across 4.1 frames in a 12-1 Shorebirds defeat.

CITY OF FOUNTAINS: The Orioles and Royals continue a three-game set this afternoon at Kaufman Stadium...The clubs will meet for a three-game set in Baltimore from May 2-4...The O's won the 2024 season series, 4-2, and have taken each of the last four series sets since 2021, going 17-10 (.630) during that stretch.

👉 **Jordan Westburg** (2018-20) and Kansas City's **Hunter Renfro**e (2011-13) and **Chris Stratton** (2010-12) each attended Mississippi State University.

👉 Royals Broadcaster **Jake Eisenberg** attended the University of Maryland and called a variety of events for BTN+, the Maryland Baseball Network, and WMUC.

👉 Kansas City Broadcaster **Steve Stewart** worked in Baltimore for WBAL radio and television as a sports anchor/reporter and talk show host from 2000-03.

👉 Kansas City selected Baltimore **RHP Roger Nelson** with the first overall pick of the 1968 Expansion Draft...Other Orioles selected in that draft included **1B Mike Fiore** (No. 9), **RHP Wally Bunker** (No. 13), and **RHP Moe Drabowsky** (No. 21).

Roenicke has four hits and Ripken and Ford get three each.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his second career MLB start today against the Royals..Is the third-ever Japanese player for the Orioles, joining right-handed relievers Shintaro Fujinami (2023) and Koji Uehara (2009-11)...Made five Grapefruit League appearances (4 GS), going 2-1 with a 3.00 ERA (5 ER/15.0 IP) on 11 hits (1 HR) and five walks with 15 strikeouts...His first four outings (10.1 IP) of the spring were scoreless...In his debut, at 35 years, 170 days, became the oldest Japanese player to make his MLB debut since New York-NL's Ken Takahashi (40-016) on May 2, 2009 at Philadelphia.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his major league debut on March 30 at Toronto...Was dealt the loss after allowing two runs on four hits and two walks with one strikeout in 4.0 innings...Left before throwing a pitch in the bottom of the fifth inning due to cramping...Threw 73 pitches, 45 strikes.

2024 RECAP: Spent the entire season with the Yomiuri Giants of Japan's Nippon Professional Baseball's Central League...Went 15-3 with a 1.67 ERA (29 ER/156.2 IP), 132 hits (6 HR), 16 walks, four hit batters, and 111 strikeouts in 24 games, all starts...Tossed three complete games, including one shutout...Led NPB in wins and finished second in ERA.

- 🏆 Named Central League MVP.
- 🏆 Earned a Mitsui Golden Glove Award.
- 🏆 Surrendered four or fewer runs in all 24 starts, three or less in 23, and one or no runs in 17; tossed six scoreless outings, including his lone complete game shutout on July 28 vs. DeNa (9.0 IP, 7 H, 8 K).
- 🏆 Opened the season with a 20.0-inning scoreless streak; pitched two scoreless games (13.0 IP) to begin the year before allowing an eighth-inning run on April 18 at Hanshin.

- 🏆 Posted a 1.16 ERA (10 ER/77.1 IP) in his final 11 games beginning July 21.
- 🏆 Helped the Giants secure a bye to the Final Stage of the 2024 Climax Series, NPB's playoff format, with the best record in the Central League (77-59-7)...Suffered two defeats in the series as Yomiuri was eliminated against DeNa...Took the loss in Game 2 after allowing two runs on six hits and one walk with five strikeouts in 7.0 innings...Entered in the ninth inning of a tie game in winner-take-all Game 7 and surrendered one run on two hits.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Sugano has compiled a 136-74 record with a 2.43 ERA (501 ER/1,857.0 IP) with 1,568 hits (142 HR), 347 walks (12 IBB), 52 hit batters, and 1,585 strikeouts in 276 career games (248 GS) with the Giants...Is a three-time Central League MVP (2014, 2020, 2024), a three-time Central League Mitsui Golden Glove Award winner (2016-18), an eight-time All-Star (2013-19, 2022), a two-time Eiji Sawamura Award honoree (2017-18), presented to the top pitcher in NPB each season, and MVP of the 2013 Central League Climax Series, the playoff format in NPB...Has led the Central League in wins four times (2017-18, 2020, & 2024), ERA four times (2014, 2016-18), and strikeouts twice (2016, 2018)...Earned the triple crown in 2018 after leading NPB in wins, ERA, and strikeouts.

ON THE WORLD STAGE: Pitched for Team Japan at the 2017 World Baseball Classic, pitching to a 3.14 ERA (5 ER/14.1 IP) with one walk and 16 strikeouts in three starts...Tied for the tournament lead in strikeouts with teammate Kodai Senga...Started the semifinal game against Team USA on March 21, 2017, at Dodger Stadium, allowing one unearned run on three hits and one walk with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings.
