## TONIGHT'S STARTER: #41 - RHP JOE ROSS (3gs, 1-1, 4.91)

ROSS AT A GLANCE: Joe Ross, 30, will make his fourth start of the season.....Ross last started last Monday vs. San Diego in a 7-3 loss (4.2ip, 9h, 7r, 6er, 2bb, 4k, 80 pitches)..... the team is 1-2 in his starts.....he has made 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .262 (16-for-61, 0hr).....Ross signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on Dec. 12.....he is signed through the 2024 season.

WE MEET AGAIN: Joe Ross played under current Brewers manager Pat Murphy as a 19-year-old pitcher in the Padres organization at Class-A Eugene in 2012.....Ross made 8 starts under Murphy that season, posting a 2.03 ERA.

LAST SEASON: Ross returned to action in August of last season and appeared in 8 games/7 starts in the San Francisco Giants farm system.....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery in June 2022, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache, the second such surgery of his career (also 2017).

**CAREER:** Is 27-29 with a 4.28 ERA in 101 games/79 starts (458ip, 218er).....is in his seventh Major League season with Washington (2015-19, 2021) and Milwaukee (2024)..... selected by San Diego in the first round (25th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Bishop O'Dowd High School in Oakland, CA, Ross was traded to Washington as part of a three-team (also Tampa Bay), 11-player deal on Dec. 18, 2014.....he was a member of the 2019 World Series-champion Nationals.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA in 4 games/3 starts (17.1ip, 8er)..... is 0-1 with a 6.48 ERA in 2 starts this season (8.1ip, 6er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 12-14 with a 3.94 ERA in 49 games/38 starts (212.1ip, 93er).....is 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA in 1 start this season (6.1ip, 2er).

CAREER vs. PIRATES: Is 1-1 with a 2.33 ERA in 4 starts (19.1ip, 19h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 24k, 2hr), including 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 3 starts at PNC Park (12ip, 13h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 13k, 2hr).
