The Brewers are currently on their third 4-game winning streak of the season....Milwaukee is the only team in the majors with 3 separate winning streaks of at least 4 games in 2024....the team is looking to win 5 straight games for the first time since 8/18-8/28 last season (9 games).

#### Home Sweet Road

The Brewers continue a 7-game trip to St. Louis (3-0) and Pittsburgh (4g) tonight....Milwaukee holds the best road record in the majors at 10-2 and are 4-0-0 in road series play, including sweeps of New York-NL (3g) and St. Louis (3g).

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 4-4 at home, going 1-1-1 in series play.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 10-2 on the road, going 4-0-0 in series play.... Milwaukee holds the best road winning percentage in baseball (.833).

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing **Craig Counsell**....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

**COACHES:** First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... **Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made five replay challenges this season, going 5-0....their last challenge came on 4/20 at St. Louis as an out call at first base involving Sal Frelick was overturned.
