### THE LATEST:

- ✦ The Blue Jays brought the tying run to the plate in the bottom of the 9th inning against the Phillies on Wednesday, but were ultimately beaten, 4-2, in the second game of their two-game set at Rogers Centre...Moved to 67-74 overall this season, 34-35 at home, and 2-5 against NL East opponents.
- ✦ Toronto has still won nine of its last 17 games, and has gone 12-10 over the last 22, and 20-18 over the last 38 contests...With a win tonight, can improve to 21-25 in series openers this season.

### DOUBLE THE FUN:

- ✦ Vladimir Guerrero Jr. got the Blue Jays on the board on Wednesday afternoon in the 1st inning with an RBI double to left, his career-best 40th two-bagger of the season...Became the first Blue Jay to record 40 doubles in a single season since Bo Bichette in 2022 (43)...Is one of five Major Leaguers to reach the milestone this season.
- ✦ Since the All-Star break, the Montreal, QC, native is batting .419 (67-for-160) with 19 doubles, a triple, 14 home runs, 35 RBI, an .813 SLG, and a 1.302 OPS... **Over that span, leads the Majors in hits, doubles, AVG, SLG, OPS, extra-base hits (34), and total bases (130),** while also ranking 2nd in OBP (.489), T-4th in RBI, and T-6th in home runs...**Leads the Majors in hard-hit balls (256) this season, 16 more than any other player** (Shohei Ohtani - 240), while his career-best 56.6% hard-hit rate sits 3rd in MLB.

### CAPTAIN ON THE BRIDGE:

- ✦ Alejandro Kirk put the Blue Jays in front, 2-1, in the 1st inning on Wednesday, plating a run with his 14th double of the year...Marked his 43rd RBI of the season, matching his total from last year in 38 fewer games...Since July 27th, has played 30 games (28 starts), batting .286 (30-for-105) with six doubles, three homers, and 19 RBI for a .782 OPS.

### PUTTING ON A VAR-SHOW:

- ✦ Daulton Varsho doubled and scored Toronto's opening run on Wednesday, his 21st two-bagger of the season...Has recorded an extra-base hit in three straight games, doing so for the fourth time this year...Has reached base safely in 27 of his last 29 games, going 30-for-111 (.270) with six doubles, a triple, five homers, 13 RBI, and 10 walks for an .824 OPS.

### EARLY BIRD GETS THE WORM:

- ✦ Toronto has scored in the opening frame in each of the last four games, totalling 16 1st-inning runs over that span...Marks the team's most 1st-inning runs in a four-game span in franchise history...The last AL team to do so was the Red Sox from June 26-July 2, 2019 (also 16 runs).

### INTERENTAINMENT VALUE:

- ✦ Toronto is playing its 13th interleague series of the year (15-19 so far)...Since the beginning of the 2021 season, the Blue Jays have gone 72-48 in interleague games (.600%), the 4th-best winning percentage in the Majors over that span.
- ✦ The Blue Jays have hit 727 home runs all-time in Interleague Play, trailing only the Yankees (734) for the most among all 30 teams in the Majors.

### GEORGIA ON MY MIND:

- ✦ The Blue Jays are on the road for a quick three-game, weekend trip to Atlanta, before returning home for a six-game homestand on Monday (3G vs. NYM, 3G vs. STL)...Have gone 33-39 away from Rogers Centre this year (.458%), ranking 10th in the AL in road winning percentage.
- ✦ Blue Jays hitters rank 5th among AL clubs in road OBP (.313) this year, while sitting 7th in road OPS (.699), 8th in road AVG (.237), and 8th in road SLG (.387)...The pitching staff currently ranks 9th in the AL in road ERA (4.17), 11th in road opponent average (.244), and 12th in road WHIP (1.32).

### GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

- ✦ Toronto hitters rank 3rd among AL clubs in doubles (252) this season...The Blue Jays also sit 3rd in the AL in walks (445), 4th in fewest strikeouts (1,064), 6th in extra-base hits (418), 6th in OBP (.313), 7th in AVG (.241), 7th in OPS (.710), 8th in hits (1,134), 8th in pitches/PA (3.88), and 9th in SLG (.397).

### THE D-JAYS:

- ✦ Entering play on Friday, the Blue Jays lead all Major League teams in Defensive Runs Saved (93), while sitting 5th in Outs Above Average (22)...The Blue Jays have also turned 108 double plays this year, 7th most in the AL.
- ✦ Daulton Varsho has tallied an MLB-leading 28 Defensive Runs Saved this year, seven more than any other player (12 in LF, 16 in CF)...Also sits T-7th in Outs Above Average (15).
- ✦ Ernie Clement has recorded 15 DRS this season, T-7th most in the Majors...Of those 15 runs saved, 10 have been at the hot corner, 2nd most among MLB third basemen.
- ✦ Alejandro Kirk has registered 13 DRS this year...Has thrown out a career-high 21 attempted basestealers, the most by a Blue Jays backstop since Russell Martin (25 in 2015), and trail only Cal Raleigh (23) and Will Smith (22) for the most in MLB this year...Ranks T-5th in MLB in catcher framing runs (8) and 5th in strike rate (50.5%).

- ✦ The Blue Jays won all three meetings with the Braves at Rogers Centre last season, outscoring their opponents by a combined score of 14-7...Have won each of their last nine games vs. Atlanta, including sweeping a three-game set at Truist Park from May 11-13, 2021...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only three franchises have had double-digit winning streaks against them (Dodgers - 2x, Reds, Cardinals).
- ✦ George Springer has hit safely in 12 of his 13 career games against Atlanta, batting .365 (19-for-52) with two doubles, six homers, and 11 RBI for a .750 SLG and a 1.182 OPS...His only two games at Truist Park came on July 4 & 5, 2017 as a member of the Astros, going 7-for-10 (.700) with two extra-base hits and three RBI (1.827 OPS)...His first two home runs in a Blue Jays uniform came on May 1, 2021 vs. ATL at TD Ballpark in Dunedin, FL.
- ✦ Vladimir Guerrero Jr. hit safely in all three games against the Braves last season, going 4-for-11 (.364) with a pair of doubles and a trio of RBI (.930 OPS)...Over 15 career games vs. ATL, has batted .304 (17-for-56) with six extra-base hits and 10 RBI (.840 OPS).
- ✦ Alejandro Kirk recorded his first career multi-home run game against the Braves on April 30, 2021 at TD Ballpark, taking both Drew Smyly and Edgar Santana deep for two-run shots in the 4th and 5th innings, respectively.

**Kevin Gausman, RHP #34**

**Born: Centennial, CO AGE: 33**

**TODAY'S GAME:**

✦ Making his 28th start of the season and 14th on the road...In his last time out, on 8/30 at MIN, took the hardluck loss after throwing 5.2 innings allowing a pair of runs on 4 hits and 4 walks with 4 strikeouts...Over his last 10 starts, has gone 6-3 while posting a 3.14 ERA (23 ER/66.0 IP) with 54 strikeouts, a 1.08 WHIP, and a .205 opponent AVG.

✦ Owns a 2.52 ERA on the road this season, trailing only Tyler Anderson (2.26), Chris Sale (2.42), and Jack Flaherty (2.49) for the lowest mark in the Majors.

**2024 HIGHLIGHTS:**

✦ Picked up his 100th career win on 8/25 vs. LAA, tossing 7.0 innings of one-run ball with 2 hits, no walks, and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts

✦ Tossed 8.0 innings of 2-run ball on 3 hits and 3 walks with a pair of strikeouts on 8/8 vs. BAL...Marked his 11th quality start of the season... Has pitched at least 8.0 innings in 3 starts this season, tied with Aaron Nola, Seth Lugo, Logan Gilbert, and Max Fried for the most instances in the Majors this season.

✦ Threw his second 9.0-inning complete game of the season his last time out, on 7/27 vs. TEX, giving up 3 runs on 4 hits and a pair of walks with 8 strikeouts...Threw a season-high 118 pitches (81 strikes), two shy of his career-high 120 on 9/14/16 at BOS...Is the only American League pitcher with multiple complete games this season, and is the first Blue Jay to accomplish the feat since Marcus Stroman had a pair in the 2017 season.

✦ Over 5 road starts between 4/23-6/8, posted a 0.55 ERA (2 ER/33.0 IP)... Marked the lowest ERA over a 5-start span on the road in franchise history.

✦ Tossed his first career 9.0 inning complete game shutout on 6/8 at OAK, allowing just 5 hits and a walk with a season-high tying 10 strikeouts... Marked his 2nd career complete game (5.0 inning CG on 7/13/14 at NYY), his 1st career shutout, and his 2nd career game pitching 9.0 shutout innings (5/5/18 at OAK)...Marked the Blue Jays 1st complete game shutout since Chris Bassitt's on 5/12/23 vs. ATL and their first coming on the road since Mark Buehrle did the same on 6/3/15 at WAS.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:**

✦ Named an All-Star for the 2nd time in his career (also: 2021)...Named to the All-MLB Second Team for the 2nd time as well (also: 2021).

✦ His career-high 237 strikeouts were the most in the AL (2nd: Pablo López - 234), and are the 4th most ever by a Blue Jay in a single season (Roger Clemens - 292 in 1997, Roger Clemens - 271 in 1998, Robbie Ray - 248 in 2021).

✦ Also ranked 1st in the AL in K rate (31.1%) and SO/9 (11.53) while finishing 4th in ERA (3.16), 6th in SO/BB (4.31), 10th in innings pitched (185.0), and 11th in WHIP (1.18)...Topped all AL pitchers with a 5.3 fWAR...Threw 100+ pitches on 18 occasions, tied with Blake Snell for the most in MLB.

**OTHER HIGHLIGHTS:**

✦ Set career-best marks in 2021 in innings pitched (192.0), wins (14), ERA (2.81), opponents' AVG (.210), and WHIP (1.04) with a career-high-tying 20 quality starts (also: 2023).

✦ Named an All-Star for the 1st time in his career in 2021 and finished 6th in NL Cy Young voting...Signed a 5-year deal with Toronto on 12/1/21.

✦ Selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the 1st round (4th overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft.

**VS. THE BRAVES:**

✦ Facing the Braves for the 3rd time in his career...Last faced ATL on 8/7/21 at Truist Park, tossing 6.0 innings of 2-run ball...The Braves are the only team Gausman has never recorded a victory against...With a win today, would be the 6th active player (24th all time) to record a win against all 30 teams, joining Gerrit Cole, Lance Lynn, Charlie Morton, Max Scherzer, and Justin Verlander.
