ALL-STARS: The Brewers were represented at the All-Star Game by Corbin Burnes, Josh Hader, Freddy Peralta, Brandon Woodruff and Omar Narváez.....the five players selected tied a franchise record, all consecutively (also 2018 and 2019)....it marked the first time in franchise history that the team had three or more pitchers selected.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as manager (492-453) and sixth full season.....he is second in franchise history in wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617)... under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinyen (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #53 - RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF (19gs, 7-4, 2.04)

WODDRUFF AT A GLANCE: Two-time All-Star Brandon Woodruff, 28, will make his 20th start of the season.....Woodruff last started on 7/17 at Cincinnati and received no decision in the Brewers' 7-4, 11-inning win (5.2ip, 2h, 2r, 1er, 4bb, 8k, 104 pitches).....the team is 13-6 in his starts.....he has 14 quality starts.....opponents are batting .168 (70-for-417, 9hr).....he has 137 strikeouts in 119.0 innings.....he was NL Player of the Week for 5/24-5/30.....Woodruff was selected in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University.

ENCORE!: Woodruff was the first Brewers pitcher to start on Opening Day in consecutive seasons since Yovani Gallardo started a franchise-record five in a row from 2010-14.

LAST SEASON: Woodruff went 3-5 with a 3.05 ERA in 13 starts last season.....he tied three others for the Major League lead in starts.....he ranked among the NL leaders in innings pitched (4th, 73.2), opponent batting average (4th, .204), H/9IP (4th, 6.72), WHIP (5th, 0.99), K/BB (5th, 5.06), strikeouts (7th, 91), K/9IP (7th, 11.12) and ERA (9th, 3.05).....the team went 6-7 in his starts.....he made a team-leading 6 quality starts.

CAREER: Is 26-15 with a 3.18 ERA in 81 games / 66 starts (399.2ip, 141er).....is in his fifth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2017-21).....was a 2019 and 2021 All-Star.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 14-5 with a 3.37 ERA in 42 games / 35 starts (208.1ip, 78er)....is 3-0 with a 2.14 ERA in 9 starts this season (54.2ip, 13er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 12-10 with a 2.96 ERA in 39 games / 31 starts [191.1ip, 63er]....is 4-4 with a 1.96 ERA in 10 starts this season [64.1ip, 14er].

CAREER vs. WHITE SDX: Received a no-decision in his only start on 8/4/20 at American Family Field (6ip, 8h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr)....Brewers lost, 3-2.
