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THE TWINS: Completed their six-game homestand last week, going 4-2 (2-1 vs. Cleveland and 2-1 vs. Los Angeles-AL)...they earned their fifth-straight series win and eighth in their last nine chances...tonight, they will begin the "second half" with the first of three weekend games at Wrigley Field...after this series, they will travel to Cleveland for four games against the Guardians at Progressive Field (July 20-23).
⌘ A win today would put the Twins back at .500 for the first time since they were 12-12 through their game on April 22 at New York-NL.
⌘ Twins have won six of their last eight and nine of their last 13.

WINNESOTA: Since May 9, the Twins have gone 32-26, tied with Texas for the second-most wins in the AL, trailing Chicago-AL (33-24)...since June 14, the Twins have gone 16-9, posting a winning percentage of .640, second-best in the AL since that date...below are overall MLB rankings since June 14:

FRIENDLY CONFINES. MINNESOTA NICE: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the 47th time in their history tonight...the Twins are 22-24 all-time against the Cubs, going 7-7 at Target Field, 9-14 at Wrigley Field and 6-3 at the Metrodome...Minnesota has gone 7-4 in its last 11 against the Cubs (since '21).

⌘ 46 games against the Cubs are second-most against any National League opponent (Pittsburgh - 51)...this excludes Milwaukee, which was in the AL from 1969-97.
⌘ Twins hosted the Cubs for three games from July 8-10, 2025, taking two of three.
⌘ Twins last visited Wrigley Field for three games from August 5-7, 2024, winning just once...despite the two-game skid, the Twins have won five of their last seven at Wrigley...their last series win here was a two-game sweep in September of 2021.
⌘ Victor Caratini made his debut with the Cubs on June 28, 2017 at Washington...he recorded his first career hit at Wrigley Field on July 9, 2017, doubling off Wade LeBlanc.
⌘ In eight career games against the Cubs, Kody Clemens is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with two doubles, three home runs, four RBI and a 1.098 OPS.
⌘ In 11 career games against the Cubs, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .296 (8-for-27) with three doubles, one home run, four RBI, three walks and a .925 OPS.
⌘ Royce Lewis was named MVP of the 2016 Under Armour All-American Game at Wrigley Field.

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone just 11-19 against National League opponents this season...they have gone 0-3 vs. Cincinnati (April 17-19), 1-2 at New York-NL (April 21-23), 1-2 at Washington (May 5-7), 2-1 vs. Miami (May 12-14), 1-2 vs. Milwaukee (May 15-17), 0-3 vs. Pittsburgh (May 29-31), 2-1 vs. St. Louis (June 12-14), 2-1 at Arizona (June 19-21), 0-3 vs. Los Angeles (June 22-24) and 2-1 vs. Colorado (June 26-28)...their next NL opponent will be the Brewers from August 7-9 at American Family Field.

NORTH STARS: Twins sent outfielder Byron Buxton, right-handed pitcher Joe Ryan and manager Derek Shelton to the 96th All-Star Game in Philadelphia this week.

⌘ Ryan pitched the fourth inning, facing four batters...he allowed a single to Juan Soto, struck out Freddie Freeman and CJ Abrams (both swinging), then induced a pop out to Max Muncy...he threw 16 pitches, 12 strikes...it was Ryan's second ASG honor (2025).
⌘ Buxton did not play in the game (IL - right hip strain)...he was voted in by the fans, receiving 1,106,264 votes, third-most among AL outfielders (Judge - 1,788,499 & Trout - 1,735,051)...marked his third All-Star honor (2022 & 2025).
⌘ Shelly made his second appearance as an honorary coach for Toronto's John Schneider after serving in that same role in Seattle in 2023 for Rob Thomson's NL squad.
⌘ Walker Jenkins started in centerfield for the AL Team in the Futures Game on Sunday and went 0-for-1 with two walks.

RUN OF SHOW: Twins enter today leading the AL in runs scored at 471, nine ahead of New York-AL (462)...last time the Twins led the AL in runs scored at the break was in 2019, when they held a share of the lead with Boston...last time they led by themselves was in 1992 (451)...they also led in 1989 (420), 1983 (386), 1977 (504), 1967 (366), 1965 (390), 1964 (412) and 1963 (383).
⌘ Twins have six different players with 40-plus runs scored: Byron Buxton (57), Josh Bell (48), Luke Keaschall (48), Kody Clemens (45), Brooks Lee (44) and Trevor Larnach (44)...only the Cubs and Brewers have as many individual players with 40-plus runs scored (also 6).

HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES: The Twins have gone 9-3 in their last 12 road games...in those 12, they have hit .290 (127-for-438) and averaged 7.2 runs-per-game...they have outscored opponents 86-49.
⌘ They have scored in the first inning in nine of those 12 games, totaling 21 runs in those innings...over that span of games, the 21 first-inning runs have accounted for 24% of their 86 total runs scored.
⌘ Twins enter this weekend having won four-straight road series' (6/15-18 at TEX, 6/19-21 at ARI, 6/29-7/1 at HOU & 7/3-5 at NYY)...they are seeking their fifth-straight road series win this weekend, which would mark the first time since September 1-October 1, 2023, when they won each of their final five road series at Texas, at Cleveland, at Chicago-AL, at Cincinnati and at Colorado.

SUMMER MOUNDNESS: Over their last 23 games, since June 16, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 8-7, 3.16 ERA (128.0 IP, 45 ER) with 42 walks, 132 strikeouts and 10 quality starts...since that date, they rank fourth in the AL in ERA...they have not allowed more than four runs in any of those starts and have allowed two runs-or-fewer in 16 of those.

I AM THE ONE WHO 'NACHS: Over his last 22 games, since June 14, Trevor Larnach is hitting .375 (30-for-80) with eight doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, a .425 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.050 OPS.

⌘ Larnach is leading off today for the 21st time in the club's last 24 games...from the number one spot in the lineup, he is hitting .344 (31-for-90) with a .398 on-base percentage, a .567 slugging percentage and a .965 OPS...his batting average from the leadoff spot ranks third-highest in baseball (minimum of 90 PA), trailing Pete Crow-Armstrong (.358) and Yandy Diaz (.345).
