LAST GAME: The D-backs won 13-6 vs. Rockies yesterday for their fifth series sweep and second since the All-Star break, and second series win in their last 3...improved to a .500+ record at home (30-30) for the first time since July 21 (26-26).

- Had a franchise-high 9 consecutive 2-out hits in the fifth inning...was the fourth instance since 2010 (also: May 23, 2023, Blue Jays @ Rays, 9 straight in ninth inning; May 4, 2019, Red Sox @ White Sox, 10 straight in third inning; July 30, 2010, Rockies vs. Cubs, 11 straight in eighth inning) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- Tied franchise high (third time) with 8 runs scored with 2 outs (also: June 21, 2017 @ Rockies, fourth inning; July 12, 2008 @ Phillies, fourth inning) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- 8-run fifth inning was the third occurrence scoring 8+ runs in an inning (also: April 18 @ Cubs, 10 runs in eighth inning; March 30 vs. Cubs, 8 runs in eighth inning).
- Went 10-for-15 with runners in scoring position.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has hit safely in 7 of his last 9 games...recorded his fourth outfield assist (fifth innina).
- Connor Kaiser recorded his first Major League hit (double in seventh inning).
- · Corbin Carroll recorded his career-high and teamhigh seventh outfield assist (second inning), tied for fourth in NL (also: 3 others).
- Brandon Pfaadt earned his career-high 12th win.

D-BACKS ROSTER MOVES: Recalled RHP Juan Morillo from Triple-A Reno, claimed RHP **Gus Varland** from the White Sox and optioned to Reno, and designated RHP Kendall Graveman and RHP Jeff Brigham for assignment.

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs have homered in 8 straight games (since Aug. 2)...third longest active streak in the Majors, behind the Mariners (11) and Braves (9)...Arizona's season high is 12 straight games with a homer (June 23-July 5).

- In their last 3 games with runners in scoring position, the D-backs are hitting .500 (15-for-30)/.500 OBP/.767 SLG/1.267 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 homer, 20 RBI and 1
- Geraldo Perdomo has hit safely in 7 straight games, including 3 multi-hit games...is hitting .410 (16-for-39)/.510 OBP/.564 SLG/1.074 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 9 walks (3 K).
- Corbin Carroll has 1+ RBI in 4 straight games, tied for the longest active streak (also: 2 others), and an extra-base hit in 4 straight games (3 HR, 1 2B), the second longest active streak, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD
- Blaze Alexander has 3 straight multi-hit games, tied for the second longest active streak (also: 4 others) behind Carlos Correa/HOU (5)...has 4 multi-hit performances in his last 7 games and hit safely in 8 of his last
- Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 8 straight games since August 1, hitting .323 (10-for-31)/.417 OBP/.516 SLG/.933 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 5 walks (4 K).

TRENDING BATS: Over his last 11 games (since July 29), Geraldo Perdomo is hitting .410 (16-for-39)/.510 OBP/.564 SLG/1.074 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 9 walks...has struck out 3 times in his last 49 PA.

- Blaze Alexander, over his last 9 games since August 1, is hitting .387 (12-for-31)/.500 OBP/.645 SLG/1.145 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI, 5 walks and 2 hit-by-pitches.
- · Corbin Carroll, over his last 8 games, has a .742 SLG with 2 doubles, 4 homers and 9 RBI.
- Adrian Del Castillo, over his last 5 games, has a .600 SLG with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 5 RBI.

ROAD ROLL: Corbin Carroll reached base safely in 6 straight road games, hitting .300 (6-for-20)/.423 OBP/.600 SLG/1.023 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 5 walks (3 K)...has recorded 1+ RBI in 3 straight road games

Geraldo Perdomo has reached base safely in 5 straight road games, hitting .412 (7-for-17)/.500 OBP/.647 SLG/1.147 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 4 walks...has not struck out in 23 straight road

VS. RANGERS: Since 2023, the D-backs are 5-3 in their 8 matchups...the D-backs swept their 2 games vs. Rangers @ Chase Field from Sept. 10-11, 2024, outscoring them 20-4.

 Against AL West opponents since 2023, the D-backs have gone 22-22: 6-6 currently this season, 8-8 in 2024 and 8-8 in 2023.

VS. OPPOSING STARTERS: In their last 8 games vs. opposing starters, the D-backs have scored 39 earned runs in 36.1 innings (9.66 ERA) with a .329 AVG/.412 OBP/.564 SLG/.976 OPS with 9 doubles, 1 triple, 8 homers and 20 walks...since August 2, their .329 AVG, .412 OBP, .564 SLG, .953 OPS, 37 runs and 20 walks vs. opposing starters rank best among NL teams.

EARLY SCORING: The D-backs have scored 2+ runs within the first 3.0 innings in 7 straight games (tied for the longest streak in MLB this season with the Phillies) and have scored 1+ first inning runs in 6 straight games, the longest first-inning streak in the Majors this season, ahead of the Astros (5 - active) and Twins (5).

Since the All-Star break, among MLB teams in the first 3.0 innings, the D-backs rank in AVG (2nd, .341), runs (2nd, 21), OBP (3rd, .412), OPS (3rd, .976), SLG (4th, .565), extra-base hits (T-4th, 10) and walks (T-6th, 9).

LEADOFF TRIPLES & HOMERS: Corbin Carroll's 5 leadoff triples are tied for the most by a player in a season since the expansion era (1961).....no player has hit 6 in a season...5 tied with Nyjer Morgan/WSH (2010), Curtis Granderson/DET (2006), Marquis Grissom/ATL (1996), Darren Lewis/SF (1994), Willie Wilson/KC (1985), Alfredo Griffin/TOR (1980), Omar Moreno/PIT (1980), Ralph Garr/ATL (1975) and Don Kessinger/CHC (1975).

NEXT STARTER: RHP ANTHONY DESCLAFANI (1-2, 4.20)

- Will make his fourth start for the D-backs.
- Did not factor in the decision in his last start on Aug. 6 vs. Padres after tossing 4.1 scoreless innings with 3 hits, 0 walks and 4 strikeouts.
- Won in his lone start @ Rangers while with the Reds on June 21, 2016...tossed 7.0 innings with 2 runs allowed on 5 hits and 1 walk with 6 strikeouts.

HOW HE STARTED: D-backs' second-round pick (No. 56) in the 2019 draft.

- Named D-backs' 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 7-4 with a 3.17 ERA (41 ER in 116.1 IP) with 163 strikeouts (T-4th in MiLB) over 22 starts between High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo.
- Attended the University of Oregon...as a junior in 2019, was First-Team All-Pac-12, led the conference with 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
