TODAY'S GAME: The Giants can still take the series here in LA with a win in tonight's finale...SF is looking for its first series win here at UNIQLO Field at Dodger Stadium since sweeping a three-game set June 16-18, 2023...entering this series, SF had lost five straight series to the Dodgers in LA (4-14 in that time).

- ▶ Tonight's LA starter, RHP Emmet Sheehan, has faced SF four times in his career (three of which were starts), allowing two runs on just three hits in 22.0 innings...he's struck out 25 in that time...however, SF is 2-2 in the four games.
- ▶ The Giants are 4-6 on getaway days thus far in 2026, but 1-5 in such games on the road.

SHOULD WE GET HIM SUSIECAKES?: C Daniel Susac celebrates his 25th birthday today.

- ▶ He caught 9.0 innings for Triple-A Sacramento last night at Round Rock as he makes his way back from right elbow ulnar neuritis.
- ▶ He's caught each of the last three days...at the plate in his five rehab games he's gone 9-for-17 (.529) with five runs scored, two homers, five, RBI, two walks, a strikeout and one stolen base.

LANDMAN: RHP Landen Roupp takes the hill tonight for his ninth start of the campaign and his second time this season facing the Dodgers this season.

- ▶ Last Saturday against the Pirates, Roupp turned in his shortest outing of the season after running up a pitch count of 94 in 4.0 innings despite allowing only one run in SF's 13-3 loss...he allowed three hits, walked three and fanned a season-high eight batters.
- ▶ He had trouble getting ahead to start at-bats with a 44.4% first pitch strike percentage, his second-lowest in a game this season to only a 35.0% first pitch strike percentage in his start against LA on April 21.
- ▶ Speaking of the Dodgers, Roupp beat LA on April 21 in the Giants' 3-1 win...he walked five in that outing, but gave up just one hit and struck out seven in 5.0 innings.
- ▶ The 27-year-old has been better on the road this season in four starts, logging a 2.01 ERA (5er, 22.1ip) while going 3-1.

ADDRESS IT AND MOVE ON: The Giants were shut out for a Major League-leading eighth time last night...the eight shutouts nearly equals the total of times SF was blanked all of last season (11).

- ▶ The eight shutouts through their first 43 games are the second-most in Giants history behind the 1976 club that was blanked nine times in the first 43 games.

I'LL HAVE WHAT HE'S HAVING: IF/DH Rafael Devers recorded two of SF's six hits last night and has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games dating to Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 30.

- ▶ In this time, Devers is hitting .364 (16-for-44) with eight extra-base hits, eight RBI, eight runs scored and six walks...he's raised his OPS over 160 points in that time (from .530 after Game 1 on April 30 to its current spot at .691 entering play today).

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS: This three-city, 10-game road trip continues tomorrow in Sacramento as the Giants will visit the A's at Sutter Health Park.

- ▶ SF went 5-1 against the A's last season, including a 2-1 mark in Sacramento.
- ▶ It's been a rough start for the Giants against the American League in 2026...SF is 1-8 against the junior circuit while going 17-17 against NL foes...to date, the Giants have faced the Yankees (0-3), Orioles (1-2) and Rays (0-3) from the AL.

THE FUTURE, CONAN?: Down in the Arizona Complex League last night the ACL Giants clubbed the ACL Dodgers 29-2 with **IF's Luis Hernández** and **Josuar González** leading the way...Hernández (17) went 5-for-5 with three doubles, a homer and nine RBI while González (18) was 3-for-3 with six runs scored, a double, four RBI and three walks.

BASH(OF) BRO: Former Giants **IF Brandon Crawford** will be officially inducted into the Bay Area Sports Hall of Fame tonight as part of this year's class.

- ▶ The Pleasanton native spent 13 of his 14 MLB seasons in a Giants uniform, helping guide them to a pair of World Series titles in 2012 and 2014...Crawford was a three-time All-Star (2015, 2018 and 2021), a four-time Gold Glove winner (2015-2017, 2021) and a Silver Slugger winner (2015) during his career.

WITH SAN FRANCISCO: Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco...the 27-year-old is slated to make his ninth start of the season tonight and is 5-3 through his first eight starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss against Pittsburgh after pitching a season-low 4.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits and three walks...Roupp struck out a season-best eight batters, but his high pitch count (94) chased him from the game after he gave up a leadoff infield single to start the 5th inning, which came around to score after the bullpen had a difficult inning...the right-hander is 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA in two starts in May after going 5-1 with a 2.55 ERA in the first month of the season.

VS. LOS ANGELES-NL: Will be facing the Dodgers for the sixth time in his career tonight...Roupp is 1-2 over five career appearances (three starts) against LA with a 5.71 ERA (11er, 17.1ip) and 22 strikeouts (11.42 SO/9ip)...earned the win against them earlier this season on April 21 at Oracle Park, turning in 5.0 innings with one run on one hit with and seven strikeouts and five walks...over his last two starts against the Dodgers, Roupp is 1-1 with a 1.64 ERA (2er, 11.0ip), .205 opposing average & 15 strikeouts (12.27 SO/9ip).

UP IN THE RANKS: Roupp leads all qualified NL pitchers with a 0.21 HR/9.0ip this season and ranks among the top of the National League in opponents' SLG (.245, T-3rd), strikeouts per nine (10.51, 5th), OPS (.529, 6th), FIP (2.52, 6th) and opposing average (.187, 9th).

OF THE HIGHEST VALUE: Roupp's 23.8% hard-hit rate early this season is currently a career-best and ranks as the 10th-lowest figure in the Majors...he is the only starting pitcher yet to allow a barrel this season (105 batted balls)...additionally, Roupp is tied for 14th in the Majors in pitching run value (11) this year.

STOPPER: Roupp has become a stopper for SF...dating back to the start of the last season, Roupp is 8-6 following a loss with a 3.19 ERA (32er, 90.1ip) in 18 starts.

ROAD WARRIOR: Through the early going this season, Roupp has a 2.01 ERA (5er, 22.1ip) in four starts on the road (3-1) compared to a 4.22 ERA (10er, 21.1ip) in four starts at Oracle Park (2-2)...his 2.01 ERA on the road is tied for ninth-best amongst qualified pitchers while his 2.40 FIP ranks eighth.

SINK OR SWIM: Roupp's largest improvement this season so far has arguably been his primary pitch (37.1% usage), his sinker...the pitch has a +6 run value this season, with opponents going just 9-for-52 (.173) off his sinker with 11 strikeouts...last season, opponents had a .355 average (60x169) off the pitch, which had a -6 run value.

CHANGING THINGS UP: The righty has also found a lot of success with his changeup this season, giving up just three hits in 34 at-bats (.088) ending with the pitch...Roupp has 12 strikeouts with his changeup so far this season, nearing his total (19) from all of 2025.

AIN'T NOBODY GOT TIME FOR THAT: Roupp averages 12.9 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, which is tied for the sixth-fastest in MLB...with runners on base, he ranks 14th with a 16.3 average between pitches...the league average thus far in 2026 is 16.1 seconds with the bases empty and 18.8 seconds with runners on base.

MIXING IT UP: In 2025, Roupp's curveball (thrown 35.7% of the time) was very effective, as opponents were just 29x147 (.197) with 49 strikeouts and a 35.8% whiff rate against it... this season, he's mixing his pitches more, as his curveball usage has dropped to 29.0%...it's been just as effective, as opponents are 10x51 (.196) off the curve with a 32.7% whiff rate...the biggest change is his cutter usage, which has increased from 6.7% in 2025 to 12.3% through eight starts in 2026.

TYLER MAHLE RHP #54

2026 RECORD: 1-4, 5.18 ERA

- ▶ Took a no-decision last Sunday in SF's 7-6 extra-innings, walk-off victory over the Pirates...threw 5.2 innings with four runs (two HRs) on five hits while striking out a season-high eight batters and walking two.
- ▶ Will face the A's for just the third time in his career...suffered the loss both times despite sporting a 1.50 ERA (2er, 12.0ip), .182 BAA & 14 strikeouts (10.5K/9ip) in the starts.

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Sweeper
Last Game: 5/13 at LAD; 2.0ip, 2h (36 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Monday...made 13 appearances with the River Cats out of the 'pen and had a 5.40 ERA (10er, 16.2ip) with 18 strikeouts and seven walks.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role... recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25.
- ▶ Left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

#47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP *(bohr-RUCK-ee)*

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinkers, Split Finger, Sweeper
Last Game: 5/10 vs. PIT; W, 2.0ip, 2bb, 1bb, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Threw 2.0 hitless, scoreless innings with a strikeout to get his first win as a Giant on Sunday vs. Pittsburgh.
- ▶ Has a 5.06 ERA (3er, 5.1ip) and .316 BAA over his last five games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-29 (.172) with four walks and eight strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (72-for-398) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 12-for-26 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP *(BROO-baker)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinkers, Slider, Cutter, Changeup
Last Game: 5/11 at LAD; 1.0ip, k (12 pitches)

- ▶ In his last five outings, he has a 6.14 ERA (5er, 7.1ip) and .333 BAA (10x30)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x40).
- ▶ Has thrown 9.1 scoreless innings in seven appearances on the road...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in eight of 14 contests (5.30 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 13-for-42 (.310) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 7-for-28 (.250).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinkers, Splitter
Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; 0.1ip, k (6 pitches)

- ▶ Has surrendered three runs (two ER) in 18.0ip this year (1.00 ERA).
- ▶ Has not allowed an earned run in his last 12g (9.2ip, 4h, 1r, 6bb, 5k).
- ▶ His 1.00 ERA ranks as the fourth-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-22 (.091) against him this season, and 19-for-105 in his career (.181).
- ▶ His 26.5% hard hit rate ranks in the top 5% of MLB.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP *(HENT-chiss)*

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinkers
Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; 1.0ip, h, 2bb, 2k (32 pitches)

- ▶ Has made two appearances with SF, logging 1.1-scoreless innings with three walks and two strikeouts.
- ▶ This is his first MLB action since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL Sunday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinkers, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; SV, 1.1ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Earned second career save on Tuesday night.
- ▶ His 1.40 ERA (3er, 19.1ip) is 10th-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Owns a 24.1% strikeout rate and .138 BAA (9x65) this season.
- ▶ Has a 5.59 BB/9ip...his 15.2% BB rate ranks in the bottom 8% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 5-for-39 (.128) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 4-for-26 (.154) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP *(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinkers, Slider, Changeup
Last Game: 5/13 at LAD; 1.1ip, bb (12 pitches)

- ▶ Activated May 5 after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 5.1 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in five games so far.
- ▶ Batters are 1-for-12 with a single off his sinker thus far, which he's thrown 51.5% of the time...he threw it 34.3% of the time in his stint w/SF last season.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider
Last Game: 5/11 at LAD; H; 1.0ip, h, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with nine holds, which is tied for the third-most in the Majors.
- ▶ 15 of his 19 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 9-for-61 (.148) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 5-for-36 (.139) with 13 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 84.8 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 5% of the league while his 25.5% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 4%.
- ▶ His 1.67 xERA is third-best in the Majors behind Mason Miller (0.80) and Dylan Lee (1.49).
