BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals open a three-game series with the Colorado Rockies as their second stop on a three-city road trip through the National League West. The Cardinals arrived from Los Angeles at their Denver hotel at 4:15 a.m., Mountain Time earlier this morning. The Cardinals lost to the Dodgers 3-2 in walk-off fashion after taking the first two games of the series for their 4th straight series win over the back-to-back World Champions. The Cardinals will finish their road trip in San Francisco over Labor Day (Sept. 7-9).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 17.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and nine games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals are 4.0 games out of the 3rd Wild Card position held by Arizona and still have to overtake San Diego and Miami in their path. St. Louis has 12 road games remaining and nine home games.

CARDINALS ACTIVATE PALLANTE; OPTION FERNANDEZ: Prior to tonight's game the Cardinals activated starting pitcher **Andre Pallante** from the 15-day Injured List (right elbow inflammation) and optioned RHP **Ryan Fernandez** to Memphis (AAA). Pallante last pitched in a Major League game on August 17 at Cincinnati. He was with the team in Los Angeles and traveled ahead last night for today's start.

BROKEN WINGS: Since August 18, the Cardinals placed seven players on the Injured List with RHP **Andre Pallante** (right elbow), RHP **Hunter Dobbins** (right forearm), SS **Masyn Winn** (left thumb), OF **Everson Pereira** (left hand), RHP **Peter Strzelecki** (right forearm), INF **Blaze Jordan** (left ankle) and INF **JJ Wetherholt** (right wrist) all currently out with injuries. Pallante was activated today and Winn has been eligible to return since Sept. 1.

DOBBINS UNDERGOES SURGERY: Cardinals RHP **Hunter Dobbins** underwent reconstructive surgery for his right elbow in Dallas on Wednesday by Dr. Keith Meister. The hurler is estimated to require a 12-month recovery period.

FOREVER YOUNG: Among the Cardinals final six opponents, Cardinals 40-year old manager **Oliver Marmol** will be matched up with five managers who have yet to record a full season (Warren Schaeffer, COL; Tony Vitello, SF; Will Venable, CWS; Blake Butera, WSH & Don Kelly, PIT). Only Pat Murphy (MIL) has managed more than a full season, while Marmol is coming to the end of his 5th full season as manager in St. Louis.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGHS: Cardinals INF **Nolan Gorman** began his career hitting safely in 12 straight games vs. the Rockies (8/9/22-6/7/24), longest by a Cardinals player to begin his career and four shy of the MLB mark by **Ely De La Cruz** (CIN) with 16. Gorman has homered in 3-of-5 career games at Coors Field. Injured SS **Masyn Winn** has hit safely in his first six games at Coors Field, two games behind the club record by **Tommy Edman** (8) and one behind **Jon Jay** and **Mark McGwire** with 7.

20/20 VISION: Cardinals All-Star OF **Jordan Walker** (28 HR/18 SB) needs two stolen bases to become the 11th instance a Cardinals player has achieved 20 HR and 20 SB in a single season and the first since **Tommy Pham** in 2017. Walker would join a Cardinals list that includes Pham, **Ray Lankford** (5x), **Lou Brock** (1967), **Brian Jordan** (1995), **Fernando Tatis** (1999), **Reggie Sanders** (2004). Lankford ran off four consecutive seasons (1995-98).

SWINGING SENSATION: 22-year old rookie catcher **Leo Bernal** made his Major League debut on Tuesday at Dodger Stadium and recorded a two-RBI bases loaded single in his first game. He followed it up with his first Major League home run on Wednesday off **Yoshinobu Yamamoto** and tallied his first multi-hit game last night. Bernal, the No. 5 prospect in the Cardinals organization by *Baseball America*, has started games at catcher, designated hitter and first base, and even switched from first base to catcher last night in a defensive/pinch-hit strategy with **Alec Burleson** in the 6th inning.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE! Cardinals INF **Thomas Saggese** had a career series in Los Angeles with a multi-home run game, a span of 3 home runs over a pair of games and six RBI during the series. Saggese was cited with **Albert Pujols** as the last Cardinals player with a multi-home run game against the Dodgers (17th Cardinal all-time) and the most recent Cardinal with three home runs over a two-game period vs. LA (Pujols last in 2011).

COLORADO CONNECTIONS

Kyle Leahy was born in and resides in Boulder... graduated from Erie High School...selected to play at the Colorado High School Futures Game at Coors Field...played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction (2016-18).

Daniel Descalso played two seasons with Colorado (2015-16).

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Albert Pujols** made MLB debut at Coors Field (Apr. 2, 2001)... singled off Mike Hampton that night for his first hit.

Jose Quintana was traded from Pittsburgh to St. Louis at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline and made 12 regular season and one postseason start.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Holliday** was originally selected by Colorado in the 7th round of the 1998 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons for the Rockies (2004-08, '18) where he was a three-time All-Star and appeared in the 2007 World Series.

Jaden Hill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 38th round of the 2018 MLB draft, but did not sign Louisiana State University.

Bryan Torres played in 67 games for the 2019 Rocky Mountain Vibes (Rookie-Brewers).

Justin Bruihl pitched in seven games for the Rockies in 2023.

Cardinals Assistant General Manager **Randy Flores** pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, 2009-10) over two stints with Colorado.

National Baseball Hall of Fame outfielder **Larry Walker** played for Colorado (1995-04) and St. Louis (2004-05)...member of 2004 NL Champions.

Rockies Bullpen Coach **Matt Buschmann** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Lafayette High School in Wildwood, Mo.

TJ Rumfield's father, **Toby Rumfield**, played in 13 games for Memphis (AAA) in 2002 where he was teammates with **Stubby Clapp**.

Rockies MLB.com **Thomas Harding** covered the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) for two seasons for the Commercial Appeal (1998-99)...mentored recent Cardinals MLB.com writer **Anne Rogers**.

Rockies Special Assistant **Clint Hurdle** played in 78 games for St. Louis in 1986.

Ricky Horton pitched for the 1990 Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) and 1991 Colorado Springs Sky Sox (AAA-Indians).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is Boulder native...graduated from Centaurus High School in Lafayette...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist **Benjamin Hochman** previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

Matt Pauley broadcasted for the Colorado Springs Sky Sox (2010-16) and Air Force Athletics.

Rockies Media Relations & Baseball Info Manager **Kevin Collins** served as the 2015 Media Relations Intern for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

TONIGHT'S START:

- Traveled ahead of the team from Los Angeles and arrived in Denver last night.
- Making his 25th start of the season and his 86th career start (194th career appearance); has three consecutive 20+ start seasons with a career-high 31 in 2025.
- Activated from the 15-Day Injured List today. Missed 15 games (Aug. 18-Sept. 3) due to right elbow inflammation.
- Enters on a 38.0-inning homerless streak, 8th-longest active streak in MLB.
- Looking to become the NL's 9th starter with 13+ wins. Compiled a 36-35 career record.
- Pallante's 12 wins in his first 22 starts were the most since 2015: **Carlos Martinez** (12-3) and **Michael Wacha** (13-4).
- Andre is the first Cardinal since **Joaquin Andujar** (1983-84) to bounce back from a 15+ loss season and win 10 or more games the very next season; Andujar lost 16 games in 1983 but then produced a 20-win season in 1984 and a 21-win season in 1985.
- Owns an 10.08 Run Support Average on the road (2nd highest in MLB) but just 3.12 at home; received 3 runs or fewer in 12 of his 14 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 7 of his 10 Road starts.
- Making his his 194th career appearance to pass **Mark Littell** for 62nd all-time among Cardinals pitchers. He has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach both 193 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 80-or-more starts.
- Is 7-0 in 10 road starts (St. Louis is 7-3) ... His 7 road wins are T-3rd in the NL, while Pallante and Jesus Lizardo (8-0) are the only two undefeated MLB pitchers with 5+ road victories.**
- Has made 10 consecutive road starts of 5.0+ IP, one shy of **Kyle Leahy's** team-high 11 straight such starts on the road.
- Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (85), wins (36), and innings pitched (602.0).**
- Began the season with 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP (March 31-May 23), first Cardinal to do so since RHP **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26) most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, August 17-Game 2 vs. Cincinnati at GABP): ND, L, 6-5 (10); 6.0 IP, 10 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 5 SO - 88 pitches.

- Maneuvered through 6.0 innings allowing 10 hits and four runs, with three in the 6th inning, that ended up costing him the decision in a game St. Louis lost 6-5 in 10 innings.
- Was his 6th straight start without allowing a home run (38.0 IP).
- Did not factor in the decision, but has not lost on the road this season. Last road loss (Sept. 12, 2025 at Milwaukee).

2026 NOTES:

MY BEST FRIEND: Has induced 17 groundball double plays this season (T-4th in NL) matching his career-high in his 2022 rookie campaign.

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .203 BA (31-153) with his slider, and 44 of his 97 strikeouts this season have come via the slider. Boasts a 12 Run Value on his slider, 7th-best slider in MLB according to *Baseball Savant* this season.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 23 of his 24 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in 15 of those games.

RIGHT ON: His .261 Opp. BA vs. RHB (50-224) would be the lowest of his career by a -.036 margin, behind his .267 mark (65-243) in 2024.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .764 OPS, 15 runs and 4 HRs in 1st inning. Batters are hitting .333 (21-63) when contacting the 1st pitch of an at-bat.

YANKEE DOODLE: With 1 run allowed on 3 hits in 5.1 IP on 8/5 at NYY, became the 3rd Cardinals starter in regular-season play to pitch at least 5.0 frames with 3-or-fewer hits allowed to the Yankees (Last: **Jordan Montgomery** on 7/2/23 at Busch Stadium), and the 2nd to do so at New York in franchise history (Also: **Clarence Mitchell**; 5.2 IP, 2 H in 1928 World Series Game 2 at Yankee Stadium).

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball pct. (61.8%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 500.0+ IP.*** As a starting pitcher (458.1 IP), Pallante's 58.7 career groundball pct. currently is the 9th-highest in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 450.0 IP as starter).

- Hurled 5.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts in a 5-1 win at Busch Stadium on June 9, 2024.
- Prior to his last start, his only run allowed came on a solo home run to **Ryan McMahon** on Aug. 5, 2023 at Busch Stadium.
- St. Louis is 5-2 in his seven appearances vs. Colorado.
- Was 1-0 with a 1.08 ERA (8.1 IP) in five relief appearances, three of those appearances of 2.0+ innings.

LAST START vs. ROCKIES (July 23, 2025 at Coors Field): L, 6-0: 5.0 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 0 HR, 2 BB, 5 K - 97 pitches

- Dropped a 6-0 decision to the Rockies at Coors Field, allowing 5 runs on 9 hits, with 4 of the runs and 5 hits coming in the Rockies 2nd inning.
