RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue a six-game homestand against the Rangers (1-0, two to play) and Marlins (three to play) tonight at Steinbrenner Field...the sets will wrap up the season series with both clubs...have alternated wins and losses in their last five games (3-2), but have gone 10-3 in their last 13, 12-6 in their last 18, 15-8 in their last 23, 17-11 in their last 28 and 22-15 in their last 37...are 10-4 over a span in which 15 of 19 games will take place at home (May 19–June 8)...following the latter stretch, 59 of their remaining 97 games (60.8%) will be on the road...are third in the AL in run differential (+45) behind the Yankees (+99) and Tigers (+91)...have been above .500 for a season-high seven consecutive days...with a win tonight, they can match their season-high-water mark (3G, 4-1 entering play on April 2)...are tied with the Blue Jays for second in the AL East, 6.5 GB the division-leading Yankees (37-22)...have spent two days in first, 11 in second, 19 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

★ The Rays won their season-high fourth straight series opener last night, 5-1, snapping a club-record-tying seven-game losing streak to the Rangers with their first win over Texas since April 2, 2024 at Tropicana Field (5-2).

★ Tampa Bay improved to 20-1 (.952) when scoring five runs or more, the best such record in the majors, outpacing the Twins (23-2/.920)...the Rays have also won eight straight games when scoring four runs or more (24-6 overall).

★ The Rays have outscored opponents, 79-24 (+55), during their 10-3 stretch, their best mark over any 13-game span since April 1-14, 2023 (+64)...over that timeframe (since May 20), they lead the majors in run differential, runs scored per game (6.08), runs allowed per game (1.85), OPS (.825), home runs (22), extra-base hits (50), stolen bases (23), opp. average (.197), opp. on-base pct. (.252), opp. slugging pct. (.303), opp. OPS (.556), WHIP (0.92) and walk rate (5.6%).

★ The Rays have allowed 1 ER in their last 23.0 IP...Tampa Bay starters have an active 12.0 scoreless inning streak and have not allowed an ER in their last 18.0 frames.

★ Tampa Bay has won eight of its last nine games at Steinbrenner Field after going 3-13 in its previous 16 from April 15–May 19...a win tonight would secure the Rays fifth straight series victory at home, their longest streak since claiming six in a row from June 11–July 28, 2024...it would also mark their sixth straight unbeaten series overall—they are 4-0-1 in their last last five sets.

#VOTERAYS—Fan voting for the 2025 MLB All-Star Game opened earlier today, with the first phase running through Thursday, June 26...votes can be cast up to five times per day.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, **OF Travis Jankowski** cleared outright waivers and elected free agency.

LIGHTS OUT—The Rays staff has pitched to a 1.47 ERA (97.2IP, 16ER) over their last 11 games, fifth lowest over any 11-game span in franchise history and their lowest since July 13-29, 2014 (1.36)...the stretch has lowered their season ERA from 3.88 (8th in AL/15th in MLB) to 3.44 (5th in AL/7th in MLB)...opposing hitters are just 10-for-65 (.154) with RISP over that span and 97-for-429 (.226) with RISP on the season, ninth in the majors...Rays pitchers have held opponents to an 8-for-60 (.133) clip over their last two contests, allowing four hits or fewer in consecutive games for the first time since a club-record-tying (6x) three-game streak from July 25-27, 2024...on the year, the Rays staff ranks among the top two clubs in the majors in WHIP (2nd, 1.15), walk rate (2nd, 7.3%) and GDP per 9.0 IP (2nd, 1.01).

★ The Rays rotation has allowed one or zero runs in eight of their last 11 outings, pitching to a 1.26 ERA (71.1IP, 10ER)...they have yielded three runs or fewer in 14 straight starts dating back to May 19 vs. HOU, their longest single-season streak since a 17-start run to conclude the 2024 campaign.

★ On the season, the Rays 31 quality starts are second most in the majors behind the Phillies (32)...they are on pace for 83 quality starts, which would mark their most since 2014 (84), after finishing 26th in MLB with 48 QS last season.

★ Tampa Bay averages the fewest pitches per inning in the majors (15.4)...Rays starters have thrown the second-most innings (343.2) behind the Royals rotation (344.2) despite ranking 16th in total pitches thrown (5,227).

★ The Rays bullpen has turned in a 1.96 ERA (41.1IP, 9ER) over the last 16 games since May 17, fourth in the majors behind the Cubs (0.94), Giants (1.83) and Blue Jays (1.87).

SCRIPT FLIPPED—Over their last 12 games since May 21, the Rays have recorded an MLB-best plus-11 (22-11) home run differential...they entered that span at a majors-worst minus-27 (67-40) over their first 48 games...Rays pitchers have allowed only 8 XBH in their last last eight games...they have not allowed an extra-base hit in back-to-back games for the fourth time in team history, first since Sept. 19-20, 2024...they have never gone three straight games without yielding an extra-base hit.

★ The Rays are 15-1 when outhomering opponents, tallying nine consecutive wins...they are 9-8 when home runs are even and 7-20 when being outhomered.

★ Tampa Bay has recorded 22 HR and 23 SB over its last 13 games, its first time reaching those marks over a 13-game stretch since June 3-17, 2009 (26HR, 22SB).

KID CAMI—In last night's win, **Junior Caminero** became the first player in Rays history to homer and steal home in a regular-season game...he is the second to turn the trick in any game, joining **Randy Arozarena** in Game 1 of the 2021 ALDS vs. BOS on Oct. 7, 2021...per Stats Perform, the last player in the majors to accomplish the feat was BOS **Jarren Duran** against the Rays on May 21, 2024 at Tropicana Field...the reigning AL Co-Player of the Week, Caminero has homered five times in his last six games, going 10-for-24 (.417) while adding 3 2B and 14 RBI...he has more home runs (5) than strikeouts (4) in that span...over his last 11 games since May 23, 13 of his 17 hits have gone for extra bases (7 2B, 6HR)—over that stretch, he leads the majors in extra-base hits, total bases (42), OPS (1.412), slugging pct. (.977), doubles (T1st, 7) and RBI (18).

★ Caminero has 27 XBH, most by a Ray through the club's first 60 games of a season since **Austin Meadows** (31) in 2021...the 21-year-old joins **Evan Longoria** (34XBH in 2010 at 23 yrs. & 33XBH in 2009 at 24 yrs.) as the only players in club history to reach the mark through 60 team games before turning 25...his 14 HR are already the most by any player in franchise history in an age-21-or-younger season.

★ He leads AL third basemen in home runs (14) and RBI (38) and ranks third among all major leaguers at the hot corner in slugging (CLE Ramirez/BOS Bregman - both .553).

SPREAD THE WEALTH—**Jonathan Aranda** is batting .448 (13-for-29) with 3 2B, 1 HR and 7 RBI in his last nine games...**Brandon Lowe** has recorded a hit in 17 of his last 19 games, slashing .338/.388/.649 (25-for-74) with 5 2B, 6 HR, 13 RBI and 15 R (T1st in AL)...he has hit safely in 10 straight home games, going 14-for-36 (.389)...**Josh Lowe** has a hit in eight of his last 10 games, going 13-for-39 (.333)...**Curtis Mead** is batting .323 (10-for-31) with 3 HR in his last 11 games.

RANGER DANGER—The Rays and Rangers complete a six-game season series this week...Tampa Bay was swept from April 4-6 in Arlington before last night's win...the Rays are 1-7 in the last eight meetings and including the 2023 AL Wild Card Series (0-2), are 2-13 in the last 15 dating back to July 17, 2023...with a win tonight, the Rays would record their first series win over the Rangers since June 9-11, 2023 at Tropicana Field and improve to 5-2-0 in their last seven home series vs. Texas dating back to 2018.

★ **Yandy Diaz** is a career .331 (45-for-136) hitter vs. Texas, second-highest average among active hitters (min. 100AB) behind **CHC Justin Turner** (.348).

★ **Danny Jansen** is batting .333 (24-for-72) in 23 career games against the Rangers, his highest average vs. any opponent in his career.

CUE THE VIOLINS—Tonight at Higgins Hall in Tampa, **Evan Longoria** will be inducted into the Sports Club of Tampa Bay Hall of Fame...other inductees include ESPN analyst **Dick Vitale** and Tampa Bay Lightning head coach **Jon Cooper**...on Saturday, Longoria will sign a ceremonial one-day contract with the Rays in a pregame ceremony before the Rays take on the Marlins at 4:10 p.m. ahead of his official retirement from MLB...the club has also announced plans to induct Longoria into the the Rays Hall of Fame next season.

DOWN ON THE FARM—Earlier today, the Rays Baseball Operations Department announced Class-A Charleston **OF Theo Gillen** (.310/.468/.549, 22-for-71, 3 2B, 1 3B, 4HR, 9RBI, 11SB in 22G) and Triple-A Durham **RHP Paul Gervase** (2-0, 0R, 13.1IP, 0.53 WHIP, .111/5-for-45 opp. AVG in 8G) as the organization's Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for May.

★ **Baseball America** released its updated top-100 prospect rankings earlier today, with Gillen (No. 79) among four Rays making the cut along with **INF Carson Williams** (No. 32), **INF Xavier Isaac** (No. 76) and **OF Chandler Simpson** (No. 84).

TONIGHT’S START—Shane Baz will toe the rubber tonight for his 13th start of the season and eighth at home...marks his 35th career start and 17th at home...the Rays have won his last two starts, with Baz going 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA (11.1IP, 4ER)...fell one out shy of a quality start in both outings...originally acquired from the Pirates as a player to be named later (Aug. 14, 2018) along with **RHP Tyler Glasnow** and **OF Austin Meadows** for **RHP Chris Archer** on July 31, 2018.

LAST TIME OUT—Baz settled for a no-decision after a late offensive explosion gave the Rays a 13-3 win on May 29 at HOU (5.2IP, 7H, 3ER, 3SO, 2HR)...did not allow a hit the first time through the order, facing the minimum after inducing a double play following **Brandon Lowe’s** 2nd-inning fielding error...stranded a leadoff double in the 4th, but two runs scored over a span of four batters in the 5th on a sequence that went home run (**Yainer Diaz**), double, strikeout, RBI-single...escaped the inning with runners at the corners to maintain a 3-2 Rays lead...was tagged for a game-tying solo homer by **Jose Altuve**, his first batter faced in the 6th...recorded a pair of outs before departing after yielding a two-out single...the Rays pushed across 10 runs over the 7th and 8th innings to secure the victory.

- ✦ Baz did not walk a batter for the third time this season, first since April 14 vs. BOS...he had issued multiple free passes in a career-high-tying five straight starts (also: Aug. 8–Sept. 9, 2024).
- ✦ He has allowed a home run in a career-high six consecutive starts, the longest streak by a Ray since **Taj Bradley** (6GS) from Aug. 12–Sept. 10, 2024...the last longer streak belongs to **Zack Littell**, who permitted a long ball in eight straight starts from May 16–June 25, 2024.
- ✦ Baz allowed a home run on his slider for the fourth time in his last five starts...six of his 12 HR allowed have come on the pitch.

HOWDY, PARTNER—Baz will be making his second career start opposite the Rangers, joining July 5, 2024 at Globe Life Field...in that outing, his first after returning from 2022 Tommy John surgery, he took the loss in a 3-0 shutout despite tossing a quality start (6.0IP, 7H, 3ER, BB, 6SO)...at the time, it marked his third career quality start and first in over a calendar year (last: July 3, 2022 at BAL).

- ✦ In six career starts against AL West opponents, Baz is 1-2 with 3.03 ERA (38.2IP, 13ER), allowing three runs or fewer in each game.

NIGHT OWL—Over five nighttime starts at Steinbrenner Field, Baz is 3-1 with a 3.21 ERA (28.0IP, 10ER) and .229 (24-for-105) opp. average with 10.93 strikeouts per 9.0 IP, allowing two runs or fewer in four of the five contests...in two day starts at home, he is 0-1 with a 12.00 ERA (9.0IP, 12ER), allowing opponents to bat .351 (13-for-37) with only 4.00 strikeouts per 9.0 IP...for his career, Baz’s night ERA (3.01) is 2.95 runs lower than his day ERA (5.96).

- ✦ In his last 12 starts at night dating back to Aug. 20, 2024 at OAK, Baz is 6-2 with a 2.65 ERA (71.1IP, 21ER)—min. 10 starts, it marks the seventh-lowest night ERA among AL starters in that span.

MAY-HEM—This season marks the first time in Baz’s career he has pitched before June...see below for a comparison of his performance in April (5GS) compared to May (6GS):

RUNNING OUT OF GAS—Over the first three innings, Baz has pitched to a 2.45 ERA (33.0IP, 9ER), 1.00 WHIP and .210 (25-for-119) opp. average with 28 SO against 8 BB...he has held opponents scoreless in the opening frame in 10 of his 11 starts this season and 28 of his 34 career starts...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 7.90 ERA (27.1IP, 24ER), 1.83 WHIP and .324 (36-for-111) opp. average with 27 SO and 14 BB...over one-third (12) of his 33 runs allowed have come in the 4th frame.

GRADING ON A CURVE—Opposing hitters are batting .222 (20-for-90) against his knuckle curve...min. 50 AB, it marks the fifth-lowest average on any pitcher’s curve in the AL, trailing TOR **Brendon Little** (.137), DET **Jack Flaherty** (.147), LAA **José Soriano** (.188) and HOU **Framber Valdez** (.189)...in Baz’s career, opponents are 38-for-181 (.210) in at-bats ending with his curve.

10 FOR 10—Baz struck out a career-high 11 batters on April 14 vs. BOS...paired with his start on April 1 vs. PIT, he became the fifth pitcher since 1901 to record 10 SO or more with no walks in two of his first three starts of a season, joining MIL **Corbin Burnes** and CWS **Lance Lynn** in 2021, WSH **Stephen Strasburg** in 2010 and AZ **Randy Johnson** in 2000 (Stats Perform).

GOING STREAKING—Baz threw 6.0 IP or more with two runs or fewer in six consecutive starts from Sept. 17, 2024–April 14, 2025, tying the longest streak in franchise history (6GS, 5x, last: **Shane McClanahan**, June 20–July 26, 2022)...he was 4-0 with a 1.89 ERA (38.0IP, 8ER) and 0.74 WHIP during the streak, holding opponents to a .160/.218/.252 (21-for-131) slash line with 46 SO and 7 BB.

THE WIZARD OF BAZ—In his first 19 starts after returning from his Tommy John surgery (July 5, 2024–April 25, 2025), he was 7-3 with a 2.90 ERA (108.2IP, 35ER) a .198 (77-for-388) opp. average and 12 quality starts...min. 100.0IP, he was one of six major league pitchers to hold a sub-.200 opp. average and was tied for fourth in the AL in quality starts...his 2.90 ERA was fifth best in the AL during that span and 12th best in the majors.

- ✦ He threw 5.0 IP or more while allowing four hits or fewer in seven straight outings from Aug. 20–Sept. 28, 2024, the longest run in club history and tied for 16th longest in major league history.

TOMORROW’S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP RYAN PEPIOT [3-5, 3.21]

LAST START—Pepiot extended his scoreless inning streak to 17.2 frames after working into the 7th inning in a 2-1, walk-off loss in Houston on May 30 (6.2IP, 2H, 0R, BB, 4SO)...he has pitched to a 2.44 ERA (48.0IP, 13ER) and 0.96 WHIP across his last eight starts...has thrown five straight quality starts.

vs. RANGERS—He took the loss in his lone career start opposite the Rangers, a 9-3 setback at Tropicana Field in his Rays debut on April 1, 2024...has made three starts opposite AL West clubs this season, going 1-0 with a 3.06 ERA (17.2IP, 6ER).
