### Today's Headlines

Zach Britton (TOR) had a 3-for-4 afternoon with the Salt River Rafters on Wednesday, driving in three of the Rafters' four runs. Britton now holds an AFL batting slash of .462/.516/.615 through eight total games (12-for-26) with 10 RBI and three extra-base hits.

Anders Tolhurst (TOR) pitched four innings with the Salt River Rafters on Thursday, allowing no earned runs. The right-hander has pitched a combined 6 2/3 innings in three AFL starts, holding a 2.70 ERA. He has not allowed an earned run in his last six innings.

Victor Mesa Jr. (MIA) hit two triples on Wednesday with the Mesa Solar Sox, entering the day with an AFL batting slash of .207/.303/.448 and ending at 235/.333/.559 (8-for-34). His .892 OPS currently ranks 22nd in the AFL among qualified players.

Taylor Lehman (PHI) pitched two innings of scoreless, hitless work in relief for the Surprise Saguaros on Wednesday night, collecting four strikeouts. The left-hander ranks in the AFL's top 20 in ERA (1.50), WHIP (1.17) and strikeouts (9) among qualified pitchers.

The Mesa Solar Sox currently hold the AFL's best team OPS (.869) and slugging percentage (.493), while the Glendale Desert Dogs lead in batting average (.288) and on-base percentage (.409). The Surprise Saguaros lead in ERA (.458), WHIP (1.46) and strikeouts (134).

The AFL is two days away from returning to Phoenix Municipal Stadium for the first time in 10 years. The venue hosted the AFL's Phoenix Desert Dogs through 2012.

### Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Jeremy Peña (Peoria Javelinas, 2019) went 3-for-4 with the Houston Astros on Wednesday in Game 1 of the American League Championship Series. His seventh-inning home run, along with two doubles, helped seal a 4-2 victory over the New York Yankees. A third-round selection in the 2018 MLB Draft, Peña came to the Fall League during his second season as a professional. The right-handed-hitting infielder made his MLB debut on April 7, 2022, going on to post a .253/.289/.426 batting slash in 136 games with the Astros. Peña currently holds a postseason slash of .350/.381/.800 in four total games this October (7-for-20).
