In the Division

The Braves today conclude their intradivision schedule, playing their last game against a fellow NL East opponent.

Atlanta is 30-21 (.588) in divisional games this season, the best record of any NL East club in such games. Philadelphia, at 29-21 (.580), is the only other club with a winning record.

The Braves won the season set against three of its four division opponents this year, going 9-3 against Washington and 8-5 against both New York and Miami. Atlanta played to a 5-8 record in its 13 games versus division-champion Philadelphia.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Nationals today conclude a three-game mid-week series with the 13th and final matchup between the teams this season...The two clubs are set to play seven times in a span of 10 days, following a four-game series at Nationals Park last week.

Atlanta hit three solo home runs to drive a win, 3-2, over Washington last night, and has now won six straight games against the club...The Braves are 9-3 in 12 total games between the two clubs this season.

Following last night's win, Atlanta has now won five-of-six against Washington here at Truist Park this season...The Braves are 40-33 (.548) versus the Nationals here all-time, however, Washington's .452 winning percentage in this building is the best of any other NL East team.

With a win this afternoon, Atlanta would claim the highest single-season winning percentage against Washington (10-3, .769) since the club moved to D.C. in 2005...The current best mark for a single season is .737, set in 2021 and then matched in 2022 when the Braves went 14-5 versus the Nationals.

RH Bryce Elder has made five starts all-time against Washington, including one this season, and is 2-1 with a 2.84 ERA (10 ER/31.2 IP) in his career against the club...The right-hander pitched 6.0 one-run innings in a no-decision against the Nationals here at Truist Park on May 14...The 6-foot-2, 220-pound Texan earned his team-leading eighth win in his last start, and is 4-1 with a 3.83 ERA (21 ER/49.1 IP) over his last eight starts dating to August 14.

LH Andrew Alvarez is set today to make just the fifth start of his major league career, and his first against Atlanta...The 6-foot-3, 215-pound Anaheim native is 1-1 with a 2.84 ERA over his first four starts...A 12th-round selection by Washington in 2021, the left-hander went 3-7 with a 4.10 ERA over 25 starts with Triple-A Rochester.

VS. LEFTIES: The Braves are set today to face left-hander Andrew Alvarez, and Atlanta enters play this afternoon with a 23-19 (.548) record against left-handed starting pitchers...That mark ranks eighth in baseball and second in the NL behind just Milwaukee (29-17, .630).

Atlanta has won each of its last five games versus opposing lefties, last losing to Shota Imanaga and the Cubs at Wrigley Field on September 2.

Dating to the start of the 2019 season, no team in baseball has been better against lefty starters than the Braves...Atlanta is 166-98 (.629) against left-handers in that span, while Houston sits in second at 197-116 (.627).

STREAKING: Atlanta's win last night was its season-best 10th consecutive victory...It is the longest active winning streak in baseball, and tied for the fourth-longest winning run by a team this season.

The Braves last compiled a winning streak of double-digit games in June of 2022, when they won 14 in a row...This run stands as the 17th in modern-era franchise history of at least 10 games, and the 10th such run of the Atlanta era.

Eight of Atlanta's 10 victories in the streak have come by multiple runs, and the Braves have a run differential of +47 (75-28) over the 10 games...The streak has trimmed Atlanta's run differential for the season down to just -4.

Six different teams have combined to compile seven individual winning streaks of at least 10 games this season, with Milwaukee owning a season-best 14-game streak...The Braves can tie the Brewers' league-best streak this season if they win out.

MICHAEL HARRIS II: Drove in two of Atlanta's three runs last night on a pair of solo homers, and finished the night 2-for-3...It was the sixth multi-home game of Harris' career, the first this season and first since going deep twice against Cincinnati September 19, 2024.

In his last six games against Washington, dating to September 15, Harris is hitting .440/.440/760 with two home runs, six runs scored, five RBI, four extra-base hits and three stolen bases.

The two home runs give Harris 19 on the season, matching his career-high total set in his Rookie of the Year campaign in 2022...His 85 RBI are also the most of his career...He is one of just four primary center fielders in baseball with at least 19 homers and 85 RBI this year, joining Jo Adell, Julio Rodríguez & Pete Crow-Armstrong.

Twenty-eight of Harris II's 50 extra-base hits this season have come since this All-Star break, and his 28 total extra-base hits in that span rank sixth in the National League.

RONALD ACUÑA JR.: Cemented the fifth 20-homer campaign of his major league career last night, driving the first pitch of his sixth-inning at-bat out to right field...His 20 homers have come over just 91 games this season, a 35-homer pace of 162 games.

Since snapping a career-worst hitless streak at 25 at-bats on September 8, Acuña Jr. has batted .352/.485/.648 over his last 15 games and 54 at-bats, and five of his 20 homers on the season have come in that span.

Acuña Jr. is batting .438/.452/.856 on the first pitch of an at-bat in his career, and his 49 homers in 0-0 counts since his debut in 2018 rank seventh in all of baseball...Just one batter in the majors, Aaron Judge (1.354), has a higher OPS than Acuna Jr.'s 1.308 mark on the first pitch since that 2018 season.
