Runs

Atlanta was shut out on Saturday and scored just a single run on Sunday, mustering just a single tally in its last two games.

Before this spell, the Braves hadn't scored one run-or-fewer in a two-game span since June 29-July 1, 2025. They scored one run against Philadelphia before being blanked by the Los Angeles Angels in the next game.

Despite the downturn in run production, Atlanta still ranks second in Major League Baseball in runs scored (282). Last weekend's opponent, Washington, leads the majors with 298 tallies on the season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Red Sox today commence a three-game midweek series with the fourth of six games between the clubs this season... The two are set to play all six games in a span of just 14 days, as Atlanta hosted Boston for three games at Truist Park from May 15-17.

A Atlanta bookended the first set with a pair of wins to take the series, including a walk-off double from Mike Yastrzemski in Game 1.

A Atlanta went an even 3-3 in six games versus Boston last season, with each club winning a series in the visiting ballpark...The Braves and Red Sox are playing for the seventh consecutive season, and Atlanta is 17-14 (.548) against Boston in 31 total games since 2020.

A The Braves are the only visiting team in MLB with a winning record at Fenway Park, playing to a 28-22 all-time record (.560).

A Since the advent of Interleague Play in 1997, Atlanta has played Boston far more than any other American League team...The two clubs have met 103 times in that span, with the Braves going 49-54 (.476)...The Braves have not played any other AL team more than 70 times (Toronto).

A LHP Ranger Suarez is slated to face Atlanta for the first time since departing the National League East...He's set to make his 14th career start against Atlanta, which will be tied for the eighth-most of any pitcher since his debut in 2018...In 22 total appearances against the Braves, Suarez has pitched to a 4-4 lifetime record and a 3.38 ERA (30 ER/80.0 IP)...Among the 22 pitchers with at least 50 innings pitched against Atlanta in that time, his ERA is tied for the fourth best behind Jacob DeGrom (2.15), Logan Webb (2.59) and Miles Mikolas (3.17).

A RHP Spencer Strider will appear for his fifth outing of the season tonight...He has limited opponents to three runs-or-fewer in each of his previous four turns, including his last, when he held Miami to three runs and struck out nine batters...It signified his highest strikeout total since whiffing 11 Athletics on July 10, 2025...In two previous starts against Boston, Strider has gone decisionless, but owns a 2.31 ERA (3 ER/11.2 IP)...He struck out 10 Red Sox in his only outing at Fenway Park on July 26, 2023.

OZZIE ALBIES: Collected half of Atlanta's hits on Sunday, going 3-for-4 and scoring the club's only run of the game...Since snapping his 24-at-bat hitless streak on May 17, the second-longest of his career, Albies has reached base 12 times in 36 plate appearances.

A Albies' 57 hits this season are the third most among MLB's switch hitters, only trailing Xavier Edwards (MIA, 64) and Elly De La Cruz (CIN, 60).

A His defense has been worth four outs above average, according to Statcast, ranking in the 93rd percentile MLB-wide.

FACING LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face left-hander Ranger Suarez this evening, and additional southpaws Connelly Early and Payton Tolle in Games 2 & 3 to round out the series...The stretch will constitute a four-game streak of the Braves facing a left-handed starter after facing Washington's Foster Griffin on Sunday at Truist Park.

A It's the second time this season that Atlanta will see at least four straight lefties, after facing five in a row from April 29-May 3 in games against Detroit and Colorado...During that stretch, the Braves beat Tarik Skubal, José Quintana, Brennan Bernardino and Kyle Freeland, with the only loss coming against Framber Valdez.

A The team enters play 16-5 (.762) against opposing left-handed starters this season...Those are the most wins and the third-best winning percentage in such games in the majors this year.

A The Los Angeles Dodgers (9-2, .818) and Tampa Bay Rays (12-3, .800) are the only clubs with higher winning percentages against southpaws this season.

A Dating even further to 2019, no team in baseball has been better against lefties...The Braves have gone 182-104 (.636) versus left-handers in that span...The Dodgers rank second at .625 (203-122).

A Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced 11 left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to a 9-2 record in those games.

A The Braves did fall in their most recent left-handed showdown, though, losing to Griffin on Sunday at Truist Park.

AT FENWAY: Although interleague play didn't begin until 1997, the Braves have played 139 games at Fenway park, beginning in 1913...The team owns a 28-22 (.560) record against the Red Sox inside this venue, and a 59-27 (.686) record when facing non-Boston teams here (including playoffs).

A The current Atlanta Braves played their home games at Fenway Park during the 1914 World Series, and began the 1915 regular season here, as they awaited the completion of Braves Field.

A The Braves clinched that World Series here at Fenway Park, beating the Philadelphia Athletics, 3-1, in front of a crowd of 34,365...The game was played in 1 hour, 49 minutes.

A The Braves and Red Sox shared the city of Boston from the Red Sox' inception as the Boston Americans in 1901 until the Braves departed for Milwaukee in 1953.

A Remarkably, **the Braves have more all-time wins (87) at Fenway Park than two current members of the American League: the Seattle Mariners (84) and Houston Astros (26).**

Today's Game

Makes his fifth start of the 2026 season and the 82nd of his career today in the opener of a three-game series against the Red Sox at Fenway Park.

Strider is 0-0 with a 2.31 ERA (3 ER/11.2 IP) over two career starts against Boston, with 14 strikeouts.

Received a no-decision in his most recent turn against the Red Sox, on May 15 at Truist Park, allowing one run over 5.1 innings with three walks and four strikeouts on 84 pitches in Atlanta's 3-2 win in 10 innings...His other career outing against the club came on July 26, 2023 at Boston, a no-decision over 6.1 innings.

Enters play 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA (7 ER/21.0 IP) and 27 strikeouts over his first four turns...Atlanta has won all four of his starts.

Picked up his second victory of the season in his most recent outing, May 21 at Miami, allowing three runs over 6.1 innings with two walks and nine strikeouts on 100 pitches in the 9-3 win...The nine strikeouts were his most in a start this season and the most since he fanned 11 on July 10, 2025 vs. the Athletics.

Owens a 3.00 ERA (7 ER/21.0 IP) over his first four starts of the season, the second-lowest mark of his career through four turns to open a year, trailing only the 2.45 ERA (6 ER/22.0 IP) he posted over his first four starts of 2023...He has gone 2-0 in both spans.

Was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 25 with a left oblique strain during spring training, missing Atlanta's first 34 games of the season before being activated on May 3.

Made three minor league rehabilitation starts in April, going 0-1 with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER/12.2 IP) and 18 strikeouts between High-A Rome and Triple-A Gwinnett...Posted a 2-0 record and a 3.24 ERA (3 ER/8.1 IP) over three Grapefruit League outings this spring with 11 strikeouts.

The Braves are 51-27 in Strider's career starts.

Owens a .631 winning percentage (41-24) in his career with Atlanta, the third-best mark among pitchers in the Atlanta era (since 1966) to make at least 80 starts for the club...He trails only Hall of Famer Greg Maddux (.688) and Max Fried (.670), and ranks just ahead of Hall of Famer Tom Glavine (.624).

2026

Earned his second win of the season on May 21 at Miami, allowing three runs over 6.1 innings with two walks and nine strikeouts on 100 pitches in the 9-3 victory at loanDepot park.

Received a no-decision on May 15 against Boston, allowing one run over 5.1 innings with three walks and four strikeouts on 84 pitches in Atlanta's 3-2 win in 10 innings at Truist Park.

Earned his first victory of the season on May 9 at Dodger Stadium, allowing one hit over 6.0 scoreless innings with two walks and eight strikeouts on 91 pitches in the 7-2 win at Los Angeles (NL)...It was his first decision since September 27, 2025.

Received a no-decision in his season debut on May 3 at Coors Field, allowing three runs and four hits over 3.1 innings with five walks, six strikeouts and one home run on 87 pitches in the Braves' 11-6 victory at Colorado.

Was activated from the 15-day injured list on May 3 after missing the first 34 games of the season with a left oblique strain.

2025

Went 7-14 with a 4.45 ERA (62 ER/125.1 IP) in 23 starts, his first season back from internal brace surgery on his right elbow.

Made his 2025 season debut on April 16 at Toronto, allowing two runs and five hits over 5.0 innings...It was his first start in 376 days, dating to April 5, 2024.

Was placed on the 15-day IL on April 21 (backdated to April 18) with a strained right hamstring and was activated on May 19.

Reached the 500th strikeout of his career on July 18 by punching out Toronto's Addison Barger.

Became the ninth pitcher in the Modern Era to reach 500 strikeouts in 68 appearances or fewer, and the first to do so since Cleveland's Shane Bieber in 2021.

The other pitchers on that list: José Fernández, Yu Darvish, Mark Prior, Kerry Wood, Hideo Nomo, Dwight Gooden and Herb Score.

Strider was the only pitcher in that group with more than three relief appearances in his first 68 games (13).

Reached the 600th strikeout of his career on August 25 against Miami, becoming the fastest primary starter in Modern Era history (by innings pitched) to the milestone.

Closed the year on a 2-2 run with a 2.79 ERA (9 ER/29.0 IP), 26 strikeouts and three quality starts over his final five outings.

His 4.45 ERA was the highest single-season mark of his career (minimum three appearances).

Career Recap

Drafted by Atlanta in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB June Amateur Draft out of Clemson University...Cleveland had previously selected him in the 35th round of the 2017 draft out of Christian Academy of Knoxville (Tenn.), but he did not sign.

Underwent Tommy John surgery in February 2019 and missed the entire collegiate season.

Made his MLB debut in 2021, appearing in two relief games for the Braves at age 22.

Was named to the 2023 National League All-Star team in his first full season as a starter.

Finished fourth in the 2022 NL Rookie of the Year voting after going 11-5 with a 2.67 ERA, 202 strikeouts and 10 quality starts in 31 appearances (20 starts).

Led the National League in strikeouts in 2023 with 281, going 20-5 with a 3.86 ERA in 32 starts.

Made two starts in 2024 before being placed on the 15-day IL on April 7 with a right elbow sprain...Dr. Keith Meister performed surgery to repair the ulnar collateral ligament with an internal brace on April 12, 2024 in Arlington, Texas.

- Has not allowed a run in 28.1 consecutive innings since August 30, 2025, the second-longest active streak in MLB behind Christopher Sanchez (PHI, 29.2 IP).
- Yields a swing on 57.4% of his pitches this season, the second-highest rate among pitchers with as many innings, and has registered a chase rate of 42.2%, which ranks second behind Tanner Scott (LAD, 46.1%).
- Has converted 26 consecutive save opportunities since July 28, 2025, one behind Aroldis Chapman (BOS) for the longest active run in the majors and tied with Craig Kimbrel for the best by a Brave since 2014.
- His 31.6% changeup rate is the second highest among Braves relievers in the Modern era (min. 100 games) and ranks first among such pitchers with 111 strikeouts on the pitch, 25 more than the next highest strikeout count.
