THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JUNE 6
2022 - The Astros sign **DH Yordan Alvarez** to a six-year contract extension that covers the 2023-28 seasons...since signing the deal, Alvarez has made three All-Star appearances (2022-24) and helped the club to their 2022 World Series title.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros will play the penultimate game of their nine-game homestand today in the middle game of their three-game series against the A's...**RHP Tatsuya Imai**, who dominated the A's for his first Major League win on April 4 (OER/5.2IP), will start today for Houston opposite rookie starter **RHP Kade Morris** and the A's.

ABOUT IMAI: **RHP Tatsuya Imai** is set to make his eighth career Major League start today and his fifth since returning from the IL after a bout with right arm fatigue...he's performed better since his return, particularly in his last three starts in which he's posted a 2.70 ERA (5ER/16.2IP) with a .148 (8x54) opponent average and a 0.84 WHIP...in January, the Astros signed Imai to a three-year deal...in 2025, he was an All-Star for the Seibu Lions in the NPB in Japan, where he went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games.

ABOUT THE NO-NO: On May 25 at TEX, **RHP Tatsuya Imai** started the Astros 17th regular season no-hitter and their 18th no-hitter overall in club history...Imai worked the first 6.0 hitless innings before giving way to **LHP Steven Okert** (1IP) and **RHP Alimber Santa** (2IP)...the no-hitter was the Astros seventh since 2019, which is the most in the Majors in that span...additionally, the Astros 18 no-hitters overall are the most in the Majors since the franchise was born in 1962.

PLAY BALL WEEKEND: The Astros are celebrating PLAY BALL Weekend presented by Nike this weekend at the ballpark...today, as part of the weekend, all 350 Astros Youth Academy Nike RBI baseball and softball players received tickets to attend the game...tomorrow, the Astros Youth Academy will host a PLAY BALL Clinic at Daikin Park for 75 Special Olympics Texas athletes...all participants will also be given tickets to attend tomorrow's game.

THE LAST 20: Since May 15, the Astros are 12-8 thanks in large part to their pitching, which has produced a 3.59 ERA (71ER/178IP) and a .194 opponent average, which ranks second in the Majors in that span...their bullpen has been even better in those last 20 games, working to a 3.10 ERA (23ER/66.2IP) and posting a league-best .176 opponent average.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Astros and A's have committed the fewest errors in the AL (24) with the Astros posting the best fielding percentage (.990) in the AL, topping the A's (.990) by a few percentage points...among all Major League teams, only the Padres (20) and Dodgers (22) have committed fewer errors than the Astros and A's.

VS. THE A'S: The Astros are hosting the A's in Houston for their first series in the Bayou City since last July...the Astros are 2-2 vs. the A's in 2026 and are looking to reverse their luck vs. the A's this season after going 5-8 against them in 2025...that marked the Astros first season series loss to the A's since the 2020 season (3-7).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros played a clean ballgame last night, dispatching the A's by a score of 5-1...**DH Isaac Paredes** (1x2) had a huge game, recording four RBI, three coming home on a 1st-inning homer...**RHP Peter Lambert** (1ER/5.1IP) won his third straight decision, working around five hits and four walks in the victory.

THREE-SOCK PAREDES: **3B Isaac Paredes** has homered in a career-high tying three consecutive games for the third time in his seven-year career (last, April 11-13, 2025)...should he homer today, he'd become the first Astro to homer in four straight games since **3B Alex Bregman** did so from Aug. 10-13, 2024.

SEÑOR CIEN: **3B Isaac Paredes** hit his 100th career homer on Thursday and his 101st last night, making him one of just four Mexican-born players in MLB history to the reach 100 career homers, joining **Vinny Castilla** (320), **Jorge Orta** (130), and **Aurelio Rodriguez** (124)...Paredes also reached another milestone last Sunday, becoming the 10th Mexican player to reach 500 career hits.

YOR-GONE!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has hit 191 career regular season home runs, which ties him for sixth in Astros history along with **3B Alex Bregman**.

ON THE LEADER BOARD: **DH Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in OPS (1.074), and total bases (149) and leads the AL in home runs (21)...also in the AL, he ranks second in batting average (.316), second in SLG (.645), second in extra-base hits (34), second in OBP (.429), tied for second in hits (73), tied for third in RBI (44), tied for fourth in runs (43), and tied for fifth in walks (42).

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** leads the AL in RBI with 46, which is two RBI more than teammate **DH Yordan Alvarez** (44), and ranks tied for sixth in the AL in homers (16)...Walker also has not committed an error in 64 games.

FIRE STARTER: **SS Jeremy Peña** is batting .328 (21x64) with three home runs, 10 RBI and an .873 OPS in 17 games since being activated from the IL on May 18...the Astros are 10-7 since his return.

VOTING COMMENCES: MLB launched the 2026 Konami eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot earlier this week...the Astros on the ballot: **1B Christian Walker**, **2B Jose Altuve**, **3B Isaac Paredes**, **SS Jeremy Peña**, **C Yainer Diaz**, **DH Yordan Alvarez**, **OF Brice Matthews**, **OF Jake Meyers** and **OF Cam Smith**.

ASTROS SIGN WADE: **OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** was signed to a Major League contract on Thursday after spending his entire season at Triple A Charlotte in the White Sox organization, appearing in 46 games and hitting .250 (38x152) with seven HR, 26 RBI, 45 walks and an .861 OPS...Wade has appeared in 561 MLB games over parts of eight seasons.

THERE IS A SANTA!: **RHP Alimber Santa** set a club record by retiring the first 18 batters of his career consecutively before giving up a walk on Wednesday...the 18 consecutive batters retired are the most to begin a career since the Pirates **RHP Nick Kingham** retired 20 straight to open his career on April 29, 2018 vs. STL...Santa still has not allowed a hit in his first 6.0 Major League innings, which per Elias, ties as the third longest of such a streak in franchise history.

LAST START, MAY 31 vs. MIL: Allowed 2 runs on 3 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...tossed a career-high 110 pitches, it's also tied for the 3rd most pitches thrown by any MLB starter in a game this season...has also recorded consecutive quality starts for the 1st time in his career.

NO-HITTER On May 25 at TEX, he tossed the first 6.0 innings of the 18th no-hitter in Astros franchise history, along with the franchise's 5th combined no-hitter...navigated 6.0 scoreless, hitless innings despite walking 4 batters, including the first 2 batters of the game and 3 total walks in the 1st inning...retired 15 of the next 16 batters he faced to finish the outing, striking out 2...was relieved in the no-hitter by **LHP Steven Okert** (1 IP) and **RHP Alimber Santa** (2 IP), with Santa making his MLB debut in the outing.

ABOUT THE NO-NO: Was the first no-hitter by the Astros since a complete-game no-hitter by **RHP Ronel Blanco** on April 1, 2024 vs. TOR...was the 1st combined no-hitter by the Astros since **RHP Cristian Javier**, **RHP Bryan Abreu**, **RHP Rafael Montero** and **RHP Ryan Pressly** combined to no-hit the Phillies in Game 4 of the 2022 World Series at Citizens Bank Park.

- Became the 4th Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history to start a no-hitter, joining **RHP Hideo Nomo** (1996, 2001), **RHP Hisashi Iwakuma** (2015) and **LHP Shota Imanaga** (2024)...both of Nomo's no-hitters and Iwakuma's no-hitter were complete-game efforts.
- Ended a 630-day drought between the last no-hitter thrown in the Majors when the Cubs tossed a combined no-hitter vs. the Pirates on Sept. 4, 2024...coincidentally, that no-hitter was started by Imanaga, who was relieved by **RHP Porter Hodge** and Imai's current Astros teammate, **RHP Nate Pearson**...was the longest no-hitter drought in the Majors since a span of 841 days between the 2004-06 seasons.
- Was the longest start of Imai's MLB career, surpassing 5.2 innings tossed on April 4 at ATH...also marked his most pitches thrown (97) in an MLB outing, surpassing 94 pitches from April 4 at ATH.
- Recorded the 2nd winning decision of his career and his 1st since April 4 at ATH.

ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY): Rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...has made 7 Major League starts this season around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10) due to right arm fatigue...today is his 5th start since returning from the IL...has posted a 2.70 ERA (5ER/16.2IP), a .148 opponent batting average (8x54) and a 0.84 WHIP over his last 3 starts, lowering his season ERA from 9.24 to 5.52 in that span.

IMAI'S ARSENAL: Has thrown 43.5% sliders in his MLB career, while throwing four-seamers (42.4%) and sinkers (9.7%) as his fastballs...among fastballs, has heavily featured his four-seamer over his last 3 starts, throwing the pitch 142 times compared to just 5 sinkers, after throwing only sinkers in his start on May 12 at SEA...has also worked in select changeups (2%), split fingers (1%) and curveballs (1%)...has raised eyebrows by featuring his unique wrong-way slider, which was well known during his time pitching in the NPB...Imai's slider is averaging 5.3 inches of arm-side run...for context, the average MLB slider breaks 4 inches to the glove side.

FIRST MAJOR LEAGUE WIN: Flashed brilliance and earned his 1st career Major League win on April 4 at ATH in what was his second Major League start...in that outing, he allowed 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts in 5.2 innings.

2025 RECAP: Went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

JAPANESE CAREER: Prior to signing with the Astros, Imai starred in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB) for the last 8 seasons (2018-25)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...was a 3-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

JAPAN CONNECTION: Became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Imai knows Matsui well, having played for him from 2023-24, while he was managing in the NPB with the Seibu Lions.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/4 vs. PIT): Had a solid bounce-back outing on Thurs. night vs. PIT, striking out 3 batters while working around 1 walk in a scoreless 1.0 inning...surrendered 3 runs on 2 hits with 1 walk and 2 strikeouts on Tues. night vs. PIT.

TURN THE PAGE: Prior to his outing on May 29 vs. MIL, he had logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28, striking out 7 while holding opponents to a .148 average (4x27) over that span...his 9-game scoreless streak is the longest by an Astro this season.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Ranks 7th all-time in appearances (340) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (476)...with his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history.
