WHAT'S BREWING?

100 Club
Jackson Chourio yesterday tied his career high with 4 hits (also 8/21/24 at St. Louis).....he also surpassed 100 RBI (102) for his career in his 175th game, becoming the second-fastest player to reach 100 RBI in franchise history behind only Ryan Braun (118g).

Welcome Addition
With a win today, José Quintana would become the third pitcher in franchise history to win his first 4 starts with the team, joining Tom Candiotti (4gs, 1983) and CC Sabathia (4gs, 2008).

Fourlorn
The Brewers are on their second 4-game losing streak this season (also 3/27-3/31).....Milwaukee was the only MLB team without a 4-game losing streak last season.....the team's last 5-game losing streak came from 6/8-6/14, 2023 (6g).

Homesick
The Brewers have lost 4 consecutive road games for the first time since 5/26-6/5, 2024.....Milwaukee last suffered a 5-game road losing streak from 5/2-5/6, 2023.

By the Slimmest of Margins
Milwaukee has dropped 3 straight games by 1 run (6-5, 3-2, 6-5) for the first time 5/3-5/5, 2021.....the Brewers last fell by 1 run in 4 straight contests from 7/22-7/25, 2012.

Like Father, Like Son
Daz Cameron made his Brewers debut yesterday in St. Louis and along with father Mike Cameron (2008-09) combine for the third father-son duo to play for the team, joining Tito Francona (1970) and Terry Francona (1989-90) and Dave May (1970-78) and Derrick May (1995).

Arch Nemesis
The Brewers are looking to avoid their first sweep against St. Louis since 9/20-9/23, 2021 (4g) at American Family Field.....the Cardinals last swept the Brewers at Busch Stadium from 4/22-4/24, 2019 (3g).

Over his last 10 games, Rhys Hoskins is batting .455 (15-for-33) with 3 HR and 8 RBI.....he holds a .526 OBP/.758 SLG/1.284 OPS in that span.

TODAY'S GAME: Is game 7 (1-5) of a season-long 10-game, 11-day road trip to San Francisco (1-3), St. Louis (0-2) and Chicago-AL (3g)....following this trip, the team returns to American Family Field for a 6-game homestand against Chicago-NL (3g) and Houston (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without **Bob Uecker** on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 9-4 at home, going 4-0-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 4-11 on the road, going 1-4-0 in series play, including this series.....the team is on a season-high 4-game road losing streak.

MANAGER: **Pat Murphy** is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Returning from 2024 is associate manager **Rickie Weeks** (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach **Jim Henderson** (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (2nd season), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (4th season), assistant coach **Daniel de Mondesert** (2nd season), infield coach **Matt Erickson** (2nd season) and third base coach **Jason Lane** (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach **Julio Borbón**, lead hitting coach **Al LeBoeuf** and hitting coach **Eric Theisen** are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made two replay challenges, going 2-0.....their last challenge came on 4/22 at San Francisco as an out call at first base involving Vinny Capra was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 679 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TODAY'S STARTER: #62 - LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (3gs, 3-0, 0.96)

QUINTANA AT A GLANCE: José Quintana, 36, will be making his fourth start of the season.....Quintana last started on Tuesday at San Francisco and earned an 11-3 victory (6ip, 6h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 3k, 94 pitches).....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .219 (14-for-64, 1hr).....he is the sixth pitcher in franchise history to win at least his first 3 starts with the team, joining **Jerry Bell** (3gs, 1972), **Clyde Wright** (3gs, 1974), **Tom Candiotti** (4gs, 1983), **Tom Filer** (3gs, 1988) and **CC Sabathia** (4gs, 2008).....Quintana signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on March 5.....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026.....name is pronounced “keen-TAH-nuh.”

LAST SEASON: Quintana went 10-10 with a 3.75 ERA in 31 starts with New York-NL.....the team went 16-15 in his starts.....he made 12 quality starts.....opponents batted .237 (150-for-634, 22hr).....he was the Mets’ Opening Day starter (against the Brewers).

MR. COLOMBIA: Quintana, born in Arjona, Colombia, is his country’s all-time leader in nearly every statistical category in the Major Leagues, including games (362), starts (336), wins (105), innings pitched (1988.1) and strikeouts (1,736).....he pitched for Colombia in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

BEEEN THERE, DONE THAT: Quintana has made 336 starts since 2012 - his first season - which ranks fourth in the Major Leagues behind **Max Scherzer** (357), **Zack Greinke** (344) and **Lance Lynn** (338).....this includes nine seasons of 30+ starts.

CAREER: Is 105-103 with a 3.72 ERA in 362 games/336 starts (1988.1ip, 821er).....is in his 14th Major League season while pitching for Chicago-AL (2012-17), Chicago-NL (2017-20), Los Angeles-AL (2021), San Francisco (2021), Pittsburgh (2022), St. Louis (2022), New York-NL (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2025).....was an All-Star in 2016 as he finished 10th in American League Cy Young Award voting.....Quintana was originally signed by the Mets as a non-drafted free agent on 4/26/06.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 6-4 with a 3.71 ERA in 13 starts (72.2ip, 30er).....is 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA in 1 start this season (5.2ip, 1er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 52-55 with a 3.76 ERA in 183 games/171 starts (1001.1ip, 418er).....is 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA in 2 starts this season (13ip, 1er).

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Quintana has gone 6-4 with a 3.95 ERA in 14 starts (73ip, 78h, 38r, 32er, 27bb, 66k, 7hr), including 3-3 with a 3.78 ERA in 7 starts at Busch Stadium (33.1ip, 38h, 17r, 14er, 14bb, 32k, 4hr).....he had no decision in his only start vs. St. Louis last season, coming in a 4-2, 11-inning win on 4/28 at Citi Field (8ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 3k).
