BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles and Yankees open a four-game set tonight in the Bronx...The clubs meet seven times in the next 13 days, as New York travels to Camden Yards for a three-game series from May 11-13...The Birds are coming off a 3-3 homestand, having dropped two of three to the Red Sox before taking two of three from the Astros.

Yesterday, the O's played their first doubleheader of the 2026 campaign, winning Game 1, 10-3, before dropping Game 2, 11-5.

In the win, **Adley Rutschman** and **Jeremiah Jackson** each hit grand slams, marking the eighth time in franchise history (since 1954) that the Birds have hit two grand slams in the same game, including the first since September 11, 2015 vs. Kansas City when **Steve Clevenger** and **Nolan Reimold** each hit one in the eighth inning.

Entering play today, **Jeremiah Jackson** is the only player in MLB with two grand slams this season, having hit his first career grand slam on April 13 vs. Arizona...The Birds lead MLB entering play today with four grand slams, with **Leody Taveras** accounting for the other on April 20 at Kansas City.

In Game 2 of the twin bill, the O's drew a season-high-tying eight walks (3x, last: 4/20 at KC) after drawing seven walks in Game 1...It marks the first time they have drawn 7+ walks in back-to-back games since September 2-3, 2024...They last did so in three straight contests from April 14-16, 2023.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game, the Orioles recalled **LHP Cade Povich** from Triple-A Norfolk and optioned **RHP Cameron Foster** to Triple-A Norfolk.

BRONX TALES: Baltimore has dropped five straight games at Yankee Stadium since June 21, 2025, its longest losing skid since a franchise-record 12-game losing streak from May 15 (G1), 2019-April 6, 2021.

In 22 career games at Yankee Stadium, **Gunnar Henderson** is slashing .305/.406/.524 (25-for-82) with six doubles, four home runs, 17 runs, 14 RBI, 13 walks, and five steals... Since the new Yankee Stadium opened in 2009, Henderson's .305 batting average is third highest by any Oriole (min. 60 AB), trailing **Nick Markakis** (.327, 72-for-220) and **Mark Reynolds** (.306, 19-for-62).

Pete Alonso is slashing .316/.412/.684 (18-for-57) with three doubles, six home runs, 15 runs, 17 RBI, and nine walks in his last 16 games opposite the Yankees since July 26, 2022.

RUTSCHMAN RAKING: **Adley Rutschman** has hit safely in each of his last six games since his reinstatement from the 10-day Injured List on April 21, and owns a seven-game hitting streak since April 10, slashing .467/.467/.933 (14-for-30) with two doubles, four home runs, six runs, and 14 RBI during that stretch...He last hit safely in eight straight games during another eight-game run from April 3-13, 2025.

He is slashing .303/.413/.386 (44-for-145) with nine doubles, one home run, eight RBI, 22 runs, and 26 walks in 39 career games against New York...He has reached base safely 18 of 20 career games at Yankee Stadium.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** went 0-for-3 with three runs and five walks across both games of yesterday's doubleheader...He has drawn a free pass in a career-high nine straight games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATH's Nick Kurtz (19 G)...He is one game shy of the Orioles franchise record (since 1954) of 10 straight games with a walk, shared by **Boog Powell** (2x, 1969, 1973) and **Ken Singleton** (1978).

He has reached base safely 63 times through his first 31 games with the O's (35 H, 27 BB, 1 HBP), the second-highest figure by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Frank Robinson** (66 TOB, 1966)...The record through 32 games is also held by Robinson (68 TOB).

Ward's .438 on-base percentage is tied for third in MLB behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (.462) and NYY's Ben Rice (.443)...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2nd, .410).

His 13 doubles are tied for the MLB lead with TOR's Ernie Clement and ATL's Matt Olson. Ward has reached safely in 29 of the last 30 games since March 28 while slashing .315/.450/.459 (35-for-111) with 13 doubles, one homer, 18 runs scored, 11 RBI, 27 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.66 ERA (1 ER/13.2 IP) with 15 strikeouts across 15 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

His .024 (1-for-42) opponent average and 0.37 WHIP are the best among all MLB relievers, outpacing MIA's John King (.048, 2-for-42) and SEA's Matt Brash (0.44 WHIP), respectively.

He has yet to allow a hit in each of his eight home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of three Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with **Bryan Baker** (9 G, 2023) and **Shawn Armstrong** (8 G, 2019).

'PEN PALS: **Grant Wolfram** has not allowed a home run in 31.0 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 36.2 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

The O's 13.2 percent inherited runners scored rate (5 IRS/38 IR) is second lowest in MLB behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR).

The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

TIGHT SQUEEZE: The Orioles have played in 22 games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for third most in the majors behind the Guardians and Mariners (both 23 G)...The Birds are 10-12 (.455) in those games.

The Birds have also played 17 games decided by two runs or fewer, tied for third most in the majors behind the Guardians (19 G) and Cardinals (18 G), going 10-7 (.588) in those affairs.

CONCRETE JUNGLE: The Birds and Yankees kick off a 13-game season series tonight in the Bronx...Baltimore returns to Yankee Stadium to close out the 2026 campaign from September 25-27, while the Yankees come to Camden Yards from May 11-13 and August 18-20.

Orioles Pitching Strategy Coach **Ryan Klimek's** brother, Steven, is currently a pitching coach in the Yankees organization.

QUICK HITS: Povich is scheduled to make his second start of the season (3rd appearance) and 38th of his career tonight in the series opener at New York-AL... He was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk prior to tonight's game...Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster in 2025 and went 3-8 with a 5.21 ERA (65 ER/112.1 IP) on 125 hits (17 HR), 43 walks (2 IBB), one hit batter, and six wild pitches with 118 strikeouts in 22 appearances (20 GS)...Had one stint on the 15-day Injured List (left hip inflammation) from 6/16-8/3/25...Acquired from Minnesota along with RHP **Yennier Cano**, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nunez in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022.

LAST TIME OUT: Povich became the 14th Oriole starter to pitch on his birthday in his last outing on April 12 vs. San Francisco, earning the win after allowing one run over 6.2 innings on five hits and zero walks with five strikeouts...Became the first O's starter to earn the win on his birthday since **John Means** on April 24, 2019 vs. Chicago-AL...Threw 97 pitches, 65 strikes.

📌 Recorded 17 whiffs, the second most of his career behind only his 18 whiffs on August 16, 2025 at Houston.

📌 Marked his second career start with at least 6.2 innings pitched without issuing a walk (also 9/3/24 vs. CWS, 7.1 IP).

NYC: Povich is scheduled to make his fifth career start against New York-AL, having gone 0-2 with a 4.58 ERA (10 ER/19.2 IP)...The four starts vs. the Yankees are his second most against any opponent, trailing Boston (5 GS)...Povich pitched at Yankee Stadium in his third career start on June 19, 2024 and allowed one run in 4.2 innings on one hit and five walks with one strikeouts in a 7-6 Orioles victory...Has allowed exactly three runs in each of his other three starts opposite New York-AL.

📌 Povich is 0-6 with a 5.26 ERA (38 ER/65.0) over 13 career starts vs. the AL East and hasn't reached 6.0 innings in all but one of those starts (8/17/24 vs. BOS, 6.1 IP).

RIGHT HAND MAN: Povich held right-handed batters to a .091 average (1-for-11) with two walks and two strikeouts in his season debut on April 5 at Pittsburgh, only allowing a leadoff single to Jake Mangum in the sixth...His one hit allowed against righties was a career low (5x, last: 5/16/25 vs. WSH).

📌 In his last outing on April 12 vs. San Francisco, he held right-handed batters to a .172 mark (4-for-18) with one double and three strikeouts.

📌 His most effective offerings against right-handed hitters have been his four-seam fastball and curveball, holding them to a .091 (1-for-11) and .111 (1-for-9) opponent average, respectively.

OFF AND RUNNING: Povich has held the opposition hitless (0-for-17) the first time through the lineup...The second time around, they are 5-for-17 (.294) and are hitting .364 (4-for-11) the third time through.

HELLO, GOODBYE: Povich has recorded a career-high 35.4 percent chase rate through two games this season, which ranks in the 89th percentile of MLB...His 42.1 percent whiff rate on his curve is the highest mark of his career on any of his pitches, ahead of his changeup (35.2%) in 2025.

SMALL SAMPLE: Although he has tossed only 12.1 innings in 2026, Povich's 35.4 percent out of zone swing rate is up 8.9 percent from last season (26.5%), while his 39.5 percent hard-hit rate is down 7.4 percent from 2025 (46.9 %).

LAST TIME OUT: Bradish suffered his third loss of the season on April 26 vs. Boston after allowing three runs on four hits (1 HR) and a season-high four walks with three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Has walked 17 batters over his first six starts of the year, marking the most walks allowed over any six-game span in his career...Threw 88 pitches, 52 strikes.

vs. NEW YORK-AL: Bradish is scheduled to make his eighth career start tomorrow against New York-AL, having gone 1-1 with a 3.09 ERA (12 ER/35.0 IP)...The 3.09 ERA is his lowest mark vs. any AL East opponent ahead of Toronto (5.18), Tampa Bay (5.94), and Boston (6.75).
