MLB COMBINE AT CHASE FIELD THIS WEEK: For the second straight year, the D-backs' Chase Field will host the 2024 MLB Draft Combine, from June 18-23...the top 300 Draft-eligible players have been invited along with up to 50 supplemental invites for the opportunity for players to participate in a series of medical and performance assessments as well as educational programming designed to prepare them for careers in professional baseball.
KIDS FREE WEEKEND @ CHASE FIELD RETURNS JUNE 28-30: Kids Free Weekend, presented by Wendy's, returns June 28-30...get up to 2 free kids tickets ( 15 \& younger) with the purchase of an adult ticket to the series against the A's... Chase Field's fun experiences, including The Kids Club, Sandlot, Baxter's Den and D-backs Sign Station, are all available during the series...for more information, visit dbacks.com/kidsfree.

THE NL CHAMPS: The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

- Roku Channel App on Sunday: Roku TV is not required to watch the game...the Roku Channel app is available for download on all smart TVs and devices or via the Roku Channel website.
- Sunday's 11:35 a.m. ET first pitch (8:35 a.m. AZ) will be the earliest ever @ Citizens Bank Park.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won yesterday, 5-2, @ Nationals.

- Ryne Nelson earned the win (2 ER in 7.0 IP ) after tossing just 70 pitches, the lowest pitch count by a D-backs starter in franchise history thru 7.0 IP in a game (previous: Brandon Webb, 74 pitches on Sept. 12, 2007).
- Jake McCarthy went 3-for-4 with 2 runs and 2 stolen bases.
-Christian Walker collected his 17th homer of the season (solo in 9th inn.).

MAKE OUR SNAKES ALL-STARS: Ketel Marte, in second place among NL second basemen (608,807 votes), leads D-backs vote getters in first balloting update for 2024 MLB All-Star Game.

- Christian Walker currently sits at sixth among first basemen (112,385 votes) while Joc Pederson sits at sixth among designated hitters ( 81,340 votes).
- Phase 1 balloting ends on Thursday, June 27 at 9:00 a.m. AZ with finalists announced later that day at 3:00 p.m. AZ on MLB Network.

LAST TIME @ THE BANK: The D-backs last faced the Phillies in the 2023 National League Championship Series, winning games 6 and 7 (Oct. 23 \& 24, 2023) @ Citizens Bank Park to clinch the NL pennant.

- The D-backs became the sixth team in MLB history to win a 7-game Postseason series after losing the first 2 road games (lost on Oct. 16-17 @ Phillies).
- Since 2022, the D-backs are 3-3 @ Citizens Bank Park. last season, Arizona took the 3-game set 2-to-1.

FACING THE PHILLIES: Christian Walker, a Philly-area native, is a career .315 batter (29-for-92, $82 \mathrm{~B}, 13 \mathrm{~B}, 2 \mathrm{HR}$, 13 RBI) vs. Phillies.

- Jake McCarthy, who hails from Scranton, Pa., is a career .341 hitter (14-for-41, 3 2B, 3 3B, 3 HR, 9 RBI).
$\bullet$ Ketel Marte is a career . 336 hitter (36-for-107, 4 2B, 2 3B, 4 HR, 12 RBI).
.500 OR BETTER: With a victory tonight, the D-backs would improve to a record of $.500+$ for the first time since Apri 16 (.500, 9-9).

JAKE LIKES TO RAKE: Jake McCarthy has hit safely in his last 4 games, with 3 multi-hit efforts in the span, batting .615 (8-for-13) with 1 double, 1 triple, 3 RBI, 1 walk and 3 stolen bases.

- Yesterday, he became the fourth D-back to collect multiple games in their career with $3+$ hits, $2+$ stolen bases and $2+$ runs scored (also: AJ Pollock/3, Jean Segura/3 and Corbin Carroll/2).

MARTE MAKING HIS CASE: Ketel Marte leads all second basemen with a 3.9 bWAR, an .848 OPS, 33 extra-base hits, 146 total bases, 42 RBI, 12 defensive runs saved and 1.5 dWAR, is second with 15 homers and 16 doubles and third with 111 times on base and 81 hits.

- Marte's 3.9 bWAR is third in the NL (8th in MLB), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (4.1) and Mookie Betts/LAD (4.0).

WALKER, TEXAS RANGER ALL-STAR: Christian Walker's 2.1 bWAR is third among all first basemen, behind Freddie Freeman/LAD (3.1) and Bryce Harper/PHI (2.9)....his 17 home runs are tied for second (also: Bryce Harper/PHI), behind Josh Naylor/CLE (19), while his 818 OPS is fifth. - Defensively, his 6 DRS and 0.3 dWAR are tied for the best marks among first basemen with Joey Gallo/WSH.

JUNE BOOM: The D-backs are 12-6 (.667) in June, tied for the third-best winning pct. (also: Mariners), behind the Mets (11-5, .688) and Orioles (13-6, .684).

SERIES SECURED: The D-backs have won 3 straight series victories (vs. Angels, vs. White Sox, @ Nationals)...they have won or split their last 6 series since May 30.

SERIES OPENERS: The D-backs have won their last 5 se-ries-opening games (June 3-18) after going 3-15 in their previous 18 to start the season (March 28-May 30).

ANOTHER 13+-HIT GAME: The D-backs' 10 games this season with $13+$ hits are tied for second in the Majors (also: Orioles and Brewers), behind the Dodgers (11) and Mets (11).

87 PITCHES - NEW FRANCHISE LOW: The 87-pitch game by the D-backs (3 pitchers) yesterday @ Nationals marked the fewest pitches tossed thru 9.0 full innings in franchise history (previous: 90 on Sept. 14, 1998 vs. Giants).

DEFENDERS OF THE DIAMOND: This season, the D-backs' . 988 fielding pct. is the second-best overall mark in the Majors, behind the Braves (.989), while their 32 errors are second fewest, behind the Braves (30).

NEXT STARTER: LHP TOMMY HENRY $(2-2,6.23)$

- Made his last start on April 29 vs. Dodgers (L; 2 ER in 4.0 IP)...has made 2 relief appearances in June (6.1 IP). - Has made 3 career starts vs. Phillies...made last start on June 12, 2023 @ Chase Field (ND; 5 ER in 4.2 IP) in the D-backs' 9-8 victory.

- Signed by the D-backs as a free agent on March 29.
- Has 3 consecutive seasons (2021-23) of 30+ starts and 150.0+ innings.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: 12th start of the season, fifth on the road.

- In his last 2 starts, is 2-0 with a 2.53 ERA (4 R-3 ER in 10.2 IP).
- The D-backs are 6-2 in his last 8 starts.

LAST START: Retired 13 of 21 batters faced in his fifth win of the season on June 16 vs. White Sox ( 0 ER in 5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 BB, 7 K).

VS. PHILLIES: Second career start vs. Phillies.

- Lone start @ Phillies was on Aug. 6, 2020 (L; 5 ER in 4.0 IP, 6 H, 2 K).

VS. NL EAST: 16th career start vs. NL East, eighth on the road.

- In his last 7 starts ( 4 with Cardinals, 1 with Rangers, 2 with D-backs), his teams are 6-1.

LIMITING LEFTIES: Is limiting left-handed batters to a . 211 average (8-for-38).

- In his career (564 BF), has held lefties to a .220/.261/.315 slash line with 11 homers, 23 walks and 132 strikeouts.
- His .576 opponent OPS vs. lefties is second among active starters (min. 500 LHB faced) to Chris Sale (.531).
- Has issued walks to just 6 of 256 (2.3\%) left-handed batters faced since 2022, the lowest walk pct. against lefties in MLB (min. 200 LH batters faced).
6.0+ INNINGS: Has tossed 6.0+ innings in 3 of his 4 road starts this season, going 2-1 with a 2.70 ERA (6 ER in 20.0 IP).
- In his last 11 starts going 6.0+ innings dating back to Aug. 15, 2023, is 6-1 with a 1.85 ERA ( 15 ER in 73.0 IP ), .228 opponent average (61-for-268), 1.00 WHIP, 12 walks and 53 strikeouts.
- Is 33-15 with a 2.38 ERA (122 R-113 ER in 426.2 IP), .212 average (332-for-1567), 0.98 WHIP and 368 strikeouts when he pitches 6.0+ innings ( 67 GS ).

HOW ABOUT THAT CURVEBALL: Is throwing his curveball 29.7 percent this season compared to 22.2 percent in 2023.

- From April $24-$ May 13, held hitters to a . 125 average (3-for-24) off his curveball.

- Has not allowed a hit on an 0-2 count in 9 straight games (15 BF).

- Went 3-0 with a 1.83 ERA (5 R-4 ER in 19.2 IP, 14 K ) in 4 road games (3 starts).

2023 RECAP: Earned All-MLB Second-Team honors after going 10-11, 3.20 ERA ( 67 ER in 188.2 IP) with 166 strikeouts in 32 starts between the Cardinals ( 21 GS ) and Rangers ( 11 GS ).

- Ranked among MLB qualifiers in home runs per 9.0 innings (7th, 0.86 ) and ERA (8th, 3.20).
- Set career highs in virtually all categories, including wins (10), innings (188.2) and strikeouts (166) in 2023.

- Was teammates with D-backs first baseman Christian Walker in 2012, when they finished as National runner-ups after falling to the University of Arizona.
