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BIRDLAND BITES: Tonight, Baltimore continues a 10-game, 11-day road trip through Texas (0-1, 2 to play), Minnesota (3 to play), and Tampa Bay (4 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 3-3 homestand, dropping two of three to the Phillies before taking two of three from the Angels...The Orioles begin play today 2.0 games back of the final AL Wild Card spot.

🦅 **Shane Baz** threw his first career complete game, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR), one walk, and nine strikeouts...The 8.0 innings matched a career high (also 6/26/25 at KC), while the nine strikeouts matched a season high (4x, last: 7/12 vs. KC)...He became the fourth pitcher in MLB this season to suffer a loss while throwing a complete game, joining SF's Logan Webb (6/21 at MIA), ATH's J.T. Ginn (5/18 at LAA), and SEA's George Kirby (4/7 at TEX).

🦅 The Birds went 1-for-5 with runners in scoring position and own a .136 (3-for-22) RISP average in six games this month.

🦅 Last night marked the fourth time Oriole pitching held the opposition to three or fewer hits (last: W, 7/11 vs. KC), but are 2-2 those affairs...The Birds held the Yankees to one hit in a 7-0 win on May 13 and permitted three hits in a 4-2 loss at the Guardians on April 18.

CONTAINING RANGER DANGER: Since first meeting in the regular season in 1972, the O's are 282-230 (.551) against the Rangers...It marks Baltimore's second-highest winning percentage against any club during that period (min. 50 G), behind their 208-166 (.556) mark against Milwaukee.

🦅 **Colton Cowser** owns a 12-game hitting streak against the Rangers since July 19, 2024, batting .317 (13-for-41) with two doubles, two home runs, four walks, and two steals...It marks the longest hitting streak by an Oriole against the Rangers since Brian Roberts hit safely in 14 straight opposite Texas from April 10 (G2), 2008-September 4, 2009.

🦅 **Pete Alonso** has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games against Texas since August 30, 2023, slashing .318/.392/.545 (14-for-44) with one double, three home runs, 10 RBI, and six walks.

🦅 **Kyle Bradish** has allowed two earned runs across 13.1 innings in three career starts against Texas.

BIRDS READY TO BREAK OUT: Through six games in August, the O's are averaging 1.67 runs per game, the lowest mark in the majors with the next closest club being the Angels (2.50).

🦅 In 13 games coming out of the All-Star break through the end of July, Baltimore averaged 4.6 runs per game.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.60 ERA in 65 games since May 24, the fourth-lowest mark in MLB during that time behind the Tigers (3.22), Red Sox (3.29), and Yankees (3.33)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

🦅 The rotation has posted a 3.72 ERA since May 24, the fourth-best starter ERA in the AL behind the Tigers (2.89), Red Sox (3.66), and Yankees (3.70)...Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

🦅 Orioles relievers have a 3.03 ERA since June 16, fifth lowest in the majors behind the Red Sox (2.54), Astros (2.61), Yankees (2.79), and Rays (2.95)...Entering that day, the team's bullpen ERA was 4.53, ranked ninth in the AL and 21st in MLB.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles have played in 76 games decided by three or fewer runs, tied for fourth most in the majors behind the Guardians (80) and Blue Jays/Royals (both 77)...Their 36-40 (.474) winning percentage in such affairs ranks 21st in MLB.

🦅 Baltimore is 10-18 (.357) in one-run games, the third-lowest winning percentage in MLB ahead of the Giants (10-20, .333) and Mets (11-20, .355).

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 28 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (23)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least five pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (7).

🦅 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and CWS/PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962)

🦅 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season while **Tyler O'Neill** and **Leody Taveras** are tied for second with three pinch-hit RBI each.

🦅 The team's 28 pinch-hit RBI are the most by the Orioles since 1991 (30)...The team record is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 107 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Tigers (42 G).

🦅 Baltimore has secured a walk in 100 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025...The current 107-game stretch is the second-longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954) trailing a 112-game run in 1995.

🦅 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

🦅 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 450 walks.

FARM REPORT: Infielder **Wehiwa Aloy** and left-handed pitcher **Caden Hunter** were named the Orioles Player and Pitcher of the Month for July, respectively.

🦅 Aloy, 22, hit .379/.450/.621 (33-for-87) with seven doubles, one triple, four home runs, and 18 RBI in 23 games between High-A Frederick and Double-A Chesapeake...Aloy ranks among all O's minor leaguers in hits (1st, 107), runs (1st, 67), total bases (T-1st, 182), RBI (2nd, 75), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 37), home runs (T-3rd, 17), slugging percentage (4th, .497), and batting average (5th, .292),

🦅 Hunter, 22, went 2-1 with a 1.05 ERA (3 ER/25.2 IP) and 35 strikeouts across five appearances (4 GS) between Frederick and Chesapeake...Hunter's 122 strikeouts are second among all Baltimore farmhands behind Joseph Dzierwa (125 K) and are tied for seventh most in all of Minor League Baseball.
