**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 12**
1995 - A year after the player's strike, which canceled the 1994 World Series, the Astros extend an olive branch to their fans by offering free tickets to the Astros-Phillies game at the Astro-dome...30,828 end up in attendance.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will continue their homestand tonight in the second game of a four-game series against the rival Seattle Mariners... Astros starter **RHP Tatsuya Imai** returns from the IL today after a bout with arm fatigue to face off against the Mariners and **RHP Bryan Woo**.

ASTROS ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have reinstated **RHP Tatsuya Imai** from the 15-day IL today... in a corresponding move, the Astros optioned **RHP Logan VanWey** to Triple A after last night's game.

ABOUT IMAI: **RHP Tatsuya Imai** is set to make his fourth career Major League start tonight and his first in over a month after missing 26 team games with right arm fatigue...Imai made two minor league starts on his way back, last pitching on May 5 vs. Triple A Albuquerque (1ER/3IP)...in January, the Astros signed Imai to a three-year deal... in 2025, he was an All-Star for the Seibu Lions in the NPB in Japan, where he went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games.

CARE BEARS NIGHT: The Astros are teaming up with the **Care Bears™** for a night filled with cheer, colorful fun, and heartwarming activities throughout the ballpark...fans can also purchase an exclusive **Care Bears Bobblehead Add-On Package** to take home a little piece of magic for \$49.50.

ON THE RADIO: The Astros radio broadcast for the Mariners series will feature **Robert Ford** and **Kevin Eschenfelder** on SportsTalk 790...the Spanish broadcast can be heard on TUDN 102.9 FM with **Francisco Romero** and **Alex Treviño** on the call.

VS. SEATTLE: The Astros and Mariners are playing their second series of the 2026 season this week in Houston...the Astros are looking for revenge, as they were swept in a four-game series in Seattle earlier this season from April 10-13...Houston is 132-102 all-time against the Mariners, including a 68-54 record at home.

ABOUT THE SKIPPER: Astros manager **Joe Espada** has 191 career managerial victories which ties him with **Harry Craft** (1962-64) for 12th in franchise history...the two immediately trail **Jimmy Williams** (215) for 11th on that all-time list.

CORREA UNDERGOES SURGERY: **IF Carlos Correa** underwent successful peroneus brevis tendon repair surgery on his left ankle yesterday...he will be sidelined for the remainder of the 2026 season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros outhit the Mariners 9-7, but dropped the opener of their four-game series by a score of 3-1...**RHP Peter Lambert** (3ER/7IP) had another strong start, but was handed the loss...**2B Jose Altuve** (3x5) and **3B Isaac Paredes** (3x5, RBI) both had three-hit games in the defeat.

THREE-HIT ALTUVE: **2B Jose Altuve** went 3x5 last night, giving him 221 career three-hit games, which ranks second in club history, trailing only **2B Craig Biggio** (225)...since Altuve's debut season of 2011, he leads all Major League players in three-hit games, with 21 more than the next closest player: **1B Freddie Freeman** (200).

THE ORDER: The Astros have used 42 different batting orders in their 42 games so far this season...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second).

AIR YORDAN: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is batting .314 (49x156) with 10 doubles, 13 HR, 29 RBI and a 1.044 OPS (.416 OBP/.628 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks first in total bases (98), tied for first in extra-base hits (23), second in OPS, tied for second in hits, third in SLG, tied for third in homers, tied for third in RBI, fourth in OBP, and tied for fourth in batting average.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has 355 career extra-base hits, which ties him with **3B Doug Rader** for 10th in extra-base hits in Astros franchise history...the two immediately trail **1B Bob Watson** (410) for ninth on that all-time list.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: With 238 career homers as a second baseman, **Jose Altuve** needs one more to tie **Lou Whitaker** for seventh place all-time in MLB history among second basemen...Altuve also needs two RBI to become the fifth player in franchise history to reach 900.

HIT PAREDES: **3B Isaac Paredes** is hitting .338 (25x74) with a .402 OBP and a .902 OPS in his last 20 games, dating back to April 19...he's hit safely in 16 of those 20 games and has reached base safely in 18 of last 20 games.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** is hitting .301 (22x73) in his last 19 games (since April 20) with five homers and 11 RBI...among AL players this season, Walker ranks tied for sixth in extra-base hits (18), seventh in total bases (78), seventh in SLG (.513), and ninth in RBI (27).

GUN 'EM DOWN: In just 19 games, **C Christian Vázquez** has thrown out nine baserunners attempting to steal (in 22 attempts), leading the AL and ranking third in the Majors in that category.

STARS DOWN IN CORPUS: **SS Jeremy Peña** (right hamstring strain) and **CF Jake Meyers** (right oblique strain) will begin minor league rehab assignments tonight at Double A Corpus Christi... they'll be joined by **LHP Josh Hader** (left biceps tendinitis), who had his rehab assignment transferred to Corpus Christi today.

MINOR LEAGUE HONORS: **RHP Angel Peralta** was named the Florida Complex League Pitcher of the Week for the week of May 4-10...Peralta made one start during the week, tossing 5.0 scoreless innings, while allowing just one hit en route to a win on May 6 vs. the FCL Cardinals.

IL STINT: Was on the 15-day IL from April 13-May 10 due to right arm fatigue...made two rehab appearances during his IL, one with Double A Corpus Christi and the other with Triple A Sugar Land...recorded a combined 10.80 ERA (6ER/5IP) with five strikeouts and eight walks.

LAST REHAB START, MAY 5 VS. ABQ: Made his second rehab start with the Triple A Sugar Land on Tuesday, May 5 at Constellation Field...allowed 1 run on 1 hit and 5 walks with 3 strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

LAST MAJOR LEAGUE START, APRIL 10 at SEA: Allowed 3 runs on 1 hit and 4 walks with 1 HBP in 0.1 of an inning.

FIRST MAJOR LEAGUE WIN: Earned his 1st career Major League win on April 4 at ATH...in that outing, he allowed 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts in 5.2 innings.

ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY): Rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...prior to signing with the Astros, Imai starred in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB) for the last 8 seasons (2018-25)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...was a 3-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

MLB DEBUT: Made his MLB debut on March 29 vs. LAA, working 2.2 innings while allowing 4 runs on 3 hits with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts (74 pitches-36 strikes)...picked up his first MLB strikeout vs. **Mike Trout**, the second batter he faced in his debut...took a no-decision in the Astros' 9-7 win over the Halos....topped out at 97.6 mph in his debut.

JAPAN CONNECTION: Became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Imai knows Matsui well, having played for him from 2023-24, while he was managing in the NPB with the Seibu Lions.

I-45: Wears jersey number 45 to honor 2 of his favorite pitchers, former Astros great **RHP Gerrit Cole** and the Phillies **RHP Zack Wheeler**, who both also wear #45.

SCORELESS SPRING TRAINING: made 3 official Spring Training starts and an exhibition game start, combining to toss 9.2 innings of scoreless baseball...in his 3 official starts, he allowed 2 hits and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...his exhibition start came on March 23 vs. the Astros Triple A affiliate, the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, in which he tossed 3.2 scoreless innings.

LOCKED UP: signed a 3-year contract with the Astros on Jan. 2, 2026...the contract includes player opt-outs after the 2026 and 2027 seasons.

2025 RECAP: went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/9 at CIN): Tossed 0.1 of a scoreless inning on Saturday at CIN, retiring the only hitter he faced (**Sal Stewart**) on 5 pitches (3 strikes).

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (1ER/5.1IP) in his last 5 games dating back to April 24...within that span, picked up his 1st win of the season on May 3 at BOS after he allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 1 strikeout in 2.0 scoreless innings...was his longest outing of the season...prior to this hot streak, posted a 14.73 ERA (12ER/7.1IP) in his first 9 games of the season.

VS. SEA: Has struck out 52 batters through 36.1 innings in 34 career appearances vs. the Mariners, holding an impressive 12.88 SO/9IP with a 3.47 ERA (14ER/36.1IP)...has the most strikeouts among active relievers against Seattle with 52...has held **C Cal Raleigh** to a 2x10 mark with 6 strikeouts in their career matchups.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...currently has 342.1 IP, with **RHP Xavier Hernandez** next on the all-time list at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (468) and 7th in apps. (331).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Is 2.0 innings from matching **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for the 4th-most innings pitched by a reliever in Daikin Park history...is also 4 strikeouts from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

CAREER: In 331 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.89 ERA (110ER/342.1P) with 468 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, 12.30 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
