THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 17
1963 - **RHP Don Nottebart** tosses the first no-hitter in Astros history, a 4-1 win over Philadelphia at Colt Stadium...**C John Bateman** is behind the dish for the feat...the Astros have now thrown 16 regular season no-hitters in their franchise history, which dates back to 1962...since the club's inaugural year, no team has thrown more, with the Angels and Dodgers ranking second on that list with 13.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros will play the final game of their seven-game homestand today as they go for a sweep in the first round of the Silver Boot Series, presented by the Texas Lottery, against the in-state rival Rangers...**RHP Peter Lambert**, a minor league free agent signing this offseason, will get the start for Houston today opposite veteran starter **RHP Nathan Eovaldi** and the Rangers.

DRIVING THE LAMBO: Today's Astros starter **RHP Peter Lambert** has been great in his five starts for the Astros, going 2-3 with a 2.76 ERA (9ER/29.1IP) with 29 strikeouts and a .198 opponent average...his advanced metrics back up his counting stats, as he ranks in the 78th percentile in barrel % (5.2), 74th percentile in xBA (.221), and 71st percentile of whiff % (28.2)...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 appearances in Japan...he began this season at Triple A Sugar Land (1.84 ERA in three appearances) before being called up to join the rotation on April 17.

SWEEPSTAKES: The Astros have won five straight games against the Rangers dating back to last season, which includes a three-game series sweep in Houston from Sept. 15-17, 2025...the Astros are looking for their second sweep of the season, the first being a three-game sweep of the Red Sox from March 30-April 1 at Daikin Park.

THE SILVER BOOT SERIES: The Astros and Rangers have played each other 294 times in the regular season in their franchise histories, with the Astros edging out the Rangers in the all-time advantage 148-146...recently, the Astros have had the upper hand, winning or splitting nine straight season series, going 95-51 against the Rangers since the start of the 2017 season...*note: the Silver Boot Trophy will be on display today in the Centerfield Team Store at Daikin Park.*

SOLO HOMER SATURDAY NIGHT: The Astros blasted four solo homers last night en route to a 4-1 series-clinching win over the visiting Rangers...**2B Jose Altuve** began the night with a leadoff homer and was later joined by **DH Yordan Alvarez**, **1B Christian Walker** and **RF Zach Cole** in the solo homer parade...**RHP Kai-Wei Teng** (0ER/5IP) had a scoreless start, earning the victory, while **RHP Bryan Abreu** (0ER/1.1IP) picked up the save.

LEADING MEN: Last night, **2B Jose Altuve** connected for his 42nd career leadoff homer, which ranks second in franchise history, trailing only **2B Craig Biggio** (53)...the Astros have a long history of leadoff homers, between Biggio, Altuve, **OF George Springer** (40), and others, with the team combining for 228 leadoff homers in franchise history, which ranks second in the Majors since their inception in 1962, trailing only the Tigers (230).

FOUR LONG BALLS: The Astros recorded their third four-homer game of the season last night, last doing so on May 8 at CIN...all four homers last night came off **RHP Jacob deGrom**, tying the most home runs he's allowed in a start in his illustrious career (also, July 7, 2017 at STL).

ARMED FORCES WEEKEND: The Astros and MLB are celebrating **Armed Forces Weekend**...as part of the celebration, MLB players and club personnel are wearing camouflage-designed New Era caps with their uniforms, as well as optional camo-themed Stance socks.

AIR YORDAN: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is batting .322 (55x171) with 11 doubles, 15 HR, 31 RBI and a 1.078 OPS (.429 OBP/.649 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks first in total bases (111), first in XBH (26), first in OBP, second in OPS, second in SLG, third in hits, third in batting average, tied for third in HR, tied for third in RBI, tied for eighth in walks (29), and tied for ninth in runs (30).

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** hit his 10th homer of the season last night, which ranks tied for third among AL first basemen, tied with **1B Ben Rice** (10) and trailing only **1B Munetaka Murakami** (17)...among all AL players in 2026, Walker ranks tied for fifth in RBI (30), sixth in extra-base hits (21), eighth in total bases (88), and eighth in SLG (.521).

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: **2B Jose Altuve** connected for his 239th career homer as a second baseman last night, which tied him with **Lou Whitaker** for seventh place all-time in MLB history among second basemen...additionally, earlier this week, Altuve reached the 900-RBI mark, making him the fifth player in club history to reach that number.

TAP THE HELMET: Astros batters lead the Majors in successful ABS challenges with 30 won in 52 total challenges (58% successful)...**2B Jose Altuve** leads all Major League players in challenges won, as he's won nine of 13 challenges (69% successful).

POWER STROKE: OF Zach Cole has hit seven home runs in his first 26 Major League games, including 15 games last season and 11 in 2026...he's one of just three players in club history to do so, joining **DH Yordan Alvarez** (9 in 2019) and **SS Carlos Correa** (7 in 2015).

ALTUVE SIDELINED: **2B Jose Altuve** left last night's game with left side soreness...he is scheduled to receive imaging today.

OUT ON REHAB: **SS Jeremy Peña** (rt. hamstring strain), **CF Jake Meyers** (rt. oblique strain) and **LHP Josh Hader** (lt. biceps tendinitis) are on rehab assignments for Double A Corpus Christi, while **RHP Nate Pearson** (rt. elbow surgery) is on assignment with Triple A Sugar Land...last night, Peña went 1x4 with a double in a start at shortstop, and Meyers went 0x4 with a run scored...Hader and Pearson both had the night off after tossing 1.0 scoreless inning each on Friday night.

LAST START - 5/11 vs. SEA: Got the 1st start of this current homestand and tossed 7.0 innings for his 2nd consecutive start, allowing 3 runs on 6 hits with 1 walk and 6 strikeouts...did not factor into the decision of the Astros' 3-1 loss to the Mariners...has logged consecutive quality starts for the 2nd time in his MLB career, also recording 2 in a row from Aug. 12-18, 2023, while with the Rockies.

THE LAMBERTGHINI: A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has been a stabilizer in the Astros rotation amid a flux of injuries...has recorded a quality start in 3 of his 6 outings this season, including 2 scoreless outings (April 22 at CLE and May 5 vs. LAD)...since making his season debut on April 17, he ranks 9th in the AL in H/9IP (6.44), 10th in opponent batting average (.198) and 10th in ERA (2.76) (min. 25 IP).

TOE-TO-TOE WITH 'SHO': Notched the best the best start of his career on May 5 vs. LAD, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros' 2-1 victory...matched his career high with 7.0 innings, which he's now accomplished 4 times...also matched his fewest hits allowed among his 24 career outings in which he's tossed at least 5.0 innings.

THE REPERTOIRE: Has been greatly successful working off his 2-pitch mix of a 4-seam fastball (32.5%) and changeup (23.9%), holding opponents to a combined .183 AVG (11x60) between the 2 pitches.

VS. TEX: Is set to make his 1st career start and 2nd career appearance vs. the Rangers this afternoon...also faced them in relief as a member of the Rockies on May 19, 2023, at Globe Life Field, allowing 2 runs on 3 hits with 2 strikeouts through 2.2 innings.

NO. 200: Recorded his 200th career strikeout in Game 1 of the Astros' doubleheader on April 30 at BAL, a called third strike against **BAL OF Colton Cowser**.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Triple A Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...has appeared at the Major League level in four seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 78 career Major League appearances, including 39 starts, he's recorded a 5.95 ERA (176ER/266IP) with 204 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School, was committed to play baseball at UCLA before signing with the Rockies...was signed by Rockies scout Jon Lukens...as a senior at San Dimas HS in 2015, he went 13-0 with a 0.34 ERA...was also named the Los Angeles Times Baseball Player of the Year.

FAMILY TIES: Has an older brother, **Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/16 vs. TEX): Picked up his 2nd save of the season last night, tossing 1.1 scoreless innings while working around 1 hit and 1 walk...has recorded a win (Wed. vs. SEA) and a save through his 2 appearances this homestand.

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 2-0-1 through 5 consecutive scoreless appearances (5.2 IP), dating back to May 3 ...prior to this streak, posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season.

VS. TEX: Has made 30 career regular-season appearances vs. the Rangers, the most among current Astros pitchers and tied for 3rd-most among active players...has averaged 10.05 SO/9IP (35SO/31.1IP) while recording a 4.02 ERA (14ER/31.1IP) in his career vs. TEX...also appeared in 6 of the 7 games of the 2023 ALCS vs. TEX, posting a 3.00 ERA (1ER/3IP) with 4 strikeouts and a .100 opponent average (1x10) through his first 4 apps of the series, before surrendering 3 runs through 2.0 innings in the final 2 apps.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (333) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (469).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing last night, surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for 4th-most by a reliever in the venue's history...is also 3 strikeouts from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

CAREER: In 333 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.87 ERA (110ER/344.2P) with 469 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.25 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
