TODAY'S GAME: The Giants kick off their final homestand of the season with the first of three games against the San Diego Padres.

- SF needs to win five of its six remaining games to secure a winning record this season, and four of six to finish .500 (81-81).
- This series features two teams on opposite trajectories...San Diego is 15-6 (.714) in September, which is the best record in the Majors this month...the Giants are 7-15 (.318) this month, which is tied with WAS and COL for both the worst record in the NL, and second-worst in MLB (Angels are last at 6-16, .273).
- Last night's loss on Sunday Night Baseball moved the Giants to two games below .500, a mark they have not held since May 21 (22-24)...it also moved them into a tie for third place with San Diego...a loss today would move the Giants into fourth place for the first time since May 16 when they were 19-23.
- The Giants dropped eight of 10 games on their past road trip to Colorado (1-3), Arizona (0-2) and Los Angeles (1-3)... SF was outscored by a 60-34 (-26) margin...the pitching staff allowed 60 runs in that span (6.0 runs/game) but only 49 runs are earned...the bullpen posted a 6.49 ERA (31er, 43.0ip)...while SF's offense averaged 3.4 runs per game.

HOME SWEET HOME: SF is 43-32 (.573) at home this year, which is the ninth-best home record in the Majors...this is in contrast to its 34-47 (.420) road record, which is 25th in MLB.

- Stats, LLC notes that the Giants' 14-6 (.700) mark at home vs. NL West teams is the best divisional record in the Majors, leading Atlanta (16-7, .696) and Los Angeles-NL (18-8, .692).
- The home divisional record is also the Giants' fourth-best since divisions formed in 1969.

A WILD RACE: The Giants kicked off their road trip on September 14 in command of the third NL Wild Card spot, but losses in eight of 10 games have dwindled SF's postseason odds on *FanGraphs* to 0.0%.

▶ Just six games remain on the Giants' regular season schedule as they enter today 5.0 games behind the Cubs for the third and final Wild Card spot in the NL...the Giants also trail the Marlins by 4.0 games and the Reds by 2.5 games.

HE CAN DO IT ALL: IF Thairo Estrada has a career-best 41 extra-base hits this season (26 doubles, two triples, 13 homers)...with his 22 steals, Estrada became just the fifth middle infielder in Giants history to record at least 40 extrabase hits and 20+ stolen bases in a single season.

- The last Giants middle infielder to record at least 40 extrabase hits and 20 steals in a season was Frankie Frisch in 1923 and 1924.
- He is the first Giants player of any position to reach those marks since Hunter Pence in 2013 (67 XBH, 22 SB).

LEADOFF LAMONTE: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. has been one of the best table setters in recent SF history.

- Wade has the second-best on-base percentage as a leadoff hitter for SF since 1995 (*Stats, LLC*), trailing only **Darryl** Hamilton's .395 on-base percentage in 1998 (min. 300 PA as leadoff hitter).
- ▶ He has five leadoff home runs this season, eight in his career.
- According to Stats, LLC, Wade has 15 total home runs as the first hitter in the lineup, which is tied for second most by a Giants player during the Wild Card era (Marvin Bernard 1999)...Ray Durham led with 17 home runs in 2003.
- When adding in all SF leadoff hitters this season, SF's .361 OBP from its leadoff hitters is seventh-best in the Majors, while its 11.8% walk rate ranks fourth.

YAZ: OF Mike Yastrzemski has performed well against SD in his career, with his .949 OPS vs. the Padres ranking fifth in SF history according to *Stats, LLC* (min. 200 plate appearances).

THE LONG BALL: Giants hitters have homered 25 times in September, their most in a month since May (30)...SF finished June and July with 23 home runs and had 22 in August.

▶ With both runs yesterday scoring on Wade's 5th-inning tworun home run, the Giants have scored 44% of their runs via home runs this month.

WEBB GEM: RHP Logan Webb currently leads the Majors in innings pitched with 207.0 this year...the next is Arizona's Zac Gallen (203.2ip).

- According to Stats, LLC, the only other Giants to lead MLB in innings pitched are Gaylord Perry (1970 and 1969), Juan Marichal (1963), Joe McGinnity (1903) and Amos Rusie (1893).
- Webb's 23 quality starts are tied for most in MLB with NYY's Gerrit Cole...**Rick Reuschel** was the last Giant to lead MLB in quality starts, tying Orel Hershiser with 28 in 1988.

LAST OUTING: It was yet another tough-luck loss for the Giants ace as he allowed three runs on nine hits in 6.0 innings but suffered the loss as the Giants fell to the D-Backs 7-1 in a crucial game at Chase Field last Wednesday...like most of the season, Webb did not receive much run support (see below) as SF scored on a leadoff homer from LaMonte Wade Jr. but did not score again the rest of the game.

GIVE ME THE BALL: Will make his 33rd start of the season tonight, a career-high, surpassing the 32 he made last season...the last Giants righty to make 33 starts during the regular season was Kevin Gausman in 2021, who also made 33...if Webb makes one more start after this, he'll be the first Giants right-hander to make 34 starts since Matt Cain did so in 2008.

ON THE LEADERBOARDS: Webb enters today's start leading the Majors in innings pitched (207.0) ahead of Árizona's Zac Gallen (203.2) and NYY's Gerrit Cole (200.0)...his 4.6 fWAR is fifth-best in the NL behind Zack Wheeler (5.8), Spencer Strider (5.4), Gallen (4.9) and Justin Steele (4.8)...his 3.35 ERA is 10th-best in MLB while his 1.08 WHIP is ninth-best in MLB.

HE'S AN INNINGS-EATER: The 26-year-old has become the first Giant to surpass the 200-inning threshold since Madison Bumgarner, who worked 207.2 innings in 2019...the last Giants righty to do it was Jeff Samardzija, who threw an NL-best 207.2 innings in 2017...Webb most likely has two starts left this season and has a real chance to lead the Majors in innings pitched...that's something not too many 26-year-olds (based on age at end of the season) have done since 1990 according to *Stats, LLC*.

THAT 70'S SHOW: If Webb does indeed lead the Majors in innings pitched at season's end, he'd be the first Giant to do so since Gaylord Perry in 1970 (328.2ip).

THERE'S MORE ...: Webb will most likely pass the 207.2 innings mark today done by Bumgarner in 2019 and Samardzija in 2017 (see above)...the last Giants pitcher to throw more than 207.2 innings in a single season was Bumgarner in 2016 (226.2)...the last Giants righty to do so was **Johnny Cueto**, also in 2016 (219.2)

200...PART DEUX !: He's also within reach of the 200-strikeout mark for the first time in his career, entering today's outing with a career-best 187 punchouts (surpassing his prior career-best 163 strikeouts from last season)...Webb's 8.1 K/9ip is the second-best of his career in a full season behind a 9.6 mark in 2021.

QUALITY EATS: Webb's 23 quality starts are most in the National League, and tied for most in MLB with NYY's Gerrit Cole...if he finishes the year leading the league in quality starts he'd be the first Giant to do so since **Rick Reuschel** had 28 in 1988 (*Stats, LLC*).

VS. SAN DIEGO: Is squaring off with San Diego for the first time this year and for the first time in over a year, last facing them on August 30, 2022 here at Oracle...He's 2-2 with a 2.77 ERA (15er, 48.2ip) in nine games (eight starts) lifetime vs. San Diego but the Giants are 2-6 in the eight starts...in five games (four starts) at Oracle vs. San Diego, Webb owns a 2.03 ERA (6er, 26.2ip) with 29 strikeouts.

STAYING GROUNDED: Webb's 61.6% ground-ball rate leads the Majors, and is up from last year's 57.8% mark and above his career average of 59.1%...his career-best mark in 2021 was also 62.2%.
