**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals kick off a six-game home-stand tonight with the opener of a three-game weekend series with the visiting Philadelphia Phillies ... After sweeping Minnesota to open the season, the Cardinals are just 2-7 over their last nine games, going 1-5 on their recent road trip through Boston (0-3) and Pittsburgh (1-2) ... St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the National League Central Division, 2.5 games behind Chicago.

**MUÑOZ RECALLED:** Prior to tonight's homestand opener, the Cardinals announced that they recalled RHP **Rodderly Muñoz** from Memphis (AAA) and optioned RHP **Chris Roycroft** to Memphis after Wednesday's game ... In four relief outings with the Redbirds, Muñoz recorded a 1.80 ERA (5.0 IP) while striking out seven and limiting the opposition to a .167 average against.

**FOREVER YOUNG:** **Oliver Marmol** enters tonight tied with **Mike Shildt** (2018-2021) for 15th all-time in franchise history with 252 managerial wins ... With a win tonight, the 38-year old Marmol, the youngest manager in MLB, would take over sole possession of 15th place.

**FREE BASEBALL:** According to *Baseball Reference*, The Cardinals and Pirates were scoreless through 11 innings on Wednesday, making their matchup at PNC Park the longest Major League game that has been scoreless under the new extra inning rules ... St. Louis leads MLB in extra-inning games this season, going 0-4 ... The last time the Cardinals dropped their first four extra-inning games was 2013.

**FREE (TV) YOUR MIND:** The Cardinals are partnering with Gray Media to broadcast at least 10 Cardinals games on KMOV and Matrix Midwest in St. Louis, and on Gray-owned or syndicated third-party television stations in Missouri, Illinois, Tennessee, Arkansas, Iowa, Indiana, Kentucky, and Oklahoma serving nearly seven and a half million television households.

•The free, over-the-air games will be simulcast with FanDuel Sports Network.

•The new partnership marks the first time a package of Cardinals games are televised locally on a free and over-the-air channel as part of a non-national broadcast since 2010.

**DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT:** **Brendan Donovan** leads the Cardinals in hits (18) this season and has 13 since April 4, tied with **Paul Goldschmidt** for the most in all of Major League Baseball over that period ... Donovan hit safely in all six games (.565/.600/.826, 13-23, HR, 7 RBI) of the recent road trip and now ranks 5th in MLB in batting average (.375), including an MLB-leading .459 mark (17-37) off right-handed pitching.

**BIRTHDAY WEEK:** Cardinals celebrating birthdays this week include **Thomas Saggase** (turned 23 yesterday), **Rodderly Muñoz** (turns 25 on Monday, April 14), and **Nolan Arenado** (turns 34 on Wednesday, April 16).

**BAT SPEED:** **Jordan Walker** leads MLB with a 84.9% Fast Swing Rate (competitive bat swings of 75 mph or faster) and ranks 2nd in Average Bat Speed (78.5 mph) to Tampa Bay's **Junior Caminero** (78.9 mph). - *Baseball Savant*

**NOLAN KEEPS ROLLING:** **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 19 consecutive games since Sept. 18, 2024 (.342/.435/.452), tied with **Corbin Carroll** for MLB's 3rd-longest active streak behind **Shohei Ohtani** (29 g) and **Jacob Wilson** (20 g) ... Arenado is the last Cardinal to hit for the cycle (2nd career) on July 1, 2022 at Philadelphia (**Oliver Marmol**'s 36th birthday).

**THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (April 11, 1981):** The Cardinals record a triple play in a 5-2 loss to the Phillies on Opening Day at Busch Memorial Stadium ... With the bases loaded in the 8th inning, **Gary Matthews** hit a low line drive to shortstop **Garry Templeton** for the first out ... Templeton, thinking the ball was trapped, threw to catcher **Darrell Porter**, who threw to first baseman **Keith Hernandez** to double-off **Mike Schmidt** for the second out ... St. Louis completed the triple play when Hernandez threw the ball to third baseman **Ken Oberkfell**, who tagged out **Bake McBride**.

#### PHILADELPHIA CONNECTIONS

**JoJo Romero** pitched parts of three seasons in Philadelphia (2020-22)...originally selected by the Phillies in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

**Edmundo Sosa** signed with the Cardinals as an international free agent (July 2, 2012)...played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2018-22)... traded to Phillies for **JoJo Romero** (July 30, 2022).

**Brant Brown** enjoyed a three-homer game on June 18, 1998 vs. the Phillies at Wrigley Field.

**Michael Siani** was born in and resides in Glenside, Pa...graduated from William Penn Charter School in Philadelphia... same high school as Phillies broadcaster **Ruben Amaro**.

Cardinals Baseball Operations Advisor **Chaim Bloom** was born in Philadelphia...graduated from Jack M. Barrack Hebrew Academy.

**Nolan Arenado** is the last Cardinal to hit for the cycle (2nd career) on July 1, 2022 at Philadelphia...became the 17th in Cardinals history and first since **Mark Grudzielanek** in 2005.

Phillies Amateur Scouting Director **Brian Barber** was a 1st-round (#22) selection in the 1991 MLB draft by St. Louis from Dr. Phillips (Fla.) High School... same school as **Oliver Marmol**...pitched in 10 games for St. Louis (1995-96).

Phillies Bullpen catcher/Asst. Catching Coach **Brad Flanders** played two seasons (2003-04) at the University of Missouri...coached at Saint Louis University for three seasons (2011-13).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Bill White** played three seasons with Philadelphia (1966-68)...traded to the Phillies in 1965 and back to St. Louis in 1969.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Tom Herr** was born in nearby Lancaster, Pa. (April 4, 1956).

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** was originally selected by the Phillies in the 2nd round of the 1993 MLB draft ... Played parts of seven seasons with Philadelphia (1996-2002)...Traded to St. Louis with **Doug Nickle** & cash for **Placido Polanco**, **Bud Smith**, & **Mike Timlin** (July 29, 2002).

Phillies Visiting Clubhouse Manager **Kevin Steinhour** began his career as a batboy & clubhouse worker for Springfield (A) in the Cardinals organization (1981-87) before serving as Louisville Redbirds (AAA) Equipment Manager (1988-89).

Phillies Senior Advisor, International Scouting **Sal Agostinelli** was selected by St. Louis in the 20th round of the 1983 MLB draft ... played six seasons (1983-88) in the Cardinals minor league system.

Tonight's Game:

- Making his third start of the season as he makes his 33rd career start in his 141st career game.
- It's his 2nd home start of the season; gained 9-2 win on 3/30 vs. MIN (5.0 IP, 2 ER).
- Owns a 2-0 mark with 0.73 ERA (12.1 IP/1 ER) in two Friday starts over the past two season (2024-2025).**
- Is 9-5 with a 3.51 ERA (97.1 IP/38 ER) over 17 starts at Busch Stadium, winning each of his last 3 starts at home dating to 9/16/24
- A win tonight would give him 20 for his career & 13 as a starting pitcher.
- Since returning to the Cardinals starting rotation on May 26, 2024 he has led the team in wins (9, tied with Sonny Gray), qualifying ERA (3.58) and opponent BA (.231) in 22 starts.
- As a starting pitcher in 2024 was 8-7 with a 3.56 ERA over 20 starts after going 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine relief appearances in April.
- Ranked 3rd on the Cardinals with eight wins in 2024 while his 3.78 ERA was the lowest among the club's pitchers with 100 or more innings.
- Established single-season highs in wins (8), games started (20), innings pitched (121.1), strikeouts (94) and quality starts (7).
- Made his MLB debut 3 years ago yesterday on April 10, 2022 vs. Pittsburgh.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Started Game 1 of 4/6 doubleheader at BOS and limited the Red Sox to 2 runs over his 6.0 IP; Took a ND in the Cardinals 5-4 loss in 10 innings.

2024/Career Notes:

- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time (2022-2025).
- Utilized as a hybrid pitcher during his 2022 rookie season with 47 appearances and 10 starts. Led the Cardinals with 62 relief appearances in 2023. Began the 2024 season in the bullpen, was optioned on April 21, and returned to the rotation on May 26 finishing the season with 20 starts as one of the Cardinals most effective starters.
- Established single-season highs in wins (8), games started (20), innings pitched (121.1), strikeouts (94) and quality starts (7) in 2024.
- Since he started his career in 2022, has the 2nd-best ground ball percentage (66.6%) in MLB trailing only **Clay Holmes** (67.3%). min. 140 appearances.
- His first start came in his 18th career appearance, on June 4, 2022 at Chicago Cubs in the second game of a doubleheader. Threw 4.0 innings allowing one run in a no-decision the Cardinals rallied to win in extra innings (7-4).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since **Alan Benes** vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.
- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- The San Clemente, Calif. native was 4th round (125th player overall) draft selection in 2019 out of University California-Irvine.
- Graduated from San Clemente High School that also produced Cardinals 2021 1st round pick RHP Michael McGreevy and Braves 2015 1st round pick Kolby Allard.

Pallante vs. Phillies:

- Is making just his 2nd career start, and 1st since 7/10/22 at STL, against the Phillies tonight.
- Holds a career mark of 0-1, 7.45 ERA in six career games (1 start) against Philadelphia with all but one of those games coming here at Busch Stadium.
- Appeared in two games in relief against the Phillies last season (April 8 & April 10), allowing 2 runs on 3 hits in just 0.1 IP.
- The Cardinals have lost 5 of the 6 games he has appeared in against Philadelphia, with the lone win (4-3) coming in the game he started on July 10, 2022.
