RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their seven-game homestand tonight with the opener of a three-game series with the division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates at Busch Stadium ... The Redbirds opened their homestand by splitting a four-game weekend series with the Colorado Rockies ... St. Louis has alternated wins and losses over a season-high six games since June 4 (L-W-L-W-L-W).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today one percentage point behind Chicago (32-34) and Cincinnati (32-34) in 4th place in the NL Central, 7.0 games behind Milwaukee, and a half game back in the National League Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12-present), the Cardinals hold MLB's 4th-best winning pct. (.640, 16-9 record).

AHOY, MATEY: Tonight is the latest in the regular season (excluding 2020) that the Cards and Bucs have begun a season series since June 22, 1992.

BURIED TREASURE: St. Louis has won the season series over Pittsburgh in 20 of the last 24 years since 2000 (excluding 2008, 2012, 2013, 2023), and owns MLB's best overall win pct. vs. the Pirates (.572, 111-83) dating back to 2013 when the two teams squared off in the Division Series.

CENTRAL CASTING: St. Louis has won five of its last six divisional games since beginning the season 0-6 (all vs. Milwaukee).

LOU GEHRIG MEMORIAL AWARD PRESENTATION: Paul Goldschmidt will be presented with the Lou Gehrig Memorial Award before the start of tonight's game ... The award is presented annually to Major Leaguer who best exemplifies the giving character of Lou Gehrig, on and off the field ... Goldschmidt is the 7th Cardinal to win the award, joining Stan Musial (1957), Ken Boyer (1964), Lou Brock (1977), Ozzie Smith (1989), Mark McGwire (1999), and Albert Pujols (2009).

FIFTH INNING FRENZY: St. Louis has allowed a league-leading 63 runs in the 5th inning of games, while only scoring 31 runs ... Its negative 32-run differential in the 5th frame is 2nd-worst in baseball (Rays -33) ... Miles Mikolas and Aaron Civale co-lead MLB with 16 runs allowed in the 5th.

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Michael Siani's younger brother, **Sammy Siani**, was selected by Pittsburgh with the 37th overall pick in the 2019 MLB Draft and is an outfielder for Altoona (AA) in the Pirates organization.

Marco Gonzales pitched parts of three seasons in St. Louis (2014-15, '17)...was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#19) of 2013 MLB Draft...2014 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year...traded to Seattle for **Tyler O'Neill** (July 21, 2017).

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (SS).

Willson Contreras (June 17, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Sonny Gray** (July 10, 2013 at PNC Park), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC Park), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC Park), and **Drew Rom** (Aug. 21, 2023 at PNC Park) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

David Bednar was teammates of **Adam Wainwright**, **Miles Mikolas**, **Paul Goldschmidt**, and **Nolan Arenado** on Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Derek Shelton was born in Carbondale, Ill...caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** pitched for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58).

Johan Oviedo signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22)...traded to Pittsburgh with **Malcom Nunez** for **José Quintana** and **Chris Stratton** (Aug. 2, 2022).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60)...traded by Pittsburgh with **Ed Bauta** to St. Louis for **Dick Gray** and **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (May 28, 1960).

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 14th start of the season and his 164th career (192nd appearance).
- Needs 5.0 innings pitched for 1,000 career. Would become the 49th active pitcher in Major League Baseball with 1,000 innings pitched.
- All four wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, has a winning record on the road (31-28) and losing mark at Busch Stadium (23-25).
- Has thrown over 100 pitches in only one of his 12 starts (101 on May 1 at Detroit).
- The 62 pitches at Houston (6/5) for a 6.0-inning win. Was the 4th-fewest pitches in a start that equated to a win by a Cardinals pitcher since 1988 (Scott Terry 1989; Rene Arocha, 1993; Kent Mercker 1998 - all with 61 pitches).
- This season, has the 3rd-highest qualifying ERA (5.32) in the National League and 3rd-highest opponent BA (.277).
- 16 of his 42 runs allowed have come in the 5th inning, tying Tampa Bay's Aaron Civale for most in the 5th inning.
- In his 153 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 62-31 when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings (4-3 this season), while the Cardinals are 23-37 when he works 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 46-5 (.902 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 61-14 in those 75 games). He's just 8-48 (.143) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 24-55).
- His loss vs. Milwaukee (April 20, 2024) was his first ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 4th among Major League pitchers in fielding pct. (.990) since 2018.

- Making his 22nd career appearance/18th start vs the Pirates. Has appeared against the Pirates more than any other team in his career. Chicago and Cincinnati are second with 20. Tied with all three N.L. Central opponents with 18 starts.
- The Cardinals are 9-10 in his 19 appearances vs. Pittsburgh since 2018.
- Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason after being traded by San Diego with Jaff Decker to Pittsburgh in exchange for Alex Dickerson (Nov. 25, 2013). Then traded away to the Rangers for Chris McGuiness (Dec. 30, 2013).
- Has held the Pirates to three runs or less in 8 of his last 9 starts against, allowing four runs at PNC Park on Sept. 9, 2022, in an 8-2 Cardinals loss.

LAST TIME OUT

- Held the Astros to two runs on back-to-back solo home runs in the 5th inning in an efficient 4-2 win, tossing only 62 pitches over 6.0 innings.
- The 62 pitches in a start that equated to a win were the fewest of his career, and 4th fewest by a Cardinals pitcher in a win via start since 1988.

- Is 23-25 in his 74 starts at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal (St. Louis is 42-32).
- Ranks among Busch Stadium III rankings in starts (74, 6th), innings pitched (451.0, 7th), ERA (3.43, 6th), quality starts (42, 6th), and wins (23, T-5th).

CAREER

- St. Louis is 84-69 (.552) in his 152 career outings (153 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas trails only Clayton Kershaw (67.6%) with the 2nd-highest percentage of first pitch strikes in MLB with 67.4%.
- Has entered his 7th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (886.0), wins (53), strikeouts (650) and games started (150) for St. Louis; trailing only Lance Lynn in all categories.
- Two-time NL All-Star (2018 & 2022). Did not appear in 2022 at Dodger Stadium and chose to miss the 2018 game in Washington D.C. to be with his wife as they welcomed twins.
