INTER-TRIBAL YOUTH BASEBALL & SOFTBALL TOURNEY: The D-backs one-of-a-kind 25th Annual Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament presented by Talking Stick Resort, and generously supported by Resolution Copper and Nike, began at Salt River Fields at Talking Stick on Tuesday and concludes today.

- The only tournament of its kind in Major League Baseball brings emerging talent from rural tribal communities to the big stage as 1,100 athletes across 75 teams representing 20 tribes spanning across Arizona, New Mexico, California and Oklahoma compete over 4 days.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 2-1 vs. Braves on Wednesday, recording their third straight win for the first time since April 12-17 (5 straight wins).

- **Merrill Kelly** won his sixth game after tossing a season-best-tying 7.0 scoreless innings (including 5.2 no-hit innings) with 1 hit, 1 walk and 8 strikeouts...5.2 is his third-longest career no-hit bid.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** had a RBI single and 2 walks to extend his season-high 10-game hitting streak.
- **Ketel Marte** added a RBI single in the ninth inning and extended his season-high on-base streak to 17 straight games.
- **Gabriel Moreno** singled and extended his season-best-tying hitting streak to 7 straight games.
- **Justin Martinez** recorded his fifth save and second career 5-out save.

KELLY CLIMBS THE RANKS: **Merrill Kelly**'s 59th career win surpassed Curt Schilling (58) for third on the franchise's all-time list...only trails Randy Johnson (118) and Brandon Webb (87).

- His 5 career starts of 6.0+ innings with 1 hit or fewer are tied with Randy Johnson for second in club history, behind Zac Gallen (6).

PERFECT RUNNING MATES: **Merrill Kelly** (4.0 perfect innings on Wednesday) and **Zac Gallen** (3.1 perfect innings on Tuesday) became the first D-back duo to post 3.1+ perfect innings in consecutive games since Miguel Batista (3.1) and Curt Schilling (5.0) on May 28-29, 2002 @ Giants [Per Elias Sports Bureau].

GOOD PEN-MANSHIP: The D-backs bullpen has allowed 1 run in its last 16.1 innings since May 31, with 2 saves, a 0.55 ERA, 0.98 WHIP and 17 strikeouts.

VS. BRAVES: **Eugenio Suárez** has 6 homers in his last 7 games since July 10, 2024 and hit safely in 6 games, batting .435 (10-for-23)/1.866 OPS with 3 doubles, 6 homers, 9 RBI and 4 walks.

- **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 6 of his last 8 games since April 6, 2024 at a .355 clip (11-for-31)/1.219 OPS with 1 double, 4 homers, 7 RBI and 5 walks, including 4 multi-hit efforts.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has a 6-game hitting streak since July 9, 2024 at a .333 clip (7-for-21)/.798 OPS with 1 double, 4 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 9 of his last 10 games since April 6, 2024 at a .333 clip (11-for-35)/.395 OBP with 1 double, 4 RBI and 5 walks.

STREAKING SNAKES: **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in a season-best 17 straight games, hitting .318 (21-for-66)/1.111 OPS with 2 doubles, 7 homers, 12 RBI, 11 walks and 4 hit-by-pitches.

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has a season-high 10-game hitting streak, batting .395 (15-for-38)/.889 OPS with 2 doubles and 5 RBI, including 5 multi-hit efforts.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has a season-high-tying 7-game hitting streak, batting .370 (10-for-27)/.911 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 2 RBI.

WITH SNAKES ON BASE: Since May 1 (31 G) with runners on base, the D-backs rank second in the NL in AVG. (.278), OPS (.817), OBP (.346), SLG (.470), hits (126), homers (19), extra-base hits (46) and total bases (213).

- **Josh Naylor**, in his last 12 games with runners on base, is hitting .455 (10-for-22)/1.318 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 homers and 8 RBI.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, in his last 15 games with runners on base, is hitting .375 (9-for-24)/1.073 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 9 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno**, in his last 14 games with runners on base, is hitting .417 (10-for-24)/1.231 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Ketel Marte**, in his last 6 games with runners on base, is hitting .333 (3-for-9)/1.067 OPS with 1 homer, 4 RBI and 1 walk.

TRENDING ROAD BATS: **Ketel Marte** has a 9-game road hitting streak, batting .361 (13-for-36)/1.369 OPS with 2 doubles, 6 homers, 9 RBI and 5 walks...reached base in 10 straight road games.

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, in his last 16 road games, is hitting .377 (23-for-61)/1.000 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 6 walks, including a current 5 game hit streak.
- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 15 road games, is hitting .346 (18-for-52)/.939 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 12 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Eugenio Suárez**, in his last 10 road games, is hitting .308 (12-for-39)/.844 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer and 7 RBI.

IT STARTS UP TOP: From the 1-2 lineup spots, the D-backs lead the Majors in OPS (.905 OPS), SLG (.538) and extra-base hits (62).

- The D-backs' 1-3 batters combined .859 OPS, .500 SLG and 41 homers rank third in MLB, behind the Dodgers (.939/.559/49) and Yankees (.897/.525/43).

FANTASTIC 4: **Corbin Carroll**, at age 24, became the youngest D-back ever and fourth all-time to hit 18+ home runs in the team's first 60 games...is the first since Luis Gonzalez (22) in 2001 (also: Steve Finley, 20 in 2000 and Jay Bell, 18 in 1999).

ON DECK - CINCINNATI REDS: Tomorrow, the D-backs begin the second leg of their road trip with a 3-game series @ Reds.

- The D-backs are 8-2 in their last 10 games vs. Reds, since Aug. 24, 2023.
- Last season, the D-backs took the season series 5-1, including a 3-0 sweep @ Reds from May 7-9, 2024.
