NEW YORK METS (43-44) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (42-46)

July 7, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 1:35 EDT - GAME #89/HOME #45

LHP SEAN MANAEA (5-3, 3.67 ERA) vs. RHP LUIS ORTIZ (4-2, 3.27 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...lost 5-2 yesterday afternoon...Scored a season-high 14 runs while hitting a club record-tying seven home runs Friday night...Have gone 15-14, including 10-7 at home, in one-run games...Have won 10 games in their last at-bat, matching their total from all of 2023 (the team won 13 games in the final at-bat of 2022)...Have gone 32-3 (.914 winning percentage) when outhitting their opponents this season...Have not been shut out in 33 straight games, which is tied for the seventh-longest active streak in MLB (the Cardinals have the longest active streak at 66 games)...Have recorded an extra base hit in a season-high 20 straight games.

ALL-STARS AMONG US: Tonight at 5:30 on ESPN, the balance of the All-Star rosters will be announced during the All-Star Selection Show...Last year the Pirates were represented at the All-Star Game by Mitch Keller and David Bednar, while Derek Shelton served as a coach for the National League...Denny Neagle represented the Pirates the last time the Rangers hosted the All-Star Game in 1995...Pirates assistant athletic trainer Tony Leo will serve as a trainer for this year's All-Star Game...Leo is in his fourth season as a member of the Pirates and 28th overall in professional baseball.

EVERYDAY BRYAN: Bryan Reynolds has started each of the first 88 games of this season...That's the longest streak by a Pirate since Josh Bell started each of the first 89 games of the 2018 campaign...Prior to Bell, the last Pirate to start more than 89 games to begin a season was Jason Bay in 2006 (118 games).

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Luis Ortiz gets the start this afternoon in game three of this series against the Mets...Today is Ortiz' 24th appearance of the season and second start...Coming into today, he ranks fifth in all of MLB among relievers in innings pitched (49.0) behind Ryan Yarbrough (55.0), Derek Law (51.2), Bryce Jarvis (50.2) and Luke Weaver (49.2).

SUCCESSION OF SOUTHPAWS: This is the second straight day and 29th time this season the Pirates will be opposed by a left-handed starter (the Bucs are 13-15 in games started by opposing lefties)...Ke'Bryan Hayes ranks third among all National League players in batting average (.350) against lefties, 10th in slugging (.567) and sixth in OBP (.423) and OPS (.989).

SHORT HOPS: Oneil Cruz has gone deep 13 times this season, which is tied for the fourth-most among all National League shortstops behind Elly De La Cruz (15), Francisco Lindor (15) and CJ Abrams (14)...On Saturday, Cruz hit his 31st home run as a shortstop, which ranks ninth in Pirates history at that position...Dale Berra ranks eighth all-time among Pirates shortstops in home runs (37) while Arky Vaughan is first (84).

CLEARING THE DECK: The Pirates have gone deep in 10 consecutive games at PNC Park, hitting a total of 17 home runs during that time...It's the longest home run streak at PNC Park since 2017 when the team went deep in 12 straight games from August 4-23...Since June 18, the Pirates have also gone deep in 14 of their 16 games...Pittsburgh's 24 home runs since June 18 are tied for the seventh-most in all of MLB (the Orioles and Mets lead the way in that time with 30 apiece).

HOT ROWD: Rowdy Tellez comes into today one home run shy of 100 in his career...Tellez has gone deep four times in his last six games and five times in his last nine contests...Since June 16, Tellez ranks ninth in the National League in batting (.345), seventh in slugging (.673) and 11th in OPS (1.052).

B-REY AND BOBBY BO: Bryan Reynolds is tied with Bobby Bonilla for the most home runs (114) in Pirates history among switch hitters...That's also tied for 17th overall in Pirates history...Reynolds is now two home runs shy of tying Andy Van Slyke and Dick Stuart for 15th place in team history in home runs (117).

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen's double on Wednesday moved him into sole possession of sixth place for the most career extra base hits (591) in Pirates history...He is now one extra base hit shy of tying Pie Traynor for the fifth-most in team history...McCutchen also ranks fifth on the team's all-time walks list (797)...The only four Pirates with more career walks are Willie Stargell (937), Max Carey (919), Paul Waner (912) and Honus Wagner (877).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

July 7, 1957: Frank Thomas and Dick Groat became the first set of teammates in Major League history to homer back-to-back in both games of a doubleheader, as the Pirates defeated the New York Giants by a score of 10-6 in game one and 8-1 in game two. Thomas had four hits and five RBI on the day, and Groat contributed with four hits and six RBI. Bob Friend threw a four-hit complete game and struck out seven in game two.

TODAY'S STARTER **RHP LUIS ORTIZ** **#48**

2024 RECORD: 4-2, 1 SAVE, 3.27 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-2/240 **BATS/THROWS:** R/R
BORN: January 27, 1999
AGE: 25 **SIGNED:** Thru 2024
HOW ACQUIRED: Signed by Pittsburgh as a non-drafted free agent on Oct. 2, 2018

STARTING OFF: The 25-year-old righthander is in his third Major League season, all with the Pirates...Entering today, he's made 45 career appearances (20 starts) for the Bucs, including 23 relief appearances in 2024 (one start)...He made the first Opening Day roster of his career with the Pirates in 2024 after making just two appearances (both starts) with the club in 2022 and 18 appearances (15 starts) over two stints with the Bucs in 2023...Ortiz was signed by the Pirates as an international free agent on October 2, 2018. He is one of four players to come up through the Pirates' Dominican Academy and reach the Major Leagues with the club, joining RHP Yerry De Los Santos, RHP Osvaldo Bido and INF Rodolfo Castro.

LIKE RIDING A BIKE: Today will be Ortiz' 21st career Major League start and his second of the season, having last took the mound in a starter's role on June 26 at Cincinnati (W, 1 ER in 6.0 IP, 7 K, 0 BB)...Served in the bulk role following Carmen Mldozinski "opening" for the Bucs three times this season...Ortiz threw 4.1 shutout frames on June 8 vs. Minnesota, allowed one run in 5.0 IP on June 14 at Colorado and allowed 6 earned runs in 4.0 innings pitched on June 21 vs. Tampa Bay.

- Has posted a 3-1 record with a 3.00 ERA (9 ER in 27.0 IP) in his last five starts since September 4, 2023, allowing two runs or fewer in four of those games and one run in three of them.
- Ortiz was a starter in 19 of his first 22 career Major League games with the Bucs from 2022-23 before primarily pitching out of the bullpen this season.
- He started 67 of his 72 appearances in the Minor Leagues from 2019-2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Ortiz allowed two runs on three hits over 2.0 innings with four strikeouts in a relief outing on July 2 vs. St. Louis.

EFFECTIVE WORK: In 17 games (one start) since April 20, Ortiz has gone 3-1 with one save, a 2.96 ERA (15 ER in 45.2 IP) and 42 strikeouts against 12 walks.

- Has pitched more than 1.0 inning in 15 of those 17 games.

VS. NEW YORK: Ortiz made his lone career outing against the Mets on April 16 of this season at Citi Field, taking the loss after he surrendered three runs on two hits in 1.2 innings of work.

SHUTTING IT DOWN: Ortiz earned the first save of his big league career on June 1 at Toronto, facing a total of 10 batters in 3.0 scoreless innings while throwing 36 pitches.

DAY MAN: Ortiz will be making his 15th appearance of the season in a day game today (second start), where he has posted a 3-1 record with a 1.35 ERA (5 ER in 33.1 IP) and .174 opponents average.

2023 RECAP: Ortiz had two different stints with the Pirates last season, going 4-5 with a 4.93 ERA (40 ER in 73.0 IP) in his 15 starts and 1-0 with a 3.95 ERA (6 ER in 13.2 IP) in three relief appearances.

- Pitched with the Dominican Republic team in the World Baseball Classic, making one appearance and striking out three batters in 2.0 scoreless innings.

ON DECK: The 28-year-old Keller will make his 18th start of the season tomorrow in the finale of this four-game series against the Mets...Allowed a season-high six runs in 5.0 innings while losing a 7-4 decision in his last start on Tuesday against the Cardinals...Has made 48 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings, which is the longest active streak in MLB...Has gone 4-2 with a 3.02 ERA (50.2ip/17er) in eight starts this season at home...Is tied for fourth in the National League in wins (nine) and tied for 10th in innings pitched (103.1)...Was named to the National League All-Star team last year for the first time in his career.
