CHICAGO WHITE SOX (34-65) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (39-60) July 20, 2025 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 1:35 EDT - Game #100/Home #50 RHP Aaron Civale (1-6, 5.30 ERA) vs. LHP Andrew Heaney (4-8, 4.59 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have dropped the first two games of this nine-game homestand...Will host the White Sox for one more game before welcoming Detroit (Monday-Wednesday) and Arizona (July 25-27) to PNC Park to conclude the homestand...Are in a stretch of 15 consecutive games against American League teams, including 12 straight games against the American League Central...Have gone 26-23 at home...Are 27-34 since Don Kelly made his managerial debut on May 9 vs. Atlanta.

FULL HOUSE: Saturday's attendance of 38,041 marked Pittsburgh's third sellout (also April 4 vs. New York-AL and April 19 vs. Cleveland) and the largest home crowd of 2025...It was the third crowd of at least 35,000 for a game vs. the White Sox since PNC Park opened in 2001...A total of 39,167 attended the Pirates' Home Opener on April 7, 2023, while 36,610 came on June 16, 2007.

TIGER TALES: The Pirates will continue their season-high-tying nine-game homestand with the beginning of a three-game series against Detroit tomorrow night...Pittsburgh dropped two of three games at Comerica Park from June 17-19...This will mark the first three-game series against the Tigers here at PNC Park since September 6-8, 2021, when the Pirates won two of three games.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Andrew Heaney gets the start this afternoon in the finale of this three-game series against the White Sox...Heaney has posted a 2.53 ERA (46.1ip/13er) in eight home starts this season...That's the 12th-lowest home ERA in the National League among those with at least 46.0 innings pitched at home this season.

ANCHOR DOWN: Bryan Reynolds went 3-for-5 with a double and a run scored on Saturday vs. Chicago (AL)...He has doubled in three consecutive games (since July 13 at Minnesota) for the third time this season (also June 22-24 and June 27-29)...He has not doubled in at least four straight games since April 27-May 3, 2023, when he doubled in a career-high six consecutive contests...Reynolds has gone 20-for-60 (.333) with two doubles, a triple, two home runs and 14 RBI in 16 career games against the White Sox.

CRUZING ALONG: Oneil Cruz tripled off the White Sox' Adrian Houser to lead off the bottom of the second inning of Saturday night's game, extending his hitting streak to

a season-high seven straight games, dating back to July 8 at Kansas City...His only career hitting streaks of longer than seven games were an 11-game streak from August 20-31, 2024 and an eight-game streak from May 5-14, 2024...During his current hitting streak, Cruz has gone 9-for-24 (.375) with a double, a triple, a home run, three RBI, a walk, two stolen bases and two runs scored.

SUPER SHORTSTOP: Isiah Kiner-Falefa went 2-for-4 with an RBI on Saturday vs. Chicago (AL)...Kiner-Falefa has seven hits over his last three games (since July 13 at Minnesota)...Across his last 16 games (since June 27 vs. New York-NL), he is batting .308 (16-

for-52) with two doubles, six RBI and three stolen bases...Kiner-Falefa's .308 batting average during that stretch is tied with Atlanta's Austin Riley for the 12th-best average among all players in the National League (min. 50 at-bats).

**SLICK NICK:** Nick Gonzales was 3-for-5 with a double, an RBI and a run scored on Saturday night vs. the White Sox, giving him his fourth game with at least three hits this season (also June 19 [G2] at Detroit, June 23 at Milwaukee and July 4 at Seattle)...Gonzales' four games with at least three hits since June 19 are tied for the fifth-most in all of Major League Baseball during that stretch.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen's next hit will tie him with National Baseball Hall of Famer Willie Stargell for 180th place (2232) in Major League history...McCutchen has recorded 1,746 of those hits with Pittsburgh, the ninth-most in franchise history (Roberto Clemente, 3000, ranks first)...McCutchen's 2231 hits are the third-most among all active Major League players, behind only Freddie Freeman (2362) and Jose Altuve (2334).

# **ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY**

July 20, 2002: Adam Hyzdu hit two home runs while recording a career-high seven RBI, as the Pirates beat the Cardinals, 15-6, at PNC Park. Just one night earlier, Hyzdu homered and knocked in four runs in a 12-9 win over St. Louis. Hyzdu became one of just three Pirates since at least 1901 with 11 RBI in a two-game span, joining Ralph Kiner in 1950 and Honus Wagner in 1901.

#### LHP ANDREW HEANEY TODAY'S STARTER

**BORN:** June 5, 1991

**AGE:** 34 SIGNED: Thru 2025 HOW ACQUIRED: Signed as a free agent on February 22, 2025.

STARTING OFF: The 34-year-old southpaw is in his 12th Major League season...He signed a one-year contract with Pittsburgh on February 22 after spending each of the previous two years with Texas...Was Los Angeles (AL)'s nominee in both 2018 and 2019 for the distinguished Roberto Clemente Award for his community involvement.

AS A RELIEVER: Heaney pitched 2.0 innings in relief on July 12 at Minnesota, allowing three runs on three solo homers (Matt Wallner, Byron Buxton, Willi Castro)...It was his first outing out of the bullpen since May 28, 2024 vs. Arizona, while he was with Texas.

**IN HIS LAST START:** Heaney allowed four runs in 3.0 innings on July 7 at Kansas City, losing a 9-3 decision (his shortest start since going 1.1 innings on August 12, 2023).

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Heaney is 5-1 with a 4.31 ERA (56.1ip/27er) in 10 career starts against Chicago (the five wins are his most against any opponent)...Since allowing seven runs in back-to-back starts against the White Sox on April 2, 2021 and August 12, 2021, he has a 1.62 ERA (16.2ip/3er) in his last three starts against Chicago.

**CASHING IN AT PNC:** Heaney will make his ninth start this season at PNC Park this afternoon...He is 3-2 with a 2.53 ERA (46.1ip/13er) through his first eight starts...In his last four starts here (since May 10 vs. Atlanta), Heaney has a 1.52 ERA (23.2ip/4er).

HERE'S THE PITCH: Heaney is averaging 16.2 pitches per inning this season...It's his best rate since averaging 15.3 pitches per inning in 2018, as a member of the Angels.

**CLOSE CALLS:** The Pirates have played in six one-run games over Heaney's first 18 starts of the season...Heaney has pitched to a 1.93 ERA (37.1ip/8er) in those six starts.

**THANKS FOR YOUR SUPPORT:** Heaney received a season-high seven runs of support in his start on June 30 vs. St. Louis (most since receiving 11 runs of support on June 30, 2024 at Baltimore, while he was with Texas)...He received a combined four runs of support while in the game in his prior four outings (since June 7 vs. Philadelphia).

AND THE WHIFF: Heaney struck out each of the first six batters he faced in his start on April 23 in Anaheim against the Angels, becoming the first Pirates lefthander to strike out at least six straight batters since Francisco Liriano on June 1, 2013 vs. Cincinnati (seven straight)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, Heaney and Paul Skenes (May 17, 2024 at Wrigley Field vs. the Cubs) are the only Pittsburgh pitchers in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to strike out six or more straight batters to begin a game...In that outing, according to Elias, he also became the first Pirates southpaw ever to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings and nine strikeouts while allowing one hit or fewer and zero walks.

**SIGN HERE, PLEASE:** Heaney signed a one-year contract with the Pirates on February 22...He posted a 5-14 record, 4.28 ERA (160.0ip/76er) and 159 strikeouts in 32 games (31 starts) with Texas in 2024...Heaney's 159 strikeouts and 160.0 innings pitched both ranked second on the Rangers, trailing Nathan Eovaldi (166 strikeouts & 70.2 innings).

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS: Heaney spent the 2023 campaign as a member of the World-Champion Rangers, where he posted a career-high 10 wins...His 9.22 strikeouts per 9.0 innings figure was the highest ever by a left-handed Texas starting pitcher in a season (min. 15 starts)...He finished the year 13th among American League pitchers (min. 140.0ip) in Ks/9.0 innings (9.22) and 19th in strikeout percentage (23.6 percent).
