RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a brief three-game road trip in Cleveland (1-0) tonight at Progressive Field...following an off day Thursday, will host the Giants and Blue Jays for a six-game homestand from May 1-6, which commences 13 straight games without an off day...have won five consecutive games, the longest active streak in the majors, to improve to a season-high six games above .500 for the first time since July 10, 2025 (50-44)...were last seven games over on July 9, 2025 (50-43)...are an AL-best 15-6 (.714) in their last 21 games since April 4, second in the majors behind the Padres (17-4/.810), on the heels of a 2-5 start...are 7-2 in their last nine road games since losing five of their first seven...have gone 9-4 on a stretch of 27 games in 29 days from April 14-May 13, with off days coming on April 23 and 30...are 1.5 GB behind the Yankees for first place in the AL East...could enter May leading the division for the fifth time, which would join 2023, 2019, 2012, and 2010...have spent six days in first, 14 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth, including 14 straight days in first or second.

* **Ryan Vilade** hit a go-ahead, two-run single in the 8th inning and **Bryan Baker** worked a scoreless 9th to earn his seventh save in a 3-2 victory last night...it was the Rays first win when trailing entering the 8th since Sept. 13, 2025 at CHC (trailed 4-3, won 5-4) and their eighth comeback victory this season, tying the Blue Jays and Orioles for the most in the AL.

* They have won five straight one-run games since a 6-5 loss on March 28 at STL, their longest streak since Aug. 16-27, 2024 (5G)...their last longer streak was May 15-June 2, 2024 (6G).

* With the win, the Rays have recorded multiple winning streaks of five games or more before the calendar flips to May for the fourth time, joining 2023 (13, 6), 2019 (5, 5), and 2010 (7, 5)...they won six straight games from April 10-16...no other club has multiple such streaks this season.

* The Rays have outscored opponents, 25-8 (+17), during their current winning streak, yielding two runs or fewer in five consecutive games for the first time since June 3 (G2)-8, 2023 (6G) while holding opponents to 2-for-24 (.083) with RISP...the eight runs are the fewest they have permitted over any five-game span since May 24-28, 2025 (7R).

* Rays starters have turned in a 1.27 ERA (28.1IP, 4ER) during the streak to lower their season-long mark from 4.22 to 3.62, second in the AL to the MLB-leading Yankees (2.80).

* The Rays have homered in six consecutive games for the first time since Aug. 27-Sept. 2, 2025 (6G)...they haven't had a longer streak since June 26-July 2, 2025 (7G)...they have connected on 9 HR during the streak compared to 7 HR in their previous 12 games (April 7-20).

* With a win tonight, the Rays would claim their first series victory over the Guardians since July 12-14, 2024 at Tropicana Field and first at Progressive Field since July 22-25, 2021 (0-3-1 in last 4)...they would also secure series wins in each of their first five sets vs. AL opponents for the first time in franchise history.

VILADE PARADE—After recording his third career go-ahead RBI last night and first in the 7th inning or later, **Ryan Vilade** is 11-for-24 (.458) with 2 2B, 5 RBI, 2 BB, and 2 SO in his last 10 games since April 7, the majors' second-best average in that span (min. 20AB) to **CHC Moises Ballesteros** (.500)...he has hit safely in a career-high-tying three straight games (3x, last: April 7-14, 2026)...his 11 hits on the year surpassed his career total (9) entering the season, while his 5 RBI match his career total coming into the year (28G).

* Min. 30 AB, Vilade's .344 (11-for-32) average is third highest by a Rays batter through his first 15 games with the franchise over the last 11 seasons (2016-26), trailing **Eric Sogard** (.348) in 2019 and **Mallex Smith** (.348) in 2017.

ALL-AMERICAN—The Rays are the seventh team to win 12 of their first 13 games vs. AL opponents, joining Milwaukee in 1987 (13-0), Detroit in 1984 and 1911 (both 12-1), Oakland in 1981 (12-1), and both Cleveland (12-1) and Baltimore (12-1) in 1966...both the Tigers and Orioles went on to win the World Series in those seasons...six NL clubs have won 12 of their first 13 intraleague contests in the modern era (since 1900), most recently the Braves (12-1) in 2013...with a win tonight, the Rays would match **Milwaukee in 1987**, **Detroit in 1984**, **Oakland in 1981**, and **Cleveland in 1966** (all 13-1) for the best start vs. the AL in league history.

* The Rays have won a franchise-record 12 straight games vs. AL competition since a 10-4 loss on April 3 at MIN, surpassing a 10-game run from March 30-April 13, 2023...it marks the longest streak in the majors since the Brewers (12G) from June 18-Aug. 24, 2024 and longest by an AL team since the Twins (12G) from April 22-May 4, 2024...the last longer streak was Cleveland's MLB-record 22-game run from Aug. 24-Sept. 14, 2017.

* The Rays have won nine straight games over AL Central opponents, tied for the longest streak in franchise history, matching March 30-April 29, 2023 and June 29-July 11, 2013.

* **Yandy Diaz** has an active 13-game on-base streak vs. AL teams, the longest season-opening run by a Ray since himself in 2020 (19G).

ALL ABOUT THAT BASE—After drawing a pair of walks last night, **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely 53 times, surpassing **Tommy Pham** (52, 2019) for the most TOB during March/April in Rays history...he has reached in 22 of his last 23 games and 26 of 28 games overall this season...Diaz's 35 hits are tied for third in the AL and are fifth most by a Ray before the calendar flips to May, trailing **Rocco Baldelli** (40) in 2003, **Quinton McCracken** (39) and **Fred McGriff** (37) in 1998, and **Randy Arozarena** (36) in 2023.

* Diaz is one extra-base hit shy of 300 for his career and 283 with the Rays, which would tie **Carlos Peña** for seventh most in franchise history...he needs 1 HR to tie **Carl Crawford** (104HR) for seventh on the Rays all-time list.

* He has 992 hits in his career, eight shy of becoming the 20th Cuban-born player in major league history to tally 1,000 hits.

IONNY BE GOOD—**Jonathan Aranda** has driven in eight runs over his last six games to bring his season total to 24 RBI, second in the AL to **HOU Yordan Alvarez** (26) and tied with four others for third most by a Ray in March/April, trailing **Randy Arozarena** in 2023 (28) and **Ben Zobrist** (25) in 2011...an AL-most 21 of those 23 RBI have come against right-handed pitching, third in the majors to **CIN Sal Stewart** (27) and **MIA Liam Hicks** (24).

FROM THE LAND DOWN UNDER—Earlier today, the Guardians selected **INF Travis Bazzana** from Triple-A Columbus, the No. 1 overall selection in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft, from Triple-A Columbus for his major league debut...Bazzana could become the second No. 1 overall pick to debut against the Rays, joining **BAL Adley Rutschman** (2019 Draft) on May 21, 2022 at Oriole Park...Rutschman tripled in that contest, but the Rays won, 6-1, after a two-homer effort by **Randy Arozarena**.

AT THE CORNER—The Rays and Guardians continue a six-game season series tonight, with the clubs reconvening from July 24-26 at Tropicana Field in Tampa Bay's first home set following the All-Star break...the Rays lost five of seven matchups in 2025, with three of the five setbacks coming by one run...it was their first season series defeat since 2022 (4-2), but they are still 4-2-1 in the last seven season sets since 2018 (clubs did not meet in 2020)...their .390 (39-61) winning pct. at Progressive Field is their second-worst in any current AL venue, better than only Texas' Globe Life Field (.250/4-12).

* Rays pitchers have yielded 3 ER or fewer in a franchise-record nine straight games vs. CLE (Sept. 15, 2024-pres.) their fourth-longest streak against a single opponent in club history, trailing runs against the Astros (18G - 2013-16), Angels (12G - 2011-12), Blue Jays (10G - 2012), and Mariners (10G - 2012)...their 2.26 ERA (79.2IP, 20ER) against the Guardians in that span is the best by any AL team...the starting rotation has a 1.57 ERA (23.0IP, 4ER) over the last five meetings.

* Since his tenure with the Rays began in 2019, **Yandy Diaz** has hit .321 (19-for-53) with 8 XBH, 6 BB, 5 SO and a .994 OPS in 14 games at Progressive Field, his home ballpark over his first two major league seasons (2017-18)...he has reached base safely in nine straight games at CLE.

* Guardians manager **Steven Vogt** is one of seven former Rays players to manage a major league club, appearing in 18 games with Tampa Bay during his first MLB season in 2012...he is joined by **Kevin Cash**, **MIN Rocco Baldelli**, **WSH Dave Martinez**, **PHI/SF Gabe Kapler**, **NYM Mickey Callaway**, and **CWS/MIA Ozzie Guillen**.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY!—**Shane McClellan** is celebrating his 29th birthday today.

SCORING CHANGE—This morning, MLB announced an official scoring change from the Rays 6-1 loss on April 20 vs. CIN...in the top of the 3rd inning, CIN **Matt McLain** reached on what was originally ruled a fielder's choice, which has been changed to a single.

TONIGHT'S START—Nick Martinez will make his sixth start with the Rays and fourth on the road today against Cleveland...marks his 135th career start and seventh opposite the Guardians...is seeking a team-high fourth quality start of the season...enters his ninth major league season and first with the Rays...signed as a free agent on Feb. 10, 2026.

- ✦ He is one of nine MLB starters age 35 or older to allow six earned runs or fewer in at least five starts this season.
- ✦ Among qualified AL starters, Martinez's .196 opp. batting average against right-handed batters ranks 15th.

LAST TIME OUT—Earned his first win of the season after tying a career high with 8.0 innings of one-run ball on five hits and one walk with six strikeouts in a 6-1 win over the Reds on April 22 at Tropicana Field...allowed a single to lead off the game but proceeded to set down nine batters in a row before allowing another hit in the 4th inning...the lone run came in the 5th inning, when baserunners reached base with a single-double-walk sequence that allowed P.J. Higgins to plate Cincinnati's lone run with a sacrifice fly... after working out of the 5th, Martinez yielded one more single in the following frame before retiring his final eight batters faced...tossed a season-high 95 pitches, his most since throwing 104 pitches on Aug. 26, 2025 at LAD.

- ✦ Martinez has pitched 4.0 innings or more and allowed two earned runs or fewer in each of his first five starts to begin the season, the first Ray to accomplish the feat since Shane McClellan did so in his first eight starts of the 2023 season...is one of four to turn the trick in Rays history, joining McClellan, Tyler Glasnow (7 starts), and Matt Moore (5 starts).
- ✦ Martinez's 2.10 ERA (30.0IP, 7ER) through his first five starts is the lowest he has posted through his first five starts of a season since his 0.84 ERA (32.0IP, 3ER)

CLEVELAND, THIS IS FOR YOU—The veteran right-hander is 1-2 with a 8.56 ERA (13.2IP, 13ER) and 12 strikeouts in six career appearances (two starts) opposite the Guardians...in his last start against Cleveland, on May 17, 2015, he went 5.0 innings, allowing one earned run on five hits, five walks, and one hit batter with six strikeouts in a 5-1 win while with the Rangers.

- ✦ Martinez is 7-9 with a 5.34 ERA (113.0IP, 67ER) and 99 strikeouts in 22 career starts vs. AL Central opponents.
- ✦ Over his last seven road starts, dating back to July 19, 2025 at NYM (w/ CIN), he has gone 2-2 with a 2.88 ERA (40.2IP, 13ER) with 29 strikeouts...has pitched 5.0 innings or more and allowed two earned runs or fewer in six of the seven outings, with his teams going 4-3 in those games.

OFFSPEED MAGIC—Per Baseball Savant, Martinez's Offspeed Run Value (4) ranks in the 99th percentile among qualified pitchers in 2026...he had a Run Value of -2 on offspeed pitches last year, down from 2024 (7) and 2023 (career-high 14)...his 3 Run Value on the changeup in 2026 is the highest in the majors (min. 100 changeups), throwing the pitch a total of 121 times through his first five starts...among AL arms in 2026 (min. 250 pitches), Martinez's .116 xBA (2-for-28) on offspeed pitches is the sixth lowest in the circuit...since the start of 2024, Martinez's 20.7 pct. hard-hit rate on offspeed pitches is the lowest in the majors (min. 200 BF).

NO FREE 90S—Since the start of 2024, Martinez has issued only 68 walks, good for the sixth lowest walks per 9.0 IP (1.81) mark in the majors (min. 250.0IP) during that stretch...the veteran right-hander trails only SEA Bryan Woo (1.44), SEA George Kirby (1.54), DET Tarik Skubal (1.57), CHC Shota Imanaga (1.61), and WSH Zack Littell (1.74) during that span...as exclusively a starter, Martinez's 56 walks are the second fewest in the majors during that stretch (also: Woo).

SOFT CONTACT KING—Among qualified pitchers last season, Martinez's 34.5 pct. hard-hit rate tied MIL Freddy Peralta for the fifth lowest in the majors, higher than only HOU Hunter Brown (32.2%), DET Tarik Skubal (33.0%), CIN Andrew Abbott (33.7%), and LAA Kyle Hendricks (34.3%).

- ✦ He also ranked fourth among qualified AL pitchers in barrel pct. (6.9%) behind only Brown (5.9%), ATH Luis Severino (6.0%), and HOU Framber Valdez (6.7%).

CAREER RUNDOWN—In 2024, set career marks in ERA (3.10), bWAR (4.0), WHIP (1.03), strikeouts (116), strikeout rate (23.0%), walk rate (3.2%), opp. average (.237), FIP (3.21), barrel rate (5.1%), and chase rate (33.9%) in his first season with the Reds... received the Johnny Vander Meer Award from the Cincinnati chapter of the BBWAA as the Reds most outstanding pitcher.

- ✦ In 2023, paced the Padres staff with a career-high 63 appearances and recorded the highest strikeout (23.0%) and whiff (28.6%) rates of his career...also held opponents to a career-best .354 slugging pct.
- ✦ Returned to the majors in 2022 after signing a one-year deal with the Padres March 16...made 47 appearances, including 10 starts, and became the first pitcher since holds became an official statistic in 1986 to record a season with four holds or more, eight saves or more, and 10 starts or more.
- ✦ Played his final season overseas in 2021...signed with the Fukoka Softbank Hawks in January and went 9-4 with a 1.60 ERA (140.2IP, 25ER) and 138 SO over 23 starts...led the club and ranked fourth in the Japan Pacific League in strikeouts...min. 100.0 IP, the only JPL pitcher with a lower ERA was Yoshinobu Yamamoto (1.39).
- ✦ Missed the 2019 season due to a right forearm strain...returned to action midway through the 2020 campaign, making 17 appearances for the Nippon-Ham Fighters (NPB).
- ✦ In 2018, started 25 games for the Nippon-Ham Fighters, tied for most on the club...also ranked second on the team in strikeouts (93) and innings pitched (161.2) and threw three complete games.
- ✦ Spent the 2011-17 seasons in the Rangers organization, pitching to a 35-23 record with a 3.28 ERA (510.2IP, 186ER) across 107 minor league appearances (87 starts).
