## BALTIMORE ORIOLES (3-5) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (5-3)

April 5, 2026 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 1:35 EDT - Game #9/Home #3

RHP Chris Bassitt (0-1, 8.31 ERA) vs. RHP Braxton Ashcraft (0-1, 3.00 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:** won their fourth consecutive game with Saturday afternoon's 3-2, walkoff victory against Baltimore...Are seeking their first five-game winning streak since last season from July 26-30...Are looking to win each of their first three home games of the season for the first time since April 7-9, 2017 (they swept Atlanta in three games).

**CHECKING THE BROOM CLOSET:** Pittsburgh would complete its first-ever three-game sweep of Baltimore with a win today (the Pirates swept the O's in a two-game series from September 26-27, 2017 at PNC Park)...Pittsburgh swept seven series in 2025, including three-game sweeps of postseason teams in Philadelphia (June 6-8), Detroit (July 21-23) & Los Angeles-NL (Sept. 2-4).

**ONE-RUN FUN:** Pittsburgh and Baltimore have had seven straight games decided by one run, dating back to April 6, 2024...Per OptaStats, that is the Major League record for consecutive one-run games between any two interleague opponents (since 1997).

**BUCS FROM BEHIND:** Nick Yorke recorded his first career walkoff RBI with Saturday's game-ending double (off Ryan Helsley) that scored Bryan Reynolds in the ninth inning...It was Pittsburgh's first win when trailing after seven innings this season after going 4-75 in such situations during the 2025 season (that last happened last year in a 5-1 win on September 13 at Washington).

**A HOP IN OUR STEP:** Today's game marks the fourth time in the last five seasons that Pittsburgh is spending Easter Sunday here at PNC Park...The Pirates lost, 5-4, in 10 innings last year on April 20 vs. Cleveland...Pittsburgh defeated Chicago (AL), 1-0, on April 9, 2023 and Washington, 5-3, on April 17, 2022...The Pirates beat Miami, 9-7, in 10 innings on March 31, 2024 at loanDepot park.

**ON DECK:** Pittsburgh will continue its first homestand with a three-game series from Monday-Wednesday vs. San Diego...The Pirates have dropped six straight games against the Padres at PNC Park since sweeping a three-game set from June 27-29, 2023.

**LOVING LEFTIES:** Oneil Cruz led off the bottom of the seventh inning of Saturday's win vs. Baltimore with a single off left-handed reliever Grant Wolfram...He is hitting 6-for-8 (.750) with two home runs and four RBI against left-handed pitching this season...Cruz, who was just 11-for-108 (.102) against southpaws last year, did not post his sixth hit against a left-handed pitcher until May 24 vs. Milwaukee (was a triple off Tyler Alexander).

**FEELING BULLISH:** Hunter Barco (2.1ip), Isaac Mattson (1.0ip) and Dennis Santana (1.0ip) combined to allow one hit over 4.1 scoreless innings of relief during Pittsburgh's 3-2, walkoff win on Saturday vs. Baltimore...The bullpen's 2.60 ERA (27.2ip/8er) over the team's last seven games (since March 28 at New York-NL) ranks seventh in Major League Baseball...The bullpen's 35 strikeouts over that same stretch rank fifth in the entire league.

**O'YEAH:** Ryan O'Hearn singled in the fourth inning and was intentionally walked in the ninth inning of Saturday's 3-2, walkoff win vs. Baltimore...He and Nick Gonzales have both reached base safely in each of their first seven games of the 2026 campaign (O'Hearn has reached base safely multiple times in six of his seven contests)...O'Hearn has become one of five Pirates during the Modern Era (since 1901) to collect at least nine hits and draw at least six walks in his first seven games with the team, along with Ed Mensor (10h, 7 bb) in 1912, Billy Southworth (15h/7bb) in 1918, Gus Suhr (11h, 6bb) in 1930 and Fern Bell (10h, 9bb) in 1939.

**AMERICAN SPIRIT:** Pittsburgh has secured a series victory in its first interleague series of 2026 after winning each of its first two games vs. Baltimore...The Pirates won just five of their 16 series against American League teams in 2025...They won two of three games from April 22-24 at Los Angeles (AL), completed a three-game sweep from July 21-23 vs. Detroit, won two of three games from August 18-20 vs. Toronto, won two of three games from August 29-31 at Boston and won two of three games from September 19-21 vs. the Athletics...Pittsburgh's last three-game sweep of an American League East opponent came from April 3-5, 2023 at Fenway Park (last three-game sweep vs. an A.L. East team here was from September 16-18, 2014 vs. Boston)...This is the Pirates' fourth series victory in a three-game series vs. the O's (also June 6-8, 2005, June 20-22, 2011 and April 5-7, 2024).

### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 5, 2010: Garrett Jones became the sixth player in team history to homer twice on Opening Day as the Pirates defeated the Dodgers, 11-5, in front of a sellout crowd of 39,024 fans at PNC Park. Zach Duke started his second consecutive Home Opener and earned the win after allowing two runs over 5.0 innings of work. Ryan Church had a pinch-hit, three-run double in the team's five-run fifth inning.

**HOW ACQUIRED:** Selected in the second round of the 2018 Draft.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ashcraft suffered the loss after allowing two runs over a career-high 6.0 innings of work in his 2026 debut on March 30 at Cincinnati...The Reds scored both of their runs in the fourth inning, by way of a Spencer Steer sacrifice fly that brought home Sal Stewart and a run-scoring triple from Will Benson that scored Eugenio Suárez...Ashcraft's 87 pitches in the loss were also the most he has thrown in a game.

**AGAINST THE ORIOLES:** This will be Ashcraft's second career outing (first start) against Baltimore...He allowed one run and struck out four batters over 3.0 innings of relief last season on September 9 at Camden Yards (Jeremiah Jackson took him deep).

**ON THE HOME FRONT:** Today is Ashcraft's first appearance back at PNC Park since striking out six batters in 3.0 perfect innings of relief last season on September 20 vs. the Athletics...He went 3-2 with a 3.00 ERA (33.0ip/11er) and 38 strikeouts over 14 appearances (four starts) at PNC Park in 2025 (allowed only one homer here at home).

**REMARKABLE ROOKIE:** Ashcraft struck out a career-high-tying six batters over 3.0 perfect innings of relief during his penultimate appearance last season on September 20 vs. the Athletics...He became the third Pirates reliever in the Modern Era (since 1901) to accomplish that, joining Bob Patterson (May 25, 1991 vs. Philadelphia) and Chan Ho Park (October 1, 2010 at Florida)...Ashcraft joined starter Bubba Chandler, who had six strikeouts and zero walks, as the only pair of Pirates pitchers in the Modern Era to each have at least six strikeouts while also issuing zero walks in the same game.

**HOMER HIATUS:** Ashcraft allowed three home runs in 69.2 innings pitched last season, coming on July 4 at Seattle (Dylan Moore, two-run), September 9 at Baltimore (Jeremiah Jackson, solo) and September 15 vs. Chicago-NL (Michael Busch, solo)...He was one of only two Major League pitchers from May 26 (debut date) through the end of the regular season to pitch at least 65.0 innings and allow three or fewer home runs, along with Milwaukee's Aaron Ashby (he allowed three home runs over 65.2 innings).

**A BIT OF BOTH:** Ashcraft went 1-2 with a 2.16 ERA (33.1ip/8er) in eight starts last season, while also going 3-2 with a 3.22 ERA (36.1ip/13er) in 18 relief appearances...His lone win as a member of Pittsburgh's starting rotation came on August 22 vs. Colorado, when he allowed one hit and struck out six batters over 5.0 scoreless innings.

**THREE'S COMPANY:** Ashcraft pitched at least 3.0 innings and allowed one or zero runs in each of his first six Major League starts, joining Los Angeles' Fernando Valenzuela in 1981 (seven starts) as the only pitchers in the Modern Era (since 1901) to accomplish that...The streak was snapped last year on Sept. 15 vs. Chicago-NL (gave up three runs).

**DAZZLING DEBUT:** Ashcraft allowed two hits and one walk while tossing 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of starter Andrew Heaney in his Major League debut last season on May 26 at Arizona...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, Ashcraft became just the fifth Pirates relief pitcher in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to pitch at least 3.0 scoreless innings in his Major League debut...He joined Jim Nelson (3.0ip) on May 30, 1970 vs. San Francisco, Bruce Dal Canton (3.0ip) on September 3, 1967 vs. Philadelphia, Steve Blass (5.0ip) on May 10 [G2], 1964 vs. Milwaukee and Jack Lamabe (4.0ip) on April 17, 1962 at Chicago (he was later joined by Bubba Chandler, 4.0ip on August 22 vs. Colorado, on that list).
