BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles complete their final homestand of the year this afternoon against the Rays (1-1, 1 to play), having dropped three of four to the Yankees from Thursday through Sunday...The Birds will close the 2025 season with three games in the Bronx beginning tomorrow. Θ With a win this afternoon, Baltimore can clinch a 7-6 season-series victory over Tampa

Bay, marking their third straight winning season over the Rays for the first time since 2014-16

In last night's 6-2 defeat, the Birds were held to three hits...It marked their 12th time being held to three or fewer hits this season (last: 9/18 vs. NYY, 3 H), tied for the fourthmost such games in MLB this year ahead of the Guardians (18 G), Rockies (16 G), and Twins (14 G).

Despite the loss, Baltimore is 55-48 (.534) since May 30, tied with New York-AL (also 55-48) for the fifth-best winning percentage in the AL during that period behind Toronto (.608, 62-40), Boston (.600, 60-40), Seattle (.573, 59-44), and Cleveland (.544, 56-47). The Orioles have hit one or zero home runs in a season-high 16 straight home games,

their longest single-season stretch since a 17-game run from June 22-July 26, 2004

RUN AND GUNN: After swiping his 29th bag of the season last night, Gunnar Henderson has been successful on each of his last 15 stolen base attempts since August 4, marking the longest such streak of his career...His previous best was 13 straight from September 27, 2023-June 21, 2024.

All Having already recorded a team-leading 33 doubles, Henderson can become the sixth Oriole (10th occurrence) in franchise history (since 1954) to record 30+ doubles and 30+ steals in a season, joining Cedric Mullins (2021-22), Jonathan Villar (2019), Nate McLouth (2013), Brian Roberts (2006-09), and Delino DeShields (2000).

Entering play today, eight players in MLB have 30+ doubles and 30+ steals: WSH's CJ Abrams, AZ's Corbin Carroll, CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong, CIN's Elly De La Cruz, NYM's Francisco Lindor. CLE's José Ramírez, PHI's Trea Turner, and KC's Bobby Witt Jr.

PATIENT APPROACH: The O's have drawn an MLB-best 90 walks since August 31, outpacing Yankees (88 BB) and Giants (87 BB)...The Birds have drawn 1+ walk in 43 straight games since

August 8, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind the Cubs (49 G).

HOLLIDAY SEASON: Jackson Holliday paces the Birds with 17 home runs, one ahead of Colton Cowser and Gunnar Henderson (both 16 HR)...The only Oriole under 22 years old to finish the season leading the club in homers is Eddie Murray (27 HR, 1977).

By Holliday can join Bobby Grich (19 HR, 1974) as the only Oriole second basemen in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the team in home runs, per Stats Perform.

Holliday's 17 long balls are the fifth most by an Oriole in their age-21 season or younger (as of age of July 1 of season) in team history (since 1954), trailing Cal Ripken, Jr. (28 HR, 1982), Eddie Murray (27 HR, 1977), Boog Powell (25 HR, 1963), and Curt Blefary (22 HR, 1965), per Stats Perform.

Baltimore has not had a player fail to reach the 20 home run mark since 2001, when Jay Gibbons and Chris Richard each paced the club with 15 homers apiece...Only five teams in Orioles history (since 1954) have not had a player hit 20+ homers ('01, '74, '57, '55, '54).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS: Dylan Beavers has reached base safely in 25 of his first 31 career games since August 16...His 23 walks during that time are tied for seventh most in the AL.

(b) His 23 walks are tied with Glenn Gulliver (23 BB, 1982) for the most in O's history (since 1954) through a player's first 31 career games...Gulliver also holds the record through 32 games with 24 walks.

(b) He has reached base safely 47 times (24 H, 23 BB) to begin his career, becoming the

fifth Oriole in franchise history to reach safely 47+ times (24 H, 23 BB) to begin his career, becoming the fifth Oriole in franchise history to reach safely 47+ times through their first 31 career games along with **Billy Ripken** (54 TOB, 1987), **Curtis Goodwin** (51 TOB, 1995), **Ryan Mountcastle** (47 TOB, 2020), and **Willie Tasby** (47 TOB, 1958-59). Since making his debut, he's averaging 4.42 pitches per plate appearance, the sixth-highest mark in the majors.

HOMETOWN TURN AROUND: After opening the season 9-17 at home and being outscored 167-11 (-56), the Birds have gone 29-25 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards since May 30 with a +26 run differential (245-219).

(96) In their first 26 home games through May 28, Oriole starters compiled a 6.93 ERA (96) ER/124.2 IP) and permitted 36 homers, but have since tallied a 3.74 ERA (120 ER/289.0 IP) and allowed 43 long balls across 54 games.

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: Baltimore has used 70 different players this season to tie the major league record set by the 2024 Marlins...The Braves have also used 70 players...The previous O's record was set in 2021 with 62.

Oh The O's have used 41 different pitchers this year (including position players), second most in a season in franchise history (since 1954) behind the 2021 Orioles (42)...The AL record for most pitchers used in a season is 42, shared by the 2021 Orioles and 2019 Seattle Mariners

Seattle Mariners. The Orioles have had 34 different position players appear in a game, the most by a major league team since 2022 (37, SF; 34, LAA, OAK, PIT) and tied for the most in a season in franchise history with 1955. The Orioles have had 23 players hit a home run for the team, breaking the team record (since 1954)...That's the most players to homer by one MLB team since 2024 (SF, 23). Baltimore has had 19 players steal a base, breaking the O's record. The Birds have used seven different players at catcher, setting the franchise record...The last MLB club to use at least seven catchers in a single season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians (also 7)...The 2022 Pirates are the last team to use eight.

QUIET ON EUTAW: The Orioles have failed to have a home run land on Eutaw Street this year after hitting six to the iconic stretch parallel to the Warehouse beyond the right field wall a season ago...Three opposing players have homered onto Eutaw in 2025: TB's Jonathan Arranda on June 28, NYY's Trent Grisham on April 29, and CIN's Jake Fraley on April 19...Not including the COVID-impacted season in 2020, that would be the fewest home runs marked on Eutaw since Chris Davis hit all three in 2015.

Since Oriole Park at Camden Yards opened in 1992, Baltimore has not had a homer land

on Eutaw Street in eight seasons: 2014, 2007, 2005, 2001, 2000, 1994, 1993, and 1992.

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt the loss on September 18 vs. New York-AL after allowing three runs on five hits and four walks (1 IBB) with five strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Has completed 5.0 innings in five straight outings since August 28, the longest stretch of his career...Threw 89 pitches, 51 strikes.

RAYS THE ROOF: Set to make his first career start against Tampa Bay...Owns a career 0-6 record with a 5.01 ERA (33 ER/59.1 IP) through 12 starts against the AL East, but has held divisional opponents to three runs or fewer across six starts this season.

DAY 'N' NITE: Holds a 3.18 ERA (16 ER/45.1 IP) through nine day appearances (8 GS) compared to a 6.46 ERA (44 ER/61.1 IP) across 12 night games (11 65)...Opponents are batting .297 (54-for-182) with a 1.52 WHIP off Povich during the day compared to .261 (61-for-234) with a 1.42 WHIP at night.

THREE'S A CROWD: Batters in the first- through third-hole spots are slashing a combined .311/.363/.567 (51-for-164) off Povich, while the rest of the lineup is slashing a combined .254/.326/.393 (64-for-252)...The first three batters have accounted for 20 of Povich's 39 total extra-base hits allowed on the year (51.3%).
