HAPPY 314 DAY: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their 29th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2026) as they face the Miami Marlins in Jupiter today, the 21st of 28 scheduled Spring Training games for the Redbirds ... The Cardinals are in Jupiter for five of their final eight Grapefruit League games.

• In 12 days on Monday, March 23, the Cardinals break camp in Florida and fly to Springfield, Mo. to play an exhibition with the Double-A Cardinals at Hammons Field ... First pitch is scheduled for 6:05 p.m. CT.

PLAYING FOR KEEPS: On Thursday, March 26, the Cardinals will host the Tampa Bay Rays on Opening Day, the earliest game in franchise history ... St. Louis played on March 27 last season vs. Minnesota, a 5-3 Redbirds winner at Busch Stadium.

LET'S HEAR IT FOR THE NEW GUY: Colton Ledbetter walked off the Marlins with a game-winning RBI single on March 2 vs. the Marlins, and provided a game-winning walk-off two-run single last night over the Astros.

• According to baseball research dating back to 2006, Ledbetter is the 9th Major Leaguer and first Cardinal with two walk-off RBI in a single Spring Training.

• Since 2006, the only other Cardinal with multiple walk-off RBI over their career is **Jon Jay** (March 22, 2009 vs. Baltimore and March 21, 2012 vs. Mets).

• The 24-year-old Ledbetter was acquired from Tampa Bay with SHP **Jurrangel Cijntje**, OF **Tai Peete** and two Comp. Round B Draft picks as part of the three-team trade with Seattle in exchange for INF/OF **Brendan Donovan** (Feb 2, 2026).

FISH FRY: The Cardinals play their 5th of six Spring matchups against the Miami Marlins in the stadium that both teams call home during Spring Training.

• Since 2006, the Cardinals are 25-30-8 against the Fish as the visiting team at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium.

• St. Louis is 3-0-1 against Miami this Spring, their best mark against the Marlins since going 5-0-1 in 2023.

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals own six of the top 86 picks (13, 32, 50, 68, 72, 86) in the upcoming 2026 MLB Draft, the most of any Major League team ... Since the DeWitt ownership group (1996-present), 2026 will be only the third time St. Louis has possessed as many as six of the top 86 selections, following 2005 (6 of top 78) and 2012 (6 of top 86).

WORLD CLASS: Cardinals remaining in the 2026 World Baseball Classic include **Gordon Graceffo** (Italy), **Thomas Saggese** (Italy), **Bryan Torres** (Puerto Rico), and Asst. Athletic Trainer **Chris Conroy** (Puerto Rico).

SPRING BREAKOUT: As part of MLB's third annual Spring Breakout showcase, the top Cardinals prospects will host the Nationals top young talent on March 19 at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, following the Cards-Nats Grapefruit League game at 1:05 p.m.

• The exhibition will be streamed live and for free on MLB.TV, MLB.com, and on the MLB App.

• St. Louis will have 25 of its top 30 prospects participating, including eight of the top 10.

100: **Masyn Winn** was named the 2025 winner of the Rawlings Gold Glove Award at shortstop, the first of his career and the 100th by the Cardinals - the most all-time for any MLB franchise since the award's inception in 1957 ... Winn joined **Ozzie Smith** (11 times), **Édgar Rentería** (2), and **Dal Maxvill** (1) as the fourth Cardinals shortstop to win the award.

TODAY'S PITCHERS

#53 ANDRE PALLANTE · RHP · 6-0 · 220 LBS · AGE 27

- Makes his fourth Grapefruit League start today.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster each of the last four seasons (2022-25) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Utilized as a hybrid pitcher during his 2022 rookie season with 47 appearances and 10 starts. After leading the Cardinals with 62 relief appearances in 2023, transitioned to the rotation in mid-May 2024 and has made 51 starts since.
- Established single-season highs in starts (31), quality starts (9), strikeouts (111), and innings pitched (162.2) in 2025.
- Since his 2022 Major League debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (63.8%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ innings pitched.
- As a starting pitcher (328.1 IP), Pallante's 60.3 career groundball pct. currently is the 8th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 325.0 IP as starter).
- Has a career reverse-split holding left-handed batters to .242 batting average & .669 OPS, while right-handed batters are hitting .288 with a .778 OPS.

#49 MATT SVANSON · RHP · 6-6 · 240 LBS · AGE 27

- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Blue Jays at the 2023 Trade Deadline for INF Paul DeJong and cash considerations.
- Made his MLB debut on April 17, 2025 at the New York Mets, working a scoreless 7th inning with one hit allowed. His college head coach made the drive from Lehigh to Citi Field for the game and returned for his weekend series that night.
- Has converted 39 consecutive save opportunities since May 23, 2023, with the first six as a member of the Blue Jays organization followed by 33 straight with the Cardinals.
- The 39 consecutive save streak currently ranks as the longest active in Minor League Baseball and 4th longest since MiLB records date back to 2005 (Brian Anderson, 41, Mike James, 40, Wander Suero, 40).

#64 RYAN FERNANDEZ · RHP · 6-0 · 205 LBS · AGE 27

- 2023 Rule 5 pick from Boston spent his first full season in the Majors in 2024 and appeared in a professional season high in games (62) and innings pitched (66.2).
- Became the first Rule 5 Selection to play entire season with St. Louis since RHP Matt Bowman (2015).
- His 62 appearances for St. Louis in 2024 were the most by a Cardinals rookie since Giovanny Gallegos (66 in 2016).
- Made Major League debut on April 3, 2024 at San Diego, striking out the side in the 9th inning. Became the 38th pitcher in MLB history and the 2nd Cardinal (Braden Looper, March 31, 1998 vs. Dodgers) to strike out three in 1.0 inning pitched in an MLB debut.
- Pitched in 32 games over two stints with St. Louis. Began the season on the Opening Day roster and appeared in 11 games (8.2 IP) with the Cardinals before rejoining the team on August 1.

#71 PACKY NAUGHTON · LHP · 6-1 · 205 LBS · AGE 29

- Attending Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee. Re-signed with St. Louis on a two-year minor league contract encompassing the 2025-26 seasons.
- Also was a non-roster invitee to Major League Spring Training in 2024 after being outrighted to the minors in November 2023.
- Underwent season-ending surgery to undergo a primary repair of the UCL and flexor tendon in his left elbow in June 2023. Re-tore his flexor tendon and tore his UCL in 2024 two weeks after being activated from his previous injury, which required UCL Revision Reconstruction and flexor tendon revision repair in July 2024.
- Has recently been working as a licensed Real Estate Agent in the Jupiter, Fla. area. Began studying and completed a 63-hour training class for his Real Estate License Exam while rehabbing from two injuries to his left elbow. Previously helped Ryan Helsley and Lars Nootbaar locate their Spring Training housing.
- Last appeared for St. Louis on April 7, 2023 vs. Milwaukee, and last pitched in any game on July 5, 2024 at Nashville (AAA-Brewers).

#66 SCOTT BLEWETT · RHP · 6-6 · 245 LBS · AGE 29

- Originally a 2nd round draft pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 out of Baker High School in Baldwinsville, N.Y.
- Signed by St. Louis as a minor league free agent with an invitation to 2026 MLB Spring Training.
- Has been signed as a minor league free agent by the White Sox (2022), Braves (2023) and Twins (2024). Was traded twice from the Braves to Orioles and back to the Braves six weeks later.
- Played the second half of the 2023 season with the Uni-President 7-Eleven Lions with the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
