THE TWWWWWWWWWWWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 6-0 (3-0 at Los Angeles-AL and 3-0 at Chicago-AL), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with consecutive victories over Boston on Friday night and Saturday afternoon... today, the Twins will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Red Sox... after this series, the Twins will welcome the Mariners for four from Monday-Thursday. Over the last 12 games, the Twins have a run differential of +45 (84-39)... prior to the current winning streak their run differential was at -25 (67-92). Minnesota's last loss came 14 days ago on April 21, a 6-1 loss to Detroit at Target Field.

TWIN CITIES BUZZIN' AFTER A DOZEN: The Twins beat the Red Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 3-1 at Target Field, extending their winning streak to 12 games while securing the series victory... Pablo López (3-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts... Jorge Alcalá (0.2), Steven Okert (0.1), Jhoan Duran (1.0) and Cole Sands (1.0, SV) combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings of relief... the offense recorded eight hits, two from both Willi Castro and Max Kepler, as Kepler hit his second home run of the season, a 405-foot solo shot to right-centerfield.

LUCKY 13?: With a win today, the Twins' winning streak will hit 13... it's MLB's longest winning streak in 2024... below are all the club's streaks of 12-plus consecutive victories:

NOTE: Two teams in 2023 had winning streaks of 12-plus games: Tampa Bay - 13 (March 30-April 13) and Cincinnati - 12 (June 10-23).

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing for the third of six games in 2024 - they will play three games at Fenway from September 20-22... the Twins have won seven of their last 10 against the Sox in Minnesota.

Twins have won four straight against the Red Sox, their longest winning streak against Boston since June 13-September 20, 2006, when they won five straight.

MINNESOTA LUMBER COMPANY: Over the current 12-game winning streak, the Twins have hit .308 (130-for-422) with 35 doubles, two triples, 16 home runs, a .377 on-base percentage, a .514 slugging percentage and an .892 OPS... they have scored a total of 84 runs (7.0 runs-per-game) during the stretch... below are the Twins numbers through April 21 (first 20 games), compared to numbers since April 22 (12 games) and MLB ranks in parentheses:

MAX PRODUCTION: Since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Max Kepler has hit .400 (14-for-35) with two doubles, two home runs, five walks, 11 RBI, a .463 on-base percentage and a 1.092 OPS in 11 games... his one RBI yesterday moved him in sole possession of 14th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

WILL-MATIC: Willi Castro has hit safely in a career-high 10 straight games... it marks the longest on the club this season... the last Twin with a hit in 10 straight was Kyle Farmer, from September 18-29, 2023 (also 10)... the last Twin with a streak of at least 11 games was Ryan Jeffers with 14, from July 15-August 9, 2023.

The streak is the longest active streak in the AL and tied with the Dodgers' Andy Pages for second-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Philadelphia's Alec Bohm (17).

SWEEPS WEEK: Minnesota is seeking its fourth sweep of the season today... their other three sweeps were four games against Chicago-AL from April 22-25, three games at Los Angeles-AL from April 26-28 and three at Chicago-AL from April 29-May 1.

Only twice previously have the Twins recorded four consecutive sweeps: 1991 (3 vs. BAL, 3 vs. CLE, 3 vs. NYY and 3 at CLE) and 1980 (3 vs. CWS, 3 vs. TEX, 3 vs. KC and 2 at TEX). The Twins are looking to sweep the Red Sox for the first time since May 25-27, 2015, when they took all three at Target Field.

MIRANDA WATCH: Jose Miranda has hit in five of his last seven games, hitting .440 (11-for-25) with a .720 slugging percentage, a 1.201 OPS and four multi-hit games in that span... since being recalled from St. Paul on April 8, he is hitting .300 (18-for-60) with five doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and an .827 OPS in 20 games.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul outfielder DaShawn Keirse Jr and Saints right-handed pitcher David Festa have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

Keirse Jr, 26, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .280 (7-for-25) with one double, one home run and six RBI... the San Diego, CA native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of Utah.

Festa, 24, made the start on Tuesday vs. Louisville, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and 10 strikeouts... the Verona, NJ native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2021 MLB Draft and is ranked as the club's fifth-best prospect by MLB.com - first among pitchers.

CINCO DE MAUER: On this day in 2017, 2024 Hall of Fame electee Joe Mauer hit his first and only career walk-off home run, a solo shot off Red Sox reliever Matt Barnes, guiding the Twins to a 4-3 victory over the Red Sox (w/ Rick Palermo/Cory Provus - BSN)... the Sox tied the game with two runs in the top of the ninth inning, then Mauer came up with two outs in the bottom half, hitting a 404-foot shot into the bullpen.

The Twins are 26-24 since 1961 on Cinco de Mayo, including 12-12 at home and 14-12 on the road... they shut out Cleveland, 2-0, in Cleveland last year on Cinco de Mayo.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his second consecutive start against Chicago-AL, recording his second-straight quality (team leader with four) and the 30th of his career...Ryan allowed two runs on six hits with one walk and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Ryan allowed two runs in the first inning on an Andrew Vaughn double and a Eloy Jiménez double play that plated Vaughn...four of the six hits he allowed came in the first inning...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings after the first, allowing just three hits over that span, with one walk and three strikeouts.

☞ Fourth in the American League in strikeout-to-walk ratio with 8.20.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan earned his first win of the season against the Chicago White Sox on April 24, after allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR), with one walk and eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work...allowed two home runs in a start and won for the second time in his career; the other came in a 9-4 win over the White Sox on July 21, 2023 at Target Field.

☞ Last time he allowed multiple home runs in an outing was on September 29, 2023 at Colorado, when he gave up three.

SUCCESS AGAINST BOSTON: Facing the Boston Red Sox for the fifth time in his career...in the previous four starts he is 3-1, 3.12 ERA (26.0 IP, 9 ER), 22 hits, two walks, 27 strikeouts, 0.92 WHIP...Red Sox hitters have hit .222 (22-for-99) with four home runs and an OPS of .616.

☞ In his last start against Boston on June 22, 2023, Ryan tossed the only complete-game shutout of his career, giving up three hits, no walks and striking out nine batters while tossing a career-high 112 pitches in a 6-0 Twins win.

☞ His only loss came on August 31, 2022 at Target Field, giving up five runs on eight hits (2 HR), in 5.0 innings with one walk and eight strikeouts.

BACK AT HOME: Through three home starts in 2024, Ryan has tossed 17.1 innings with 16 hits, two walks, 21 strikeouts and three home runs – two of which came in his last home start against the White Sox on April 24.

☞ In 35 career home starts, he is 15-10, 3.74 ERA (197.1 IP, 82 ER), 157 hits, 50 walks and 237 strikeouts...Twins are 20-15 in Ryan's 35 home starts.

☞ Since making his debut in 2021, he leads all Twins pitchers with 15 home wins...behind him are Griffin Jax and Caleb Thielbar, both with 10.

☞ Has allowed four home runs this year...three have come at home.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .279/.319/.397 with five extra-base hits, including one home run, three walks and 19 strikeouts in 72 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .185/.209/.585 with four doubles, three home runs, two walks and 22 strikeouts in 67 plate appearances.

☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .215 (144-for-670) 27 doubles, four triples and 21 home runs with a .643 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .237 (173-for-730) 43 doubles, no triples and 39 home runs with a .735 OPS.

☞ In four games vs. Ryan, Red Sox left-handed hitters have hit .213 (10-for-47), with two doubles, one home run and eight strikeouts...right-handed hitters have hit .231 (12-for-52) with three home runs and 19 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in his six starts this season, with sinkers all coming in the first three outings...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and split finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 69.7 percent of the time in his last start against the White Sox... here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

☞ In his last start against Chicago-AL, threw his 4-seam fastball a season-low 35 times, previous low was 36 on April 6 vs. Cleveland...White Sox hitters went 2-for-6, with one double and no strikeouts against the 4-seam fastball.

☞ In the top 6% in the league in base on balls.

☞ Right-handed hitters are hitting .154 (4-for-26) with one home run and nine strikeouts against the fastball in 2024.

RUNNERS ON: With runners in scoring position vs. Ryan, opponents are hitting .348 (8-for-23), with one home run, one walk and four strikeouts...with the bases empty, opponents are hitting .185 (17-for-92) with two home runs, three walks and 32 strikeouts.

SHINE BRIGHT LIKE A DIAMOND: Making his fourth day start of the year...has gone 0-1, 2.60 ERA (17.1 IP, 5 ER), with two walks, 24 strikeouts and a .209 opponent batting average in his prior three outings...went 6-5, 3.65 ERA (74.0 IP, 30 ER) with 16 walks, 88 strikeouts and a .233 opponent batting average in 13 day starts in 2023...is 12-9, 3.06 ERA (155.2 IP, 53 ER), .207 BAA in 28 career day starts, compared to 15-11, 4.66 ERA (214.1 IP, 111 ER), .240 BAA in 39 career night starts.

MOVE OVER SANTANA: Picked up his 416th career strikeout against the Chicago White Sox on April 24...puts him 51st all time in Twins history with 419 strikeouts ahead of Juan Rincón (412) and Ervin Santana (414)...next up is Pete Redfern with 426.

MY GOOD FRIENDS IN THE CENTRAL: Each of his first six starts this season came against AL Central opponents...longest streak at any point throughout his career...KC (1x), CLE (1x), DET (2x), CWS (2x).

- 2024 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics... went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz... learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
