The Mariners and Padres square off for the second time this year...the Padres swept Seattle in a 3-game series at Petco Park last month from April 14-16.

**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners continue the 6-game homestand with the 3rd and final game of a 3-game series against the San Diego Padres (0-2)...Seattle is coming off a winning road trip (4-3) against the Chicago White Sox (1-2) and Houston Astros (3-1)...beginning tomorrow, Seattle will host the White Sox for a 3-game set (5/18-5/20) to wrap up the homestand...today's tilt will be aired live on NBC (simulcast on Peacock) with Jason Benetti, Jake Peavy and Ryan Rowland-Smith on the call...the game will be broadcast live on ESPN Radio with Roxy Bernstein and Doug Glanville on the call, and on Seattle Sports (710 AM) with Rick Rizzos and Gary Hill Jr. on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners dropped yesterday's game against the Padres by a 7-4 final...the Mariners are 12-10 over their last 22 games since April 22.

- **Sunday Night Baseball in Seattle** - Today, the Mariners will be on NBC's Sunday Night Baseball for the second time this season...the Mariners were on Sunday Night Baseball during the opening week of the season, beating the Guardians 8-0 in the debut of the Mariners Sunday Steelheads uniforms.
- **Young and Spry** - Second baseman Cole Young's 11 defensive runs saved [lead MLB infielders](#) and rank T-2nd in the big leagues among all positions.
- **Just Producing** - Over his last 5 games (5/12-c), J.P. Crawford is batting .333 (7x21) with 4 runs, 1 double, 2 home runs, 5 RBI and 3 walks.

**KIRBY'S DREAMLAND**...in 9 starts to begin the season, George Kirby is 5-2 with a 2.84 ERA (18 ER, 57.0 IP) and 14 walks compared to 46 strikeouts...he ranks 8th in the Majors and 5th in the AL in innings pitched this season...since his debut in 2022, he leads qualified MLB starters in fewest walks-per-9 innings (1.39) and ranks 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.23), ahead of Tarik Skubal-DET (6.11) and behind only Jacob deGrom-NYM/TEX (7.02)...his 3.8% walk rate since 2022 is also an MLB-best among qualified starters.

**ANSWERING THE CALL**...the Mariners bullpen leads MLB with a 3.03 ERA (50 ER, 148.2 IP) this season, narrowly ranking ahead of the next closest Braves (3.04 ERA) and Rangers (3.07 ERA)...they have allowed just 11 home runs and 53 walks over 148.2 IP, both ranking 3rd lowest among Major League bullpens this season...Seattle has gotten outstanding contributions from LHP José A. Ferrer (1.71 ER, 22 G) and RHP Eduard Bazarzo (2.21 ERA, 22 G) who both rank T-7th in the Majors with 22 appearances...RHP Cooper Criswell holds a 2.37 ERA (31 ER, 19.0 IP) and RHP Nick Davila has not allowed an earned run in 6 appearances (6.1 IP) since being selected from Triple-A Tacoma on May 2.

**NAYLOR LOCKED IN**...over his last 24 games since April 17, Josh Naylor is batting .357 (35x98) with 10 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 13 RBI, 10 walks, 9 stolen bases, a .413 OBP while slugging .500 for a .913 OPS...during that span, he ranks T-3rd in the Majors in both average and stolen bases...Naylor is 28-for-30 (93.3%) in stolen base attempts since joining Seattle, ranking T-1st in franchise history in stolen base percentage (min. 25 attempts) along with James Jones (93.3%) and ranking just ahead of teammate Victor Robles (92.5%).

**A RALEY STRONG FORCE**...Luke Raley is batting .265 (31x117) with 19 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 10 homers, 27 RBI and 8 walks, getting on base at a .333 clip, slugging .573 with a .906 OPS...over his last 10 games (5/4-c), Raley is hitting .321 (9x28) with 8 runs, 5 homers, 14 RBI and 3 walks with 1.281 OPS...on May 8 at the White Sox, Raley became one of 16 players in franchise history to record 7+ RBI...his 7 RBI are also the most by a player in the Majors this season.

**THIS IS RANDY'S WORLD**...over his last 10 games (5/6-c), Randy Arozarena is batting .447 (17x38) with 8 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 5 RBI, 3 walks, 4 stolen bases and 3 hit-by-pitches, getting on base at a .523 clip, slugging .579 with a 1.102 OPS in 44 plate appearances...overall this season, the Mariners left fielder's .306 batting average ranks 7th among qualified American Leaguers.

**SOLID ON THE MOUND**...the Mariners pitching staff has been stellar this season, posting a combined 3.66 ERA (170 ER, 418.1 IP) with an MLB-lowest 118 walks and 397 strikeouts...among Major League pitching staffs they rank 1st in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.36), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.54), 7th in ERA and 8th in WHIP (1.23)...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 269.2 innings pitched and ranks 5th in strikeouts with 252.

**HOT (J)-ROD**...over his last 24 contests (4/20-c), Julio Rodríguez is batting .294 (30x102) with 14 runs, 6 doubles, 6 home runs, 13 RBI, 5 walks and 4 stolen bases, getting on base at a .327 clip, slugging .529 with a .856 OPS.

**VEDDER CUP 2.0 GOES TO THE PADRES**...the Padres on Friday clinched the Vedder Cup after Seattle took the season series in the inaugural Vedder Cup in 2025...as part of the annual series, the Mariners and Padres are supporting the Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB) Research Partnership, a charity co-founded by Eddie and Jill Vedder dedicated to funding research to discover treatments and cures for EB...learn more at [ebresearch.org](http://ebresearch.org).

**BIG TEX IS BACK**...Bryce Miller made his season debut on Wednesday night in Houston, tossing 5.1 innings and allowing 2 runs (2 ER) on 8 hits (1 HR) and 1 walk with 3 strikeouts...he was activated off the Injured List prior to the game after missing the start of the season with a left oblique strain...he made 4 rehab starts between High-A Everett and Triple-A Tacoma before being reinstated, where he posted a 1.98 ERA (3 ER, 13.2 IP) with 14 strikeouts.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...Julio Rodríguez went 1-for-4 with 2 stolen bases in yesterday's game against the Padres, his 14th career multi-stolen base game, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Julio's 14 such games rank 4th most in franchise history?...Rodríguez yesterday passed Alex Rodríguez (13 G) and trails only Harold Reynolds (24 G), Julio Cruz (47 G) and Ichiro Suzuki (64 G) for the most games with 2+ stolen bases in Mariners history.

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 17

- **1977** - Catcher Skip Jutze hit the first grand slam home run in Mariner history and the Mariners went on to beat the Baltimore Orioles, 10-2, at the Kingdome.
- **1990** - Brian Giles goes 3x4 with two home runs (including a grand slam) and 7 RBI and the Mariners scored nine in the 3rd on their way to a 14-0 lead and an eventual 14-6 win.
- **1993** - Mike Blowers becomes the 13th-player in Major League history to hit grand slam home runs in two consecutive games...he hit the first off Bobby Witt at Oakland May 16 and the second off Criag Lefferts May 17 at Texas...Seattle finished with a near club-record 23 hits and tied the team mark with 16 runs in a 16-9 win.
- **2000** - John Halama needs just 87 pitches and tosses his 2nd career complete game.
- **2015** - James Paxton tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings to lead the Mariners over Boston 5-0...Paxton extended his scoreless streak to 20.0 IP.

ABOUT GEORGE KIRBY...

- The 28-year-old right-hander is making his 10th start of the season and 1st against the Padres...is making the 122nd start of his career and his 3rd career start against San Diego.
• Is in his 5th season with Seattle; selected by the Mariners in the first round (20th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Ty Holub.
• Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2023.
• Named AL Rookie of the Month in August 2022 after posting a 2.15 ERA and 5-0 record.
• Is the highest drafted player out of Elon University.

LAST TIME OUT...W#5 on May 11 at Houston, tossing 5.0 innings and allowing 1 run (1 ER) on 7 hits and 2 walks with 7 strikeouts...he threw 99 pitches (64 strikes) in his 9th start of the season.

WIN #50...earned his 50th career win in his last start (5/11 at HOU), becoming the 12th player in franchise history with 50+ wins...his 121 games are tied for the 4th-fewest games to reach 50 wins with the Mariners, alongside; Hisashi Iwakuma and Erik Hanson...behind: Jamie Moyer (100 G), Freddy Garcia (100 G), and Marco Gonzales (118 G).

LATEST STRETCH...is 4-0 with a 2.43 ERA (10 ER, 37.0 IP) and just 1 home run allowed to 30 strikeouts across his last 6 starts (4/13-c) with the Mariners going 5-1 across the stretch...he has thrown 3 quality starts and has allowed 2-or-fewer runs in each of those last 6 starts.

LENGTH ON THE MOUND...has reached the 6th inning in 8 of his 9 starts this year and has cleared the 7th inning in 3 of those starts...his 57.0 innings pitched this season are 3rd-most in MLB, trailing Max Fried-NYY (61.2 IP) and Sandy Alcantara-MIA (57.2 IP).

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD...has not allowed a home run in each of his last 4 starts (4/24-c)...his 0.6 HR/9 this season is tied for 9th-best among pitchers with 200+ batters faced...in addition, his 57.0% ground-ball percentage ranks 4th-highest in MLB among starters this season.

EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT...currently averages 14.5 pitches per inning this season, tied with teammate Bryan Woo for 6th-lowest mark among starters...is averaging 15.5 pitches per inning across his career, tied for the 9th-fewest P/IP among starters since 2022 (min. 500 IP).

THE SWEEPER...his sweeper is his 2nd-most used pitch behind his 4-seam fastball, averaging about a 20.7% usage across his career, including a 25.7% usage this season...his 2,237 sweepers thrown since 2022 are 2nd-most in MLB, trailing only Logan Webb-SF (3,360) and ranking ahead of Taylor Rogers-6Tms (2,181)...he has thrown 213 sweepers this season, 6th-most in MLB, trailing Luis Severino-ATH (214) and ranking ahead of Max Meyer-MIA (194).

FURIOUS GEORGE...has thrown 7.0+ innings with 3-or-fewer earned runs allowed in 3 starts this season and in 25 career starts...in addition, Kirby and Bryan Woo 2 of 4 pitcherx in MLB this season to have 3 games of 7.0+ IP, 3-or-fewer runs, and 1-or-fewer walks allowed (also: Shota Imanaga-CHC and Paul Skenes-PIT).

QUALITY STUFF...has thrown a quality start in 5 of his 9 starts this season (last: 5/5 vs. ATL)...has thrown 67 quality starts across his career, 9th-most in MLB since 2022...has thrown a quality start without any walks in 36 career starts (1x this season, 4/7 at TEX), most in MLB since 2022, ahead of Tarik Skubal-DET (26 G) and Zack Wheeler-PHI (26 G)...has also tossed a quality start with no walks in 20 home games, most in MLB since 2022, ahead of Zach Wheeler-PHI (17 G).

HAPPY TO BE HOME...across his last 11 home starts since July 31, 2025, he is 6-2 with a 2.74 ERA (20 ER, 65.2 IP) and 72 strikeouts to 19 walks allowed...he has thrown 6.0+ IP in 8 of those 11 starts, including 7 quality starts with the Mariners going 7-4 in his last 11 home starts.

GEORGE & WALTER...among pitchers with 50+ starts at home since 2022, he leads in both walks-per-nine innings (1.49) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.39), ranking ahead of rotationmate Logan Gilbert in both categories (1.65 BB/9 and 6.06 SO/BB).

BEST IN ALL THE LAND...among starting pitchers since 2022 (min. 600 IP), he leads the Majors in fewest walks allowed (107), strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.23), walks-per-nine innings (1.39), and walk rate (3.8%).

FOR THE M'S HISTORY BOOKS...leads the Mariners franchise (min. 100 GS) in fewest walks-per-nine innings (1.4), ahead of Hisashi Iwakuma (1.9) and Logan Gilbert (1.9)...also leads franchise in strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.23), also ahead of Gilbert (4.90)...ranks 5th in franchise history in career ERA (3.54), ahead of Logan Gilbert (3.59) and Luis Castillo (3.66)...ranks 11th in total strikeouts (667 SO), trailing Castillo (676 SO).

CRUISE CONTROL...tossed 8.0 innings on April 7 vs. Texas on the road, his 2nd career complete game (also: 8/12/23 vs. BAL)...is 1 of just 2 pitchers with a complete game so far this season (also: Sandy Alcantara-MIA, 4/1 vs. CHW)...became the first Mariners pitcher to toss 8.0+ IP since Logan Gilbert did so twice in 2024 (last: 9/7/24 at STL)...Kirby has thrown 8.0+ IP without a walk in 3 career games (last: 4/7 at TEX) and is 1 of 9 pitchers in MLB with 3-or-more such games since 2023, joining teammate Logan Gilbert (3 G, last: 6/16/24 vs. TEX).

SO NICE HE DID IT TWICE...is the only pitcher to have multiple starts of 14+ SO and no walks since 2025, having done so twice last season (6/8/25 at LAA & 9/14 vs. LAA)...teammate Emerson Hancock recently joined him and Max Meyer-MIA (4/21/25 vs. CIN) as the only pitchers in MLB with 14+ SO and 0 BB in a game since 2025.
