- ♦ Kole Calhoun has 9 RBI in his last 6 games.
- ♦ **Ketel Marte** is batting .387 (12-for-31) in his last 7 games.

GALLEN GETS A NL RECORD: Last night, Zac Gallen set the NL record by allowing 3 or fewer earned runs in each of his first 19 career games (all starts), breaking a tie with Steve Rogers/MON (July 18, 1973-April 11, 1974).

♦ The Major League record is 21 by Aaron Sele/BOS from June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994.

REST UP: Following tomorrow's off day, the D-backs will play a season-high 17 straight games.

♦ Arizona's next off day is Aug. 31.

DOUBLE-PLAY DUO VS. SENZATELA: Nick Ahmed (SS) and Ketel Marte (2B) have combined to go 14-for-31 (.452) vs. Anto-

MILE HIGH HOME RUNS: The D-backs have homered in a clubrecord 15 straight games @ Coors Field (32 HR total).

- ♦ The 15-game streak @ Coors Field is tied for the second longest by a Rockies opponent (also: Braves from Sept. 12, 1996-Aug. 17, 1999).
- ♦ The Cubs homered in a record 18 consecutive games @ Coors Field from May 22, 1995-July 26, 1997 (25 in a row in Denver starting on July 5, 1993).

IT'S A LINE DRIVE IN THE BOX SCORE: Arizona had 4 infield hits last night and lead the NL with 16 infield hits.

SUNRISE OVER THE ROCKIES: The D-backs totaled 18 extra-base hits (8 doubles, 2 triples, 8 home runs) and hit .304 in their 4 day games @ Coors Field last season.

WALKER PROVIDING SOME WALLOP: Christian Walker leads the D-backs and ranks sixth in the NI with 24 "hard hit" balls (95 + mph).

♦ His 451-foot home run last night registered 104.7 mph.

HERE'S THE STORY: Arizona is 8-3 in last 11 games vs. Colorado. | DOUBLE YOUR FUN: Arizona ranks second in the NL with 35 doubles...only Atlanta (40) has more.

◆ Christian Walker is second in the NL with 8 doubles, 1 behind Donovan Solano/SF (9).

THE POWER IS BACK ON: The D-backs have hit 12 home runs over their last 7 games after totaling 2 in their first 11.
