### TOUCHING ALL THE BASES

**D-BACKS LAUNCH INTERACTIVE APP:** The D-backs launched a series of interactive games within the MLB Ballpark app that will allow fans to stay connected from home during the 60-game season and beyond...fans can download the Ballpark App for free and after navigating to the D-backs' homepage, click on Interactive Games to earn points during daily competitions, with the opportunity to win prizes each day throughout the season.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** Arizona is 8-3 in last 11 games vs. Colorado.

- ◆ **David Peralta** is hitting .444 (12-for-27) in his last 8 games.
- ◆ **Kole Calhoun** has 9 RBI in his last 6 games.
- ◆ **Ketel Marte** is batting .387 (12-for-31) in his last 7 games.

**GALLEN GETS A NL RECORD:** Last night, **Zac Gallen** set the NL record by allowing 3 or fewer earned runs in each of his first 19 career games (all starts), breaking a tie with Steve Rogers/MON (July 18, 1973-April 11, 1974).

- ◆ The Major League record is 21 by Aaron Sele/BOS from June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994.

**REST UP:** Following tomorrow's off day, the D-backs will play a season-high 17 straight games.

- ◆ Arizona's next off day is Aug. 31.

**DOUBLE-PLAY DUO VS. SENZATELA:** **Nick Ahmed** (SS) and **Ketel Marte** (2B) have combined to go 14-for-31 (.452) vs. Antonio Senzatela.

**MILE HIGH HOME RUNS:** The D-backs have homered in a club-record 15 straight games @ Coors Field (32 HR total).

- ◆ The 15-game streak @ Coors Field is tied for the second longest by a Rockies opponent (also: Braves from Sept. 12, 1996-Aug. 17, 1999).
- ◆ The Cubs homered in a record 18 consecutive games @ Coors Field from May 22, 1995-July 26, 1997 (25 in a row in Denver starting on July 5, 1993).

**IT'S A LINE DRIVE IN THE BOX SCORE:** Arizona had 4 infield hits last night and lead the NL with 16 infield hits.

**SUNRISE OVER THE ROCKIES:** The D-backs totaled 18 extra-base hits (8 doubles, 2 triples, 8 home runs) and hit .304 in their 4 day games @ Coors Field last season.

**WALKER PROVIDING SOME WALLOP:** **Christian Walker** leads the D-backs and ranks sixth in the NL with 24 "hard hit" balls (95+ mph).

- ◆ His 451-foot home run last night registered 104.7 mph.

**DOUBLE YOUR FUN:** Arizona ranks second in the NL with 35 doubles...only Atlanta (40) has more.

- ◆ **Christian Walker** is second in the NL with 8 doubles, 1 behind Donovan Solano/SF (9).

**THE POWER IS BACK ON:** The D-backs have hit 12 home runs over their last 7 games after totaling 2 in their first 11.

**GUERRA HAS IT GOING ON:** **Junior Guerra's** 7 hitless outings to start the season are tied for the most in the NL with Tyler Kinley/COL.

**ON DECK - SAN DIEGO PADRES:** The D-backs are 2-5 vs. Padres this season (all @ Petco Park).

- ◆ Arizona has a 7-game winning streak vs. San Diego @ Chase Field, 1 shy of the club record (8 from July 25, 2002-May 23, 2003).
- ◆ **Starling Marte** is hitting .346 (9-for-26)/.370 OBP/.577 SLG with 3 doubles, 1 homer and 3 RBI vs. Padres in 2020

### NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (2-1, 2.29)

- ◆ Has gone 6-2 with a 2.22 ERA (13 ER in 52.2 IP) and a 1.01 WHIP in his last 8 starts dating back to 2019.
- ◆ Won his last start on Aug. 8 @ Padres, allowing 1 run on 6 hits over 6.0 innings.
- ◆ Is 4-1 with a 3.31 ERA (12 ER in 32.2 IP) in 6 career starts vs. San Diego.
- ◆ In his last 3 starts vs. Padres, is 3-0 with a 0.45 ERA (1 ER in 20.0 IP) and a 0.80 WHIP.

## RHP LUKE WEAVER ◆ #24 ◆ R/R ◆ 6-2/185 ◆ 26 (AUG. 21, 1993)

**AT A GLANCE:** Is in his second season with the D-backs.

- Acquired from the Cardinals with C Carson Kelly, INF Andy Young and a competitive balance draft pick for INF Paul Goldschmidt on Dec. 5, 2018.
- Named the Cardinals' Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2016 after going 7-3 with a 1.30 ERA with Triple-A Memphis and Double-A Springfield.
- St. Louis' first-round selection (27th overall) in 2014 draft.

**LAST START:** Lost on Aug. 7 @ Padres (2 ER in 3.0 IP)...retired the final 6 batters faced.

- Surrendered home runs to Fernando Tatis Jr. (solo) and Jake Cronenworth (solo).

**PART OF THE PLAN:** Threw only 3.0 innings in his last start @ Padres - by design.

- Entering that start, had yielded just 1 run in the first 3 innings and 11 in the fourth and fifth combined.

**VS. ROCKIES:** Is 1-1 with a 6.57 ERA (9 ER in 12.1 IP) in 4 career games (3 starts) vs. Rockies.

- Won his only start last season on May 4, 2019 @ Coors Field (1 ER in 7.0 IP)

**THE CARSON KELLY CONNECTION:** Roomed with teammate Carson Kelly in 2015 with Single-A Adv. Palm Beach.

- Kelly has caught Weaver 20 times in the Majors, including 11 of his 14 starts with the D-backs.
- In 27 career Minor League outings together, Weaver was 14-5 with a 1.58 ERA.

**2019 REVIEW:** Limited to 12 starts due to right forearm tightness in his first season with the D-backs...was 4-3 with a 2.94 ERA.

- On the injured list from May 27-Sept. 21.
- His 26.5 strikeout pct. and 9.65 strikeouts per 9.0 IP were up from 19.9 SO% and 7.99 SO/9.0 IP in 2018.
