THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, taking two of three in Houston, followed by consecutive losses over the last two nights in the Bronx... tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the three-game series finale at Yankee Stadium... after tonight's game, Minnesota will travel to Pittsburgh to play the Pirates for three games over the weekend.

☞ Since April 22, the Twins have gone 26-15, the third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (30-11) and New York-AL (29-12).

☞ The Twins have gone 4-10 (.286) against AL East opponents and 29-18 (.617) against the rest of their opponents.

YOU GUYS LIKE APPLES? WELL, HOW DO YOU LIKE THESE APPLES?: Tomorrow night's game at Pittsburgh can be seen exclusively on Apple TV...this will mark the club's second time on Apple TV this season, their previous being a 3-2 defeat on May 17 at Cleveland.

BIG INNINGS COOK THE TWINS: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night in the Bronx by a score of 9-5...Chris Paddack (4-3) made the start and was issued the loss, allowing seven runs on six hits in 4.0+ innings pitched, including two walks and seven strikeouts...he allowed four runs in the first inning, then retired 10 consecutive batters until exiting in the fifth inning after loading the bases...New York scored four more runs in the fifth inning, which proved to be enough...the Twins offense recorded six hits, two from Kyle Farmer...Carlos Santana (9) and Royce Lewis (3) each added home runs, both solo shots.

ROYCE AROUND THE BASES: Last night's home run by Royce Lewis made him the first player in club history (since 1961) to homer in each of his first three games...below are the Twins to homer in their first two-plus games:

LEW-GENDARY: A home run tonight for Royce Lewis and he will be the seventh player in baseball history to homer in each of their first four games to start a season...nobody has ever homered in their first five (since 1990 - Elias confirmed):

THE AMAZING ROYCE: In 32 career road games, Royce Lewis is hitting .387 (46-for-119) with 12 home runs, 34 RBI, a .714 slugging percentage and a 1.165 OPS...he enters tonight with a 13-game hitting streak on the road...in fact, in his last 16 road games, dating back to August 23, 2023, he has slashed .386/.485/.860 (1.345 OPS) with nine home runs, 23 RBI and has homered in every road series he has appeared in (7 series).

☞ Since the start of last season, Lewis has an at-bat-per-home run ratio of 10.18 on the road, second-best in baseball (minimum of 100 AB), trailing only Aaron Judge (9.84).

START SPREADING THE NEWS: The Twins and Yankees are playing the final of six games in 2024...Minnesota is 0-5 vs. the Yankees this season...they have lost six straight against the Yankees, seeking their first win over New York since a 6-2 victory on April 25, 2023 at Target Field. ☞ Minnesota has gone 3-4 in their last seven at Yankee Stadium after going 1-16 in their previous 17 from September 18, 2017-September 7, 2022 here.

☞ Carlos Santana is hitting .373 (22-for-59) with four doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, a .433 on-base percentage, a .695 slugging percentage and a 1.128 OPS in his last 15 games at Yankee Stadium.

THE LAST DANCE: The Twins are looking to avoid being swept for the fifth time this season...their previous four sweeps were April 4-6 vs. Cleveland (2 games), April 15-17 at Baltimore (3 games), May 14-16 vs. New York-AL (3 games) and May 17-19 vs. Cleveland (3 games). ☞ Last time Minnesota was swept at Yankee Stadium was in three games from August 19-21, 2021.

DON'T STOP RELIEVIN': Over the last 14 games, the Twins relievers have gone 4-0, 1.85 ERA (48.2 IP, 10 ER) with 14 walks, 39 strikeouts, a .171 opponent batting average, 12 holds and seven saves in seven opportunities...their .171 opponent batting average and .226 wOBA in that span both lead baseball, while their .259 slugging percentage and .237 on-base percentage both rank second.

WE DON'T TALK ABOUT BRUNO: Over his last 33 games, dating back to April 25, Jose Miranda is hitting .296 (34-for-115) with eight doubles, five home runs, 17 RBI, a .322 on-base percentage, a .513 slugging percentage and an .835 OPS...on the road, in that span, he is slashing .310/.333/.586 (.920 OPS) with 11 RBI in 17 games.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2019, Max Kepler became the second player in club history to record multiple three-homer games (also 2016), joining Eddie Rosario (2017 and 2018), as Kepler hit all three homers off Trevor Bauer at Progressive Field...it also marked the second time Kepler homered three times in Cleveland.

NOW, FOR THE MOST IMPORTANT THING...: Pablo López was 0-2, 12.10 ERA (9.2 IP, 13 ER) in two starts from May 20 at Washington-May 26 vs. Texas, so he shaved his beard into a goatee...in his last start (with the goatee), he allowed one run on six hits in 7.0 innings pitched on Friday at Houston...last season, he went from beard to goatee prior to his June 7 start at Tampa Bay and maintained it for seven starts...through the first six goatee starts in '23, he went 2-2, 2.72 ERA (39.2 IP, 12 ER) with 52 strikeouts and a .197 BAA, including two 10+ strikeout games and four 9+ strikeout games...the goatee got knocked around on the seventh start on July 15 at Oakland (5.2 IP, 8 H, 7 ER), then was shaved off.

- ☞ Lost to New York-AL on May 15 at Target Field, allowing three runs on 10 hits in 6.1 innings as Minnesota lost 4-0...has gone 0-2 with a 2.95 ERA (18.1 IP, 6 ER) in three career starts vs. the Yankees.
- ☞ Has recorded 26 quality starts since the beginning of 2023, tied for seventh most in baseball...has made 10 starts of 7.0-or-more innings during that span.

HUGE START IN HOUSTON: Last pitched May 31 in Houston, opposite Ronel Blanco, and earned the win in Minnesota's 6-1 victory...allowed one run on six hits (1 HR) in a season-high-tying 7.0 innings with one walk and six strikeouts...only run came on Alex Bregman's fourth-inning home run...retired nine-straight batters to end the outing.

- ☞ Snapped career-high-tying three-start losing streak.
- ☞ Induced 17 whiffs on 53 swings (32.1%)...ranks in MLB's 69th percentile with a 28.0 percent whiff rate.
- ☞ Allowed just three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Houston went 3-for-3 on those swings, including Bregman's 96.2 mph home run...ranks in MLB's 61st percentile with a 36.7 percent hard-hit rate.
- ☞ Owns a 1.47 ERA (18.1 IP, 3 ER) in three career starts (regular + Postseason) vs. Houston.
- ☞ Was his 26th quality start since the beginning of 2023, tied for seventh most in baseball during that span.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 26 vs. Texas, opposite Gerson Garabito, and took his third-straight loss in Minnesota's 6-2 defeat...allowed six runs on seven hits (2 HR) in 4.2 innings with one walk and six strikeouts...surrendered two home runs to Corey Seager...allowed two runs in the fourth on a HBP and three hits...was pulled with a runner on third and two outs in the fifth; Kody Funderburk entered and allowed an RBI single.

- ☞ Induced seven whiffs on 43 swings (16.3%).
- ☞ Allowed seven hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Texas went 5-for-7 on those swings, including Seager's two home runs (108.9 and 98.3 mph).

SECOND STROMAN SHUTDOWN: Faced Marcus Stroman and New York-AL on May 15 at Target Field; took the loss, allowing three runs on 10 hits (1 HR) in 6.1 innings as Minnesota lost 4-0...has made three career starts vs. the Yankees, going 0-2 with a 2.95 ERA (18.1 IP, 6 ER), two walks and 14 strikeouts.

- ☞ Juan Soto has hit .333 (10-for-30) with three doubles, three home runs and eight walks vs. López...tied with Eloy Jiménez and Corey Seager for the most home runs off López.
- ☞ On May 15, allowed a career-long 467-foot home run to Aaron Judge.
- ☞ Only career Yankee Stadium start came April 16, 2023; took the loss, allowing two runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings with one walk and seven strikeouts...New York won 2-0.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making seventh road start of 2024...has gone 3-2 with a 5.03 ERA (34.0 IP, 19 ER), 10.59 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings and 2.12 home-runs-per-9.0 innings on the road, compared to 2-3 at home with a 4.64 ERA (33.0 IP, 17 ER), 9.55 K/9 and 1.09 HR/9 in six home starts.

- ☞ Has allowed a .265 batting average on balls in play on the road, .344 at home.
- ☞ Has allowed one-or-more home run in every road start this season.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: On May 31, Houston's left-handed hitters went 2-for-9 with two strikeouts vs. López, while its righties went 4-for-18 with a home run, a walk and four strikeouts...through 12 games vs. López, lefties have hit .262 (37-for-141) with a .742 OPS, 25.9 percent strikeout rate and 4.8 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .242 (29-for-120) with a .726 OPS, 28.5 percent strikeout rate and 3.9 percent home run rate.

- ☞ Has allowed a 34.6 percent hard-hit rate to lefties, 39.3 percent to righties.
- ☞ Has a 25.6 percent whiff rate vs. lefties, 30.9 percent vs. righties.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Has used his typical five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...here's his repertoire through 12 starts:

- ☞ On May 31, Houston went 1-for-10 vs. López's 4-seamer with four strikeouts and a 52.2 percent whiff rate (12 whiffs on 23 swings).
- ☞ His 4-seamer's 31.1 percent whiff rate ranks second in baseball (min. 100 PA), trailing only Ryan Pepiot (36.9 percent)...ranks eighth with a .172 batting average against.
- ☞ His sweeper ranks seventh in baseball (min. 50 PA) with a 31.3 percent whiff rate.
- ☞ Opponents have hit .162 (6-for-37) with 19 strikeouts vs. López's sweeper in two-strike counts.

KEEP IT DOWN: López's 30.9 percent fly ball rate and 4.3 percent home run rate are both career highs...has allowed one-or-more home run in all six road starts and nine of 12 starts overall...average launch angle of 15.7 degrees is also a career high; compares to 12.6 degrees in 2023...his 4-seam fastball has allowed a career-high average launch angle of 27 degrees; compares to 19 degrees in 2023.

- ☞ Among qualified pitchers, López's 1.61 home-runs-per-9.0 innings ranks second highest, trailing only Triston McKenzie (2.01).
- ☞ His 30.9 percent fly ball rate is 16th highest in baseball (min. 250 batters faced).

FEW FREE PASSES: Among qualified MLB pitchers, his 1.48 walks-per-9.0 innings are eighth lowest...ranks in MLB's 93rd percentile with a career-best 4.0 percent walk rate; compares to 6.0 percent in 2023...issued four total walks in six May games...has the fourth-highest strikeout-to-walk-ratio (5.24) of the 35 pitchers to start 40-or-more games since the beginning of 2023, trailing only George Kirby (9.46), Zach Eflin (8.32) and teammate Joe Ryan (6.09).

LOOMING MILESTONE: Sits two strikeouts shy of 800 in his career...would become the 16th Venezuelan-born pitcher to reach the milestone...Omar Daal is 15th on the Venezuelan leaderboard with 806 strikeouts...López currently owns a higher career strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.97) than any of the 15 pitchers above him on that list.
