TODAY'S GAME: The Giants will try and avoid a sweep after dropping the first two games of this series vs. their rival.

- ▶ Today's game ends a stretch of 16 consecutive games without an off day dating to April 30 for the Giants...this was the Giants' longest stretch of consecutive games this year...SF has gone 5-10 in the 15 games played thus far but is 4-4 in its last eight games.
- ▶ The last time SF was swept by the Dodgers in a three-game series here at Oracle Park was September 16-18, 2022.
- ▶ SF enters today's game six games under .500, matching their lowest point below .500 in 2024.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following moves today.

- ▶ **C Curt Casali** (#18) signed to a one-year ML contract.
- ▶ **C Jakson Reetz** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **C Tom Murphy** (left knee sprain) transferred to the 60 IL.

TOUGH SLEDDING: It's been a tough go vs. LA at home since 2018 with SF going 17-31 in 48 games against the Dodgers here at Oracle Park...SF has a -111 run differential in that time.

- ▶ SF did not win a home series vs. LAD in 2024, going 2-4 overall...since August 1, 2022, SF is 2-13 vs. the Dodgers here at Oracle Park, being outscored 88-38 in that stretch.
- ▶ The Giants have lost their last six games overall (regardless of venue) to the Dodgers dating to the final game of the 2023 season...since 2018, SF is 40-64 (.385) against their Southern California rivals.
- ▶ The last time SF lost six straight to LAD was September 6, 2022-April 10, 2023...the last time SF lost more than six in a row to LAD was July 21-August 4, 2022 (eight games).

STILL GRINDING: The Giants are slashing .226/.294/.341 over their last 19 games dating to April 24...they are averaging 3.16 runs/game in that span, scoring 60 runs.

- ▶ SF's 3.16 runs/game in that second-lowest in the Majors in that time...only the Pirates have averaged fewer runs (2.95).

THE INJURY BUG PLAGUE: SF put **C Patrick Bailey** back on the 7-day concussion IL ahead of yesterday's game and removed **RHP Keaton Winn** after 78 pitches due to right forearm tightness (he's going for an MRI today)...below is a chart of all the players the Giants have placed on the IL in the last 11 days.

WEBB PORTAL: **RHP Logan Webb** aims to try and lead the Giants to a victory tonight to salvage a game of this three-game series.

- ▶ Webb pitched well last Friday against the Reds here at Oracle, allowing three runs (two earned) in 7.0 innings but it wasn't enough in SF's 4-2 loss.
- ▶ It was the fifth time in Webb's nine starts this year he's pitched 7.0 or more innings...Webb's five such starts of 7.0 or more innings pitched are most in the Majors this year.
- ▶ He's had trouble with the Dodgers here at Oracle in his career, going 0-5 with a 5.58 ERA (19er, 30.2ip) in six starts...SF is 1-5 in those six starts with the lone win coming July 27, 2021 with a 2-1 victory.

TRENDING UP: **OF Jorge Soler** is scheduled to join Triple-A Sacramento today up the road and start a rehab assignment there tonight against Oklahoma City.

- ▶ **LHP Blake Snell**, on the IL since April 24 with a left adductor strain, will have his MLB rehab assignment transferred to Sacramento and join the River Cats on Friday to make another rehab start.

WADE'S WORLD: **IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** has reached base in 15 consecutive games entering play today and has a .491 OBP with seven RBI in that span...the 15-game on-base streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors behind MIL's William Contreras (22 games), SD's Luis Arraez (21 games) and TEX's Leody Taveras (17 games).

- ▶ Wade's 15-game on-base streak is tied for the second-longest of his career with a 15-gamer from September 1-20, 2023...his only longer streak was a 19-gamer from April 20-May 13, 2023.
- ▶ His .473 on-base percentage and 21.4% walk rate are both tops in MLB (min. 130 PA).

ROX ON?: After tomorrow's off day the Giants will host the Colorado Rockies beginning Friday night...SF is 20-5 vs. the Rockies here at Oracle since 2021, winning each of their last five games vs. Colorado here and eight of their last nine.

- ▶ The Rockies (entering play today) have won six straight starting with a win over the Giants last Thursday in Denver.

WEBB GEMS: SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster here in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension in April 2023 that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.

LAST TIME OUT: Returned to form last Friday vs. Cincinnati here at Oracle, allowing three runs (two earned) over 7.0 innings...it wasn't enough, however, as the Giants fell 4-2...Webb struck out six, walked two and allowed eight hits in the 100-pitch effort...it was a step in the right direction personally for Webb, who'd allowed nine runs (eight earned) in 7.2 combined innings over his previous two starts at Boston and Philadelphia.

BACK IN THE COMFORTS OF HOME: In four starts at Oracle Park this year, Webb has allowed five runs (four earned) in 29.0 innings (1.24 ERA)...he's allowed 26 hits, walked four and struck out 18 in those 29.0 innings while SF has gone 3-1...in his career, Webb is 25-17 with a 2.63 ERA (103er, 352.0ip) in 57 career starts at home here at Oracle Park...SF has won seven of his last 10 starts here dating back to August 2 of last year with Webb logging a 1.90 ERA (15er, 71.0ip) in that span...Webb has a long way to go to catch some recent Giants legends in terms of starts here at Oracle but his 2.63 ERA so far stacks up with some of the best hurlers to pitch in this ballpark.

EL CAMBIO: According to Statcast, Webb's changeup in 2023 was the second-most valuable pitch in the Majors in terms of run value at +28...only the Yankees Gerrit Cole had a more valuable pitch (+29 with his four-seam fastball) ...in his first three starts of this season it was not as good with hitters batting .324 off the pitch and only two strikeouts...in three starts with it from April 13-23, he found it with hitters going 10-for-47 (.213) and five strikeouts...in the two tough outings at Boston and Philly on May 5 and May 10, they combined to go 8-for-15 (.533) with three extra-base hits and a 83% hard-hit rate off Webb's changeup...on Friday vs. the Reds, they went 3-for-11 in at-bats that ended with Webb's changeup.

VS. LOS ANGELES-NL: Will face the Dodgers for a second time this season and first time at Oracle Park in 2024 in today's series finale...Webb lasted just 3.2 innings in his April 2 start at Dodger Stadium, allowing a season-high five runs (later equalled on May 5 at PHI) on seven hits...Webb, a groundball machine, only induced one ground ball of the 13 balls in play by Dodger hitters in the outing...in six previous starts against the Dodgers here at Oracle, Webb is 0-5 with a 5.58 ERA (19er, 30.2ip) with SF going 1-5 in those games.

CHECK 'EM: Opposing teams have had success running on Webb so far in 2024, stealing 10 bases when he's been on the hill...the 10 steals are tied for the second-most allowed by a starter this year...with OAK's JP Sears...only BAL's Corbin Burnes has allowed more (13).

0-1 IS MUCH BETTER THAN 1-0: Webb's first pitch strike percentage is 67.3% through eight starts in 2024...in his last start against the Reds, Webb had a 62.1% first pitch strike percentage...when Webb has pitched ahead in the count this year opponents have a .593 OPS off him...when he pitches from behind that OPS jumps to .876.

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants as a team are 59-42 (.580) in Webb's 100 regular season starts since 2021...SF is 4-5 in his nine 2024 starts and he's received three or more runs of support just three times in those nine outings.

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Through nine starts this year he owns a 59.2% ground ball rate, sixth-best in MLB entering play today...ATL's Max Fried leads at 63.2%...below is a chart of Webb's groundball breakdown by start so far in 2024.
